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## Joint Enforcement Drive for removal of abandoned vehicles & other illegally parked vehicles conducted

### 25 two-wheelers, 1 three-wheeler & 12 four-wheelers removed from roads so far



Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr. 24 Considering the severity of the traffic related problems as well as road safety issues faced by the citizens due to the unauthorised parking of abandoned vehicles and other motor vehicles on the roadsides & road berms, advisory was issued to the vehicle owners to remove such vehicles immediately vide press release dated

17.04.2026, in Daily Telegrams and other print and electronic media. Accordingly, the Andaman & Nicobar Administration has initiated the enforcement drive jointly by Transport Department, Traffic Police, A&N Police, and SVPWC from 21.04.2026 onwards for removal of such vehicles.

On the day of the enforcement drive, road

stretches from Bengali Club to Chatham, Bengali Club to Goal Ghar and Bathubasti to Garacharma were identified and such vehicles were taken to the identified pit by towing. Similarly, on the second day, such vehicles lying on the two stretches from Corbyn's Cove to Prothrapur Jn and Bengali Club to Chatham were removed from the roads. On 23.4.2026 and 24.4.2026,

two stretches from Bathubasti to Garacharma and Hawa Ghar to Chakkargaon residential Quarters were selected by the enforcement teams and abandoned vehicles were removed from the roads. So far, a total of 25 two-wheelers, 01 three-wheeler and 12 four-wheelers have been removed from the roads. The vehicles will be released to the registered

vehicle owners after imposing the appropriate penalty as per the legal provisions. More road stretches will be identified for similar action against such vehicles.

It has also been observed that many vehicle owners have come forward and removed their vehicles from the roadsides on seeing the enforcement action which

## Utilization of Natural Pond Water for Drinking Water Supply at Caddlegunj

Sri Vijaya Puram, Apr. 24 During a visit on April 18, 2026, the Commissioner-cum-Secretary (PWD), Dr. Sachin Shinde, IAS, accompanied by the Chief Engineer, APWD, and other officials, identified a natural pond in the Caddlegunj area with an approximate storage capacity of 6 million litres as a potential water source. No.71/2026/F.No. 34-725/2026-Rev.- Whereas it appears to the appropriate Government that a total of 87.7902 hectares land is required in the Campbell Bay, Govind Nagar, Joginder Nagar, Vijay Nagar, Laxmi Nagar and Gandhi Nagar villages of Campbell Bay Tehsil of Nicobar District for public purpose, namely the Acquisition Land for the Project of Trunk Infrastructure at Great Nicobar Island.

The Social Impact Assessment (SIA) was carried out by Social Welfare Department through M/s Probe Research and Social Development Pvt. Ltd., Delhi and a report submitted / preliminary investigation was conducted by a team constituted by Collector as laid down under Rule 4 of the said Rules vide Order No. 17 dated 03.12.2025 and Social Impact Assessment report was received vide Letter dated 14.11.2025. The copy of SIA Report, copy of Expert Group Report and copy of Committee Report have been annexed as 'Annexure-I', 'Annexure-II' and 'Annexure-III' respectively.

The summary of the Social Impact Assessment Report / Preliminary investigation is as follows:  
This development of Trunk Infrastructure is for Public Purpose. Hence, as per the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 Section 2-(1)-(a & b), the acquisition of land for the project serves public purpose.

The Committee finds that the public purpose of the proposed Trunk Infrastructure project is immense. The project not only holds substantial benefits for the local community including the people affected by the land acquisition, but also serves a larger purpose for the nation as a whole. The strategic location of the Nicobar Islands, coupled with improved connectivity, will enhance economic, social, and defence-related integration, thereby bolstering national security and development.

A total of 201 families are likely to be displaced due to the land acquisition. The reason necessitating such displacement is that as per findings of the committee, the acquisition of land for the aforementioned project serves public purpose and after going through all the required technicality of the Trunk Infrastructure construction by the experts, SIA team and all stakeholders have selected the Campbell Bay, Govind Nagar, Joginder Nagar, Vijay Nagar, Laxmi Nagar and Gandhi Nagar villages as the most suitable site.

The Deputy Commissioner, Nicobar District is appointed as Administrator for Rehabilitation and Resettlement vide A & N Administration Notification F. No. 34-725/2017-Rev. dated 14.11.2017 under Section 43 of the Act for the purpose of rehabilitation and resettlement of the affected families. The copy of the Notification is annexed as 'Annexure-IV'.

Therefore, it is notified that for the above said project in the Campbell Bay, Govind Nagar, Joginder Nagar, Vijay Nagar, Laxmi Nagar and Gandhi Nagar villages of Campbell Bay Tehsil under Nicobar District, a piece of land measuring 87.7902 hectares of standard measurement, whose detailed description are annexed as 'Annexure-V-A', 'Annexure-V-B' and 'Annexure-V-C', is under acquisition.
