As per the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, a new scheme called Dr. Ambedkar Centrally sponsored scheme of Post Matric Scholarship for Economically Backward Class Students has been introduced. Students studying in post matriculation, post secondary stage/graduate/post-graduate/doctoral/ post doctoral level are eligible for grant of 'Post-Matric Scholarships for the Economically Backward Class' for the year 2019-20, to enable them to complete their education. The scholarship is open to all students (Other than SC/ST & OBC Classes) whose parents/guardian income does not exceed Rs.1.00 lakh per annum.

Eligible students may collect the form from Office of the Commission for Other Backward Class, Directorate of Social Welfare, Secretariat Complex.

Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY) is an accident insurance scheme launched by the Government of India with the aim to bring the uninsured population under insurance cover. The scheme is available to people in the age group 18 to 70 years with a bank account who give their consent to join/enable auto-debit on or before 31st May for the coverage period 1st June to 31st May on

an annual renewal basis. Aadhaar would be the primary KYC for the bank account. The risk coverage under the scheme is Rs. 2 lakh for accidental death and full disability and Rs. 1 lakh for partial disability.

Laser Guided ATGM Successfully Test-fired



New Delhi, Sept. 23 (PIB) Laser Guided Anti Tank Guided Missile (ATGM) was successfully test fired from MBT Arjun Tank at KK Ranges, Armoured Corps Centre and School (ACC & S) Ahmednagar yesterday (Sept. 22). In these tests, the ATGM successfully defeated a target located at 3 km. Laser guided ATGMs lock and track the targets with the help of laser designation to ensure precision hit accuracy. The missile employs a tandem HEAT warhead to defeat Explosive Reactive Armour (ERA) protected armoured vehicles. It has been developed with multiple-platform launch capability and is currently under going technical evaluation trials from gun of MBT Arjun. A r m a m e n t R e s e a r c h & D e v e l o p m e n t E s t a b l i s h m e n t (ARDE) Pune in association with High Energy Materials Research L a b o r a t o r y (HEMRL) Pune, and Instruments Research & D e v e l o p m e n t E s t a b l i s h m e n t (IRDE) Dehradun have developed the missile. undertaking, investigation and settlement of industrial disputes. The third bill, The Code on Social Security, 2020 seeks to amend the laws relating to social security of the employees in the country.

Replying to a discussion on the bill, Labour and Employment Minister, Shri Santosh Kumar Gangwar said that these historic bills will have far-reaching effects on the interests of the workers by creating a time bound grievance resolution mechanism. He said, several provisions have been included in the bills to provide a safe environment to the workers and robust social security mechanism. He said, the Government is committed for the welfare of the workers and in the last six years several steps have been taken in this direction. He clarified that the Government has not taken away the rights of labourers. He added that several provisions have been made for the welfare of the migrant workers.

Intervening in the discussion, Information and Broadcasting Minister, Shri Prakash Javadekar said that these historic bills will ensure justice for the workers. He said, several provisions have been made in the Bills including guaranteed minimum and timely wages, free health check-up facility and allowances for migrant workers to visit their homes once in a year. till the scheme is in force, subject to re-calibration that may be deemed necessary on review of experience of the scheme.

In case of a joint account, all holders of the said account can join the scheme provided they satisfy the eligibility criteria and pay the premium at the rate of Rs.12 per person per annum through auto-debit.

Individuals who exit the scheme at any point may re-join the scheme in future years by paying the annual premium, subject to conditions that may be laid down.

The accident cover of the member shall terminate / be restricted accordingly on any of the following events:

- On attaining age 70 years (age nearer birth day).
- Closure of account with the Bank or insufficiency of balance to keep the insurance in force.
- In case a member is covered through more than one account and premium is received by the insurance company inadvertently, insurance cover will be restricted to one account and the premium shall be liable to be forfeited.

Natural calamities being in the nature of accidents, any death/disability (as defined under PMSBY) resulting from such natural calamities is also covered under PMSBY. While death due to suicide is not covered, that from murder is covered. In case of any untoward incidence, Disability Claim will be credited in the bank account of the insured bank account holder. Death claims will be remitted to the bank account of the nominee/legal heir(s). In case of incidents like road, rail and similar vehicular accidents, drowning, death involving any crime etc, the accident should be reported to police. In case of incidents like snake bite, fall from tree etc, the cause should be supported by immediate hospital record. For more details, public may visit their nearest bank branch or the branch in which they have their accounts, a press release from Deputy Secretary (Finance-1) said.

with Quality Council of India, an autonomous body under DPIIT (Ministry of Commerce & Industry).

The SAATHI initiative will help the industry for resumption of business as well as give an opportunity to ascertain the degree of compliance with the operational recommendations/compliances in the following three phases:

- Execute the Self-Assessment framework and self-assessment certificate for the applicants.
- Conducting the Capacity Building Webinars to handhold stakeholders/units to understand the guidelines issued.
- Site-Assessment framework and IT Systems for on-ground tech-based assessment of the stakeholders' properties for physical verification of compliance to the notified guidelines.

The units seeking support under SAATHI will have to register with the National Database of Accommodation Units and they will be provided access to various online capacity building services under SAATHI. Till date, 250 accommodation units are registered with National Database for accommodation units. The Registration No. of National Database has been sent to the respective hotel owners/representative of the unclassified accommodation units by the Directorate of Tourism through email. All the registered accommodation units have been requested to check their email for Registration No. of National Database to link with SAATHI and go for self certification, online training and site assessment.
