Social Welfare Deptt. providing social security to senior citizens in Isles

12,760 beneficiaries receiving monthly pension under Old Age Pension Scheme

Port Blair, Aug. 23

The Department of Social Welfare, A&N Administration is providing Old Age Pension @ Rs 2,500/-pm to Senior Citizens in the age group of 60 to 79 years and Rs. 3,000/-pm to Senior Citizens of 80 years and above.

The aim of the scheme is to provide social security by way of financial assistance to poor senior citizens who are without any means of subsistence



and having nobody to give financial support to them for their livelihood. In A&N Islands, 12,760 beneficiaries between

the age of 60 to 79 years including 1052 beneficiaries of 80 years as on July 2021 are receiving their monthly pension

under the Old Age Pension Scheme. As per the scheme, only those who are permanent residents of A&N Islands or having resided in this territory for not less than 10 years immediately preceding the date of applications will be eligible for financial assistance.

qualification, present economic trends and the market potential, which can earn them a suitable employment or make them suitably skilled to go for self employment. The scheme is implemented through selected expert Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs). It ensures placement of minimum 75% trainees, out of which at least 50%

placement is in treated as unreserved.

Media briefed on COVID-19

Two positive cases detected during RT-PCR test conducted on flight passengers: Director (IP&T)

Port Blair, Aug. 23

The Director (IP&T), Shri Kamlesh Kumar briefing the media persons on COVID-19 status in the Islands held in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 583 passengers who arrived here yesterday, two positive cases have been detected. Today, 4 flights with 668 passengers arrived and the RT-



PCR reports are awaited. He further disclosed that RAT was conducted on 332 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and all the tests were found negative. During the return journey from Swaraj Dweep, 135 passengers were tested and all were negative. 229 passengers proceeding to Shaheed Dweep were also tested and all of them

were negative and during return journey from Shaheed Dweep, 109 passengers were tested and all samples were negative. At helipad, 7 persons were tested and all were negative.

The Director further informed that at Mohanpura Bus Terminus, 180 passengers were tested and all the reports were negative.

New portal under Bhuvan "Yuktdhara" will facilitate planning of new MGNREGA assets using Remote Sensing and GIS based information: Minister

New Delhi, Aug. 23 (PIB)

Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for the Ministry of Science and Technology; Ministry of Earth Sciences and Union Minister of State for Prime Minister's Office; Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions; Department of Atomic Energy and Department of Space, Shri Jitendra Singh said that the new portal under Bhuvan "Yuktdhara", which has been released today, will facilitate planning

of new MGNREGA assets using Remote Sensing and GIS based information. The Minister said that this platform will serve as a repository of assets (Geotags) created under various national rural development programmes i.e. MGNREGA, Integrated Watershed Management Programme, Per Drop More Crop and Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana etc., along with field photographs. Speaking at the launch of "Yuktdhara" Geospatial Planning

Portal by Union Minister of Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, Shri Giriraj Singh, Dr. Singh said that the name given is very apt as word 'Yukt' is derived from Yojanam, the planning and 'Dhara' indicates the flow. He said that it is definitely a culmination of untiring joint efforts of ISRO and Ministry of Rural development made towards realising a G2G service for rural planning in support of decentralized decision making.

Dr. Singh acknowledged the potential and services of ISRO's Geoportal Bhuvan and said that due to its rich information base, satellite images and analytical capabilities, Bhuvan, in fact, has become a de-facto geospatial platform for number of developmental planning activities in the country.

Volumes 1 and 2 of the report on NMP was released today in the presence of Vice Chairman (NITI Aayog), CEO (NITI Aayog), and Secretaries of infrastructure line Ministries included under the pipeline-Roads, Transport and Highways, Railways, Power, Pipeline and Natural Gas, Civil Aviation, Shipping Ports and Waterways, Telecommunications, Food and Public Distribution, Mining, Coal and Housing and Urban Affairs along with Secretary (Department of Economic Affairs) and Secretary (Department of Investment and Public Asset Management).

Union Minister of Finance, while launching the pipeline, said, "the Asset Monetisation programme has taken shape because of the vision of our Hon'ble Prime Minister who has always believed in universal access to high-quality and affordable infrastructure to the common citizen of India. Asset monetisation, based on the philosophy of Creation through Monetisation, is aimed at tapping private sector investment for new infrastructure creation. This is necessary for creating employment opportunities, thereby enabling high economic growth and seamlessly integrating the rural and semi-urban areas for overall public welfare." Smt. Sitharaman further enumerated the reforms and initiatives undertaken by the current Government towards accelerated infrastructure development and for incentivizing private sector investments. This included the recent 'Scheme of Financial Assistance to States for Capital Expenditure', which incentivizes State Governments to recycle State Government-owned asset for fast-tracking greenfield infrastructure.

Indian Army grants time scale Colonel Rank to Women Officers

New Delhi, Aug. 23 (PIB)

A Selection Board cleared the way for the promotion of five women officers to the rank of Colonel (Time Scale) rank, post completion of 26 years of reckonable service. This is the first time that women officers serving with the Corps of Signals, Corps of Electronic and Mechanical Engineers (EME) and the Corps of Engineers have been approved to the rank of Colonel.

Previously, promotion to the rank of Colonel was only applicable for women officers in the Army Medical Corps (AMC), Judge Advocate General Education Corps (AEC).

The widening of promotion avenues to more branches of the Indian Army is a sign of increasing career opportunities for women officers. Combined with the decision to grant commission to women officers from a majority of branches of the Indian Army, this step defines the Indian Army's approach towards a gender-neutral Army. The five women officers selected for Colonel Time Scale rank are Lt Col Sangeeta Sardana from the Corps of Signals, Lt Col Sonia Anand and Lt Col Navneet Duggal from the Corps of EME and Lt Col Reenu Khanna and Lt Col Ritcha Sagar from the Corps of Engineers.

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
