AIR will broadcast the programme in regional languages immediately after the broadcast. Regional language versions of the programme will also be repeated at 8 PM.



## Fruits of development should reach poorest of the poor: Vice President

Visakhapatnam, Feb 24  
The Vice President, Shri Venkaiah Naidu has opined that there should be an equitable distribution of prosperity and the fruits of development, which should reach the poorest of the poor.

Addressing a large number of delegates at the inaugural session of CII Partnership summit-2018 in Visakhapatnam today, he said, key structural reforms of Government of India like the implementation of

demonetization and GST led to an expansion of the formal economy and brought about increased tax compliance.

He further said, as a result of reforms, the number of people, who had filed Income Tax returns increased from 6.47 crore in 2014-15 to 8.27 crore at the end of 2016-17.

He said, the long-term advantages will definitely outweigh the short-term hiccups emerged due to GST and demonetization as the economy is on the track to achieve a higher growth in the coming days. Around 230 delegates from 16 countries are participating in the three-day summit.

New Delhi, Feb 24  
The Election Commission has announced that polls to 59 Rajya Sabha seats will be held on 23rd of next month. A statement issued by the Commission today said, the counting of votes will take place on the same evening. The term of the members representing these seats is going to expire in April-May this year. These seats

include ten from UP, six each from Maharashtra and Bihar, five each from West Bengal and Madhya Pradesh, four each from Gujarat and Karnataka. The members, whose terms are ending, include Union Ministers Shri Arun Jaitley, Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, Shri J P Nadda, Shri Thaawar Chand Gehlot and Shri Ramdas

Athawale. The commission will also hold by-election to one Rajya Sabha seat of Kerala on the same date. The seat has fallen vacant following the resignation of Shri Veerendra Kumar. In August 2017, the BJP had overtaken the Congress to become the largest political party in Rajya Sabha with 58 members against 57 of the main opposition party.

The Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs has clarified that it is not directly involved in distribution of LPG cylinders and it is the responsibility of the Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. to ensure adequate availability and its timely distribution through their authorized LPG distributors. The clarification has been given following the frequent

complaints and appearances of news items regarding irregular supply of LPG cylinders in South Andaman and N&M Andaman Districts leading to hardship to the consumers, and alleging that these shortcomings are due to the inefficiency of the Department of CS&CA.

In a press release received her today, the Deputy Director, Deptt of CS&CA has mentioned

that this Department is only the monitoring agency on behalf of the Administration for market intervention in case of scarcity to make its availability at the time of crisis to safeguard the interest of the consumers. Time and again this Department issue directions to IOCL and its authorized LPG distributors to streamline the distribution of LPG but since only three

**Aruna Reddy creates history to win bronze at Gymnastics World Cup**

Melbourne, Feb 24  
Aruna Buddha Reddy became the first Indian gymnast to clinch an individual medal at the Gymnastics World Cup in Melbourne by securing bronze in the women's vault. Reddy, 22, scored 13.649 to finish behind gold medallist Tjasa Kyslslef of Slovenia and Emily Whitehead of Australia who took silver. The other Indian woman in contention, Pranati Nayak finished sixth with a score of 13.416. Reddy is a former black belt and Karate trainer. In 2005, Reddy won her first National medal which convinced her to take up the sport. Reddy finished 14th at

Indian women defeated South African women by 54 runs in the fifth and final Twenty20 cricket International in Cape Town today. By winning the match played at Newlands, India women also ended their South African tour with another series win. The side led by Harmanpreet Kaur won the five-match T20 series by 3-1. The third match was a no result encounter due to rain. The Indian women had



earlier clinched the ODI series by a 2-1 margin. Sent in to bat, India made 166 for 4 in their 20 overs. Opener Mithali Raj was the top scorer with a fine 62 off 64 balls. Jemimah Rodrigues made 44, while skipper Harmanpreet Kaur was run out for 27. Veda Krishnamurthy was not out on 8. Vice-captain Smriti Mandhana contributed 13 runs.

agencies are appointed as LPG distributors, the desired results are not achieved.

Taking into accounts the facts, the A&N Administration requested the Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas, Govt. of India for appointing new LPG distributors in all Islands of this UT. The Ministry approved the proposal for appointment of regular LPG distributors at Mayabunder, Rangat, Kadamtala, Bambooflat, Bathu Basti & Prothrapur which is potentially viable from business point of view. As part of implementation of 'Durgam Kshetriya Vitrak' (DKV) scheme by the Gol, to ensure more penetration of LPG at remote areas, the Administration proposed appointing independent LPG distributors viz CCS Ltd. for Little Andaman & Campbell Bay, EHL at Car Nicobar and Tribal Development Cooperative Society (TDCS) for Nancowary group of Islands which was accepted by the Govt. of India. New LPG distributorship at Rangat, Bathubasti, Prothrapur, Car Nicobar and Nancowary group of Islands are expected to start functioning soon whereas, no agency was found qualified for other notified areas. Advertisement shall be published by IOCL inviting fresh application for the left out areas will be done at the earliest. Once new LPG distributors are appointed, irregular distribution of LPG cylinders will be addressed permanently.
