Supplies Department, Directorate of Science & Technology, Agriculture Department, Fisheries Department, Electricity Department along with other stakeholder Departments and agencies. Their enthusiastic involvement and coordinated efforts contributed significantly to the successful conduct of the exercise.

The exercise simulated an oil spill incident along the coastline, requiring a coordinated response from multiple Departments. Various response activities, including activation of the Incident Response System (IRS), incident assessment, establishment of the Incident Command Post, deployment of response teams, shoreline protection measures, pollution containment, public safety management, environmental monitoring, medical preparedness, traffic regulation, communication support, and resource mobilization, were carried out in accordance with the approved exercise scenario.

The Additional District Magistrate, South Andaman/Director (Disaster Management), Ms. Priyanka Kumari, functioned as the Incident Commander and



effectively coordinated the overall response operations, ensuring seamless inter-departmental coordination throughout the exercise.

Commandant Laxmikant Gajbhiye, Indian Coast Guard extended technical guidance and operational support to all participating agencies for the smooth conduct of the mock exercise. Deputy Commandant Ram Karan Swami, National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) and Commandant (JG), Abhinav Srivastava, Indian Coast Guard were designated as Observers for the exercise. They closely monitored the response operations, evaluated the performance of the participating agencies, and provided valuable observations and recommendations to further strengthen preparedness and response mechanisms for oil spill emergencies in the Union Territory.

action in case of animal bites. A total of 43 students and 7 teachers participated in the session.

During the awareness talk, the students were educated on understanding dog behaviour and warning signs, dos and don'ts to be followed while encountering stray dogs, and the immediate steps to be taken in the event of a dog bite. Special emphasis was laid on avoiding provocation of dogs, maintaining a safe distance from unfamiliar animals, thoroughly washing the wound with soap and running water for at least 15 minutes, informing elders immediately, and seeking prompt medical attention along with Anti-Rabies Vaccination (ARV) without delay, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

Movement of all four-wheeler vehicles restricted on road leading from PM SHRI KV-I to Carmel SSS

In exercise of the powers conferred under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Act No. 59 of 1988), read with the Andaman and Nicobar Administration's Notification No. 32 95/2008-TR dated 10th March, 2008, the District Magistrate, South Andaman District, has imposed a complete restriction on the movement of all four-wheeler vehicles on the road leading from PM SHRI KV-I to Carmel

Senior Secondary School with immediate effect until the completion of the ongoing culvert construction work, in the interest of public safety.
