PM's maiden visit to Bihar from today; to launch Gram Jyoti Yojna in Patna

New Delhi, July 24
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi will be on a day visit to Bihar tomorrow. This is his first visit to the state after becoming Prime Minister. He will participate in several programmes in Patna and address a Parivartan rally at Muzaffarpur. Soon after arrival at Patna, Prime Minister will inaugurate the NDA government's ambitious Deen Dayal Upadhyay Gramjyoti Yojana for rural empowerment besides participating in the foundation day function of the Indian Council of Agriculture Research (ICAR). Prime Minister will dedicate permanent campus of Indian

Institute of Technology, Patna to the nation. Under Deen Dayal Upadhyay Gramjyoti Yojana, there are projects of Rs 76,000 crore out of which subsidy of Rs 63,000 crore will be given by Central government. The Centre has approved a grant of Rs 8,000 crore for the projects in Bihar. Under this scheme, the elements of agricultural and non-agricultural feeders would be separated to restore power units in rural areas. Through this scheme, the Centre aims at providing uninterrupted electricity supply to each household across the nation by 2022. Shri Modi will also lay foundation of the first phase

of the much awaited Jagdishpur-Haldia Gas pipeline project, the process of supplying LPG through pipeline network would begin. Petroleum Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhan said in four years LPG customers in Patna would start getting gas in their homes through the pipeline. Prime Minister will inaugurate Daniawa-Bihar Sharief new rail line. The distance between Patna and Rajgir will be reduced by 12 kilometres after this rail line. The Prime Minister will flag off Patna-Mumbai air-conditioned Suvidha Express and Rajgir-Bihar Sharief - Daniawa - Fatuha passenger train.

All arrangements for the exam complete: Director ANIIMS

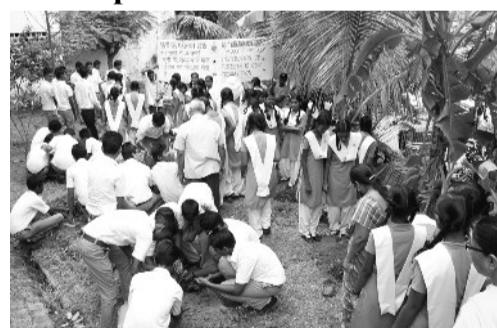

The Administration will conduct the Andaman Nicobar Islands Pre-Medical Entrance Test-2015 (ANIPMT) on August 2, 2015 for the candidates seeking admission to Medical College at Port Blair, named as Andaman & Nicobar Islands Institute of Medical Science (ANIIMS). Informing this, the Director ANIIMS Maj. Gen. R.P. Choubey VSM (Retd) along with the Officer Incharge of the Examination Cell, Prof. T.K. Bhattacharyya briefed media persons here today about the arrangements made for the free, fair and smooth conduct of the examination.



At a press conference, the Director ANIIMS said that altogether 900 candidates will take the ANIPMT-2015 exam which will be held in two centers i.e. JNRM College and Kendriya Vidyalaya No.1 between 10 AM to 1 PM. **Oman, Afghanistan grab final
World Twenty20 spots**

Dubai, July 24
Oman's fairytale rise as a cricket nation continued Thursday when they qualified for next year's World Twenty20 in India.
A five-wicket win over Namibia at the ICC qualifying event in Malahide near Dublin saw the Gulf minnows reach their first major international tournament. Victory also saw the International Cricket Council grant Oman, coached by former Sri Lanka captain Duleep Mendis, and with ex-England all-rounder Derek Pringle recently recruited as a technical advisor, full Twenty20 status.
Oman had previously beaten Canada, the Netherlands and Afghanistan, all far more experienced associate or non-Test cricket nations, at the qualifying tournament.
Afghanistan sealed the other qualifying spot on offer Thursday with a six-wicket win over Papua New Guinea.
It was the fourth successive time

that Afghanistan -- who competed at this year's 50-over World Cup in Australia and New Zealand -- had qualified for the World Twenty20.
The 16 teams who will compete

in the finals phase of the World Twenty20 are the 10 Test sides, plus qualifiers Scotland, Ireland, Hong Kong, the Netherlands, Afghanistan and Oman.
