Online services through integrated portal of DoIP Govt Departments urged to utilize this service; suggestions & feedbacks invited from users

Port Blair, Mar 24

The integrated portal (Url: andssw1.and.nic.in/doip) of the Directorate of Information, Publicity and Tourism is designed as an electronic interface between Central, State and UT Govt. Departments, functioning under the A&N Islands and the local media. Accordingly, all Departments and local media have been allotted login credentials to access the portal. The Computerised Advertisement Allotment System (CAAS) built in the portal automatically allots the advertisements to Newspapers registered in the Portal, as per the roster policy. The Departments/

DoIP can monitor the status of advertisements like list of advertisements allotted to newspapers, those yet to be published, payment pending with offices etc.. It helps DoIP and other Departments to monitor pending payments so that agencies get payment in time.

The portal also provides option for Govt. Departments to upload electronic copies of press releases and the uploaded press releases can be accessed and utilized by Newspapers, citizens and other stakeholders. The integrated portal also has a central telephone directory of Govt. Officials working in various offices

of the A&N Administration in an official capacity. All Departments are required to create entries of their Departments Heads, Officers and Officials in the online directory.

India's teen shooting sensation Manu Bhaker today bagged Gold in the Women's 10-metre Air Pistol Individual and Team events at the ISSF Junior World Cup in Sydney, Australia. Coming off a double Gold in her maiden senior World Cup in Mexico recently, the 16-year-old continued her terrific form to beat Thailand's Kanyakorn Hirunphoem in a thrilling Final. Manu shot 235.9 to finish at the top of the podium. Hirunphoem settled for a Silver, while China's Kaiman Lu won the



Bronze. Manu, Devanshi Rana and Mahima Agrawal also brought India on top of the team podium. China was second, while Thailand took home the bronze. India also tasted success in the Men's 10 metre Air Pistol event, with Gaurav Rana winning a Silver medal, and Anmol Jain grabbing the Bronze.

She stressed on the need for conducting more awareness programmes at the village level so that people are made aware of the free treatment of TB and its preventive measures. She also assured the support of the PRIs in disseminating information related to TB and DOTs treatment among the community.

Welcoming the gathering, the Director, DHS, Dr. S. P. Burma, through a power point presentation, highlighted about the cause, preventive measures and availability of advanced medicines for treatment of TB. He said, in India, 40% of the populations are infected with TB Baccilli while 1.5% populations suffer from TB. He stated that in A&N Islands 125 MDR cases are currently being treated and called upon the Health Staff, Anganwadi Workers, ANMs, ASHA workers and PRIs to work in close coordination with the Health Department in disseminating information about prevention of TB and help achieve the target of eliminating TB in the country as well as the Islands by 2025.

The dignitaries also distributed certificates to the winners of the competitions organized as part of the observance of World TB Day. The programme concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by District TB Officer, Dr. Anwar Moosa.

Earlier, in the morning, a rally by school students was flagged off by the Joint Secretary (RNTCP), Dr. S.P. Burma from Cellular Jail premises to Gandhi Statue, Aberdeen Bazaar which will culminated at the Cellular Jail. d) One Muslim Member having expertise in Muslim Theology and Law.
e) One Muslim Member from Muslim voluntary organization working in the fields of public administration, finance, education, social work or culture.
Provided that in case a Union Territory does not have a Legislative Assembly, the Government concerned shall have the discretion to nominate two members from any of the other categories mentioned above.
The name(s) sponsored in the above manner shall be duly considered by a Screening Committee constituted by the A & N Administration and the shortlisted names placed for consideration of the competent authority.
