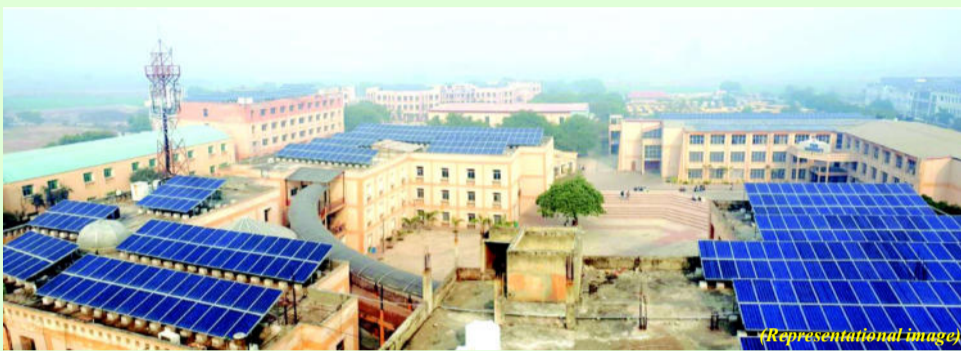
Administration intends to complete solarisation of all Govt. buildings by end of 2021

5.71 MW rooftop solar plants to be established in 469 Govt. buildings of North & Middle Andaman

Port Blair, July 23

The A&N Administration is fully committed towards dieselization of electricity production by taking all steps to minimize the power generation through fossil fuel by tapping renewable energy resources. In this regard, the Administration has received a mandate from Ministry of Power that all Government buildings have to be solarised by 2021. In line with this direction, the Administration intends to complete solarisation of Government buildings by end of 2021.

For implementation of Rooftop Solar Power Plant in North & Middle Andaman,

A&N Administration has entered into MoU with EESL, a Government of India Enterprise on 14.02.2020. The solar power project for rooftop in Government buildings shall be taken in annuity model wherein the entire upfront investment shall be borne by EESL & the rooftop owners will provide the fixed payment in

periodic manner which can be either on monthly/quarterly/annual basis. This business model is preferable as A&N Administration does not have to pay the upfront cost to EESL as is normally required in CAPEX model. At present only 4.15 MWp Rooftop project has been installed on 54 Government buildings against the target of

20MWp to be achieved by 2022. Under the proposed Annuity model the project cost is Rs.68.58 crores for the establishment of 5.71 MW rooftop solar plants in 469 Government buildings of North & Middle Andaman. The entire upfront cost shall be borne by M/s EESL, a Government of India Enterprise and the payable amount by UT Administration will be

@ Rs.6.85 crores per year. Rooftop solar plants on 469 Government buildings will be generating on an average of 6 million units of energy yearly and in its entire life span of 25 years it will generate around 125-150 MU which will cause a diesel saving of around 35,000 KL. The total expected saving on Government exchequer from the diesel saving will be Rs.7-8 crores/year, a press release from Electricity Department said.

Saturation drive for issuance of Kisan Credit Cards for all willing PM-Kisan beneficiaries & Dairy farmers

Special campaign for KCC for Agricultural & Animal Husbandry farmers

Port Blair, July 23

The A & N Administration has undertaken special initiative to saturate all PM-KISAN beneficiaries with Kisan Credit Cards (KCCs) in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman (PM-KISAN) is a Central Sector Scheme, with a view to provide income support to all landholder farmers' families, subject to certain exclusions relating to higher income group across India, so as to enable them to take care of expenses related to agriculture and allied activities as well as domestic needs. The scheme provides a payment of Rs. 6000 per year in three 4-monthly installments of Rs. 2000/- directly into the bank accounts of the eligible farmers under DBT mode.

The Govt. of India is committed to cover all PM-KISAN beneficiaries under Kisan Credit Card Scheme (KCC) this year, thereby covering



additional 2.5 crore farmers across India. This is expected to push an additional Rs. 2 lakh crore in the rural economy and bring down the cost of credit for working capital requirement for those farmers.

In A & N Islands, there are over 16,000 PM-KISAN beneficiaries and a little less than 6000 of them have access to concessional credit through KCC Scheme. The Department of Agriculture is collaborating in the task of ensuring adequate publicity of the scheme with active support of NABARD and the banks in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The District Collectors have also been sensitized about the need for the close monitoring of this Central

Scheme, for effective implementation.

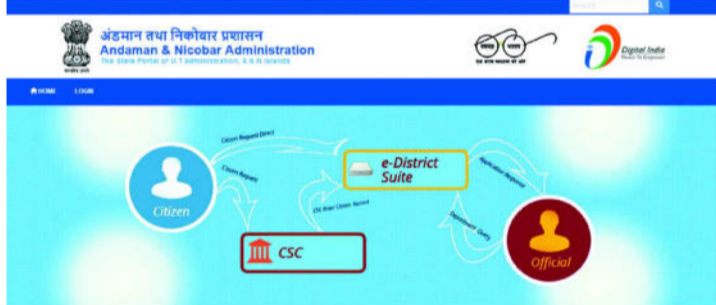

It is for information of all concerned that as per the seat distribution criteria/formula enumerated by the Ministry of Home Affairs, following are the tentative procedure for allotment of reserved seats for the students of Andaman and Nicobar Islands in the Professional/ Technical/Non-Technical courses at Mainland Institutions during 2020-2021 :-

(i) Criteria for allotment of seats to various categories fixed by the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi's Order No.U-14040/5/96/ANL, dated 30th May, 1996 is as under:-

Category-I	Tribals	20%
Category-II	Deputationist and Central Government Employees with transfer liability to serve outside the Union Territory provided the candidates in this category have studied the last two years in the islands and passed the qualifying examination from a school in the Islands.	10%
Category-III	Settlers who were settled prior to 1942 and those who were settled under various rehabilitation schemes introduced after re-occupation of the Islands. The seats in this category will be allocated as under:- (a) Pre-1942 Settlers 1/3 rd (b) Others Settlers 1/3 rd (c) Seat to be allocated on the 1/3 rd basis of combined merit of (a) & (b) above	50%
Category-IV	Other locals who do not fall under (I) (II) or (III) above and such Central Government Employees having no Transfer liability to serve outside the Union Territory, provided all have had 10 years education in the islands.	20%
Category-V	General merit quota open to all the residents of A&N Islands irrespective of any classification. This will be subject to condition that the candidates in this category have studied the last two years in the Islands and passed the qualifying examination from a school in the islands.	Unutilized seats of Categories I, II, III & IV above.

PwD : 5% seats are reserved for PwD candidates on interlocking reservation basis i.e. horizontal reservation cuts across vertical reservation (various categories of students in A & N Islands). Since the PwD candidates have to be placed in the appropriate category viz. Category-I, Category-II, Category III A, Category-III B and Category-IV.

Note : - The reservation of 10% seats to the students belonging to Economically Weaker Sections and the above referred seat allotment/ distribution criteria are subject to change depending upon communication to be received from the Ministry of Home Affairs.

(ii) ONLINE applications will be invited from eligible candidates by giving wide publicity through Local Newspapers/All India Radio/ Website of A&N Administration for considering allotment of reserved seats in Colleges/Institutions at Mainland.

(iii) The candidates should submit their application ONLINE at <http://colleeadmission.andaman.gov.in>.

(iv) Candidates have two options; either they fill the Admission Application Form through Common Service Center (CSC) or through internet by accessing the portal via URL <http://colleeadmission.andaman.gov.in>.

(v) If the candidates are applying through CSC, they are advised to pay the charges/fees at CSC Counter for filling up the application forms based on the criteria as stated below:
