Prime Minister also released a commemorative coin on the occasion. On this occasion, Prime Minister said Rani Gaidinliu perpetuated and spread across the thoughts of Father of the nation Mahatma



Gandhi. Remembering Rani Gaidinliu, Prime Minister said that people need to learn to love nature from Rani Maa. He stressed that this will help in addressing the challenges of

global warming. Referring to India Bangladesh land agreement, Prime Minister said it has enhanced connectivity between North East and rest of India.

## Centre asks States to take stringent action against onion hoarders

New Delhi, Aug 24  
 Centre has asked all the state governments to take stringent action against hoarders to rein in prices of onion. Food and Consumer Affairs Minister Shri Ram Vilas Paswan today reviewed the supply and the price situation of onion at a meeting in New Delhi in view of increase in the prices of kitchen staple. Talking to reporters after the meeting, Shri Paswan said that steps taken to import onion and curb its exports will help control the rising prices of onion. Terming price rise in onion as a temporary phenomena, Shri



Ram Vilas Paswan said there is no shortage of onion in the country but hoarders are trying to take advantage of the situation. Highlighting the measures taken to boost domestic onion supply, Shri Paswan said, a tender has

been floated for import of 10,000 tonnes of onion to meet the demands. The Minister also said that the passage of Goods and Services bill could have helped in controlling onion prices.

## HM hits out at Pakistan for calling off NSA-level talks

New Delhi, Aug 24  
 Home Minister Shri Rajnath Singh hit out at Pakistan yesterday a day after it called off the NSA-level talks. Talking to reporters on the sidelines of a function in Lucknow, the Home Minister accused Pakistan of deviating from the agenda agreed to between Prime Ministers Shri Narendra Modi and Nawaz Sharif at Ufa. He said, if Pakistan was so keen on raising the Kashmir issue, why didn't it do so during talks at Ufa in Russia. The Home Minister made it clear that the possibility of any future dialogue will depend on Pakistan. He

underlined that India stands for dialogue and cordial relationship with Pakistan. Political parties in Jammu and Kashmir have expressed disappointment over the cancellation of talks.

New Delhi, Aug 24

### Public urged to remain alert against alluring phone calls, SMS, cyber frauds

Port Blair, Aug 24  
 There are reports of online fraudsters having become active in cheating the public of their money. In most of the complaints received by A&N Police, the victims are bank account holders who fell into the trap of the cheats. The cheats made phone calls posing themselves as bank officials and the victims shared their ATM Card No. and PIN

**STAY ALERT NOT TO GET DUPED**

- \* Do not disclose Bank ATM Card no. or PIN details to anyone. Banks never ask customers over phone or through e-mail or SMS for such details.
- \* Do not respond to any e-mail seeking your personal details, bank account number, credit/debit card details etc.
- \* Do not pay heed to alluring messages like "You have won prizes, lotteries & cash rewards"... etc.
- \* Sometimes, the sender of the message want you to call a particular number like WINNER! 9495504389 is chosen for \$ 2500 CASH prize, call +43820956174 now". If this number is called, huge amount gets deducted from the balance in the mobile connection. Instance of subscribes receiving missed calls from suspicious looking numbers starting from +375, +22455 or a few digits and those who tried to call back on these numbers were charged a whopping Rs. 45 per minute.
- \* Do not call back to such numbers.

Banks never ask any such information from their customers through phone or email. But those people who do not pay attention to these advisories issued by the banks, fall prey to the fraud callers.

On revealing the info, the caller asks the victim to switch off the mobile for some time so that a new PIN would be received. On switching it on after some time, the victim finds that money has been withdrawn from his or her account. The fraud caller is not traceable thereafter.

**Ravichandran Ashwin spins magic,  
India roar back to level series 1-1**

Colombo, Aug 24

Ravichandran Ashwin on Monday produced another magical spell to scalp five wickets as India notched up a series-levelling 278-run victory in the second cricket Test against Sri Lanka, denying the legendary Kumar Sangakkara a fairy tale farewell from the game.

Set a daunting target of 413, the islanders caved in rather tamely to be bundled out for a meagre 134 in 43.4 overs shortly after lunch break to allow the Indians to restore parity in the three-match series.

Wily off-spinner Ashwin again did the bulk of the damage with superb figures of 5 for 42 as the Lankans capitulated spectacularly to give Virat Kohli his first Test win as captain with almost two full sessions to spare. It was a commendable show by the Indians, who dominated the match right from the first day and made amends for their shock defeat in the first Test in Galle where they lost despite being the driver's seat for most part of the



game.

It was a disappointing end to Sangakkara's stellar career as he not only failed with the bat in both the innings but had to deal with the added misery of seeing his team go down with embarrassing ease.

Nobody expected the game to end so quickly as Sri Lanka lost last 7 wickets for 58 runs at lunch break, which was taken early owing to a rain interruption.

Leg-spinner Amit Mishra trapped the last man standing Dushmantha Chameera (4) to seal the issue triggering off scenes of celebration in the Indian dressing room while the players hugged

each other on the field.

India took five deliveries after lunch to wrap up the proceedings and bring themselves back in the series. Apart from Ashwin's mesmerising bowling effort, leg-spinner Amit Mishra chipped in with 3 wickets for 29 runs, while the pace duo of Ishant Sharma and Umesh Yadav claimed a wicket apiece.

For the home team, opener Dimuth Karunaratne provided a semblance of resistance with a gritty 46-run knock, which came off 103 balls. None of the other top-order batsmen could hang around for long, making the job easier for the rampaging Indians.

**Sensex crashes 1624-pts; erodes  
Rs 7-trn wealth**

New Delhi, Aug 24

In the worst-ever carnage in stock market, benchmark Sensex today crashed by 1,624.51 points and nearly Rs 7 lakh crore got wiped out from the investors' wealth as rout in Chinese stocks triggered a global sell-off.

The intra-day fall was even larger at 1,741.35 points -the third biggest ever and highest in over seven years since January 21, 2008, even as Finance Minister Arun Jaitley and RBI Governor Raghuram Rajan, among others, sought to allay the fears and said fundamentals of Indian markets remain strong.

The BSE's 30-share index closed the day at 25,741.56 points, down 5.94 per cent (1624.51 points), as stocks across all sectors including energy, banking, auto, IT, infrastructure and real estate saw massive selling as investors turned jittery amid a global carnage.

The total investor wealth, measured in terms of cumulative market value of



all listed stocks, plunged by nearly Rs 7 lakh crore and crashed below Rs 100-lakh crore mark to end the day at Rs 95,33,105 crore.

The broader 50-share NSE Nifty too witnessed heavy selling pressure and plunged

by 490.95 points to 7,809.00. Asian markets were also in deep red with Shanghai shares closing more than 8 per cent down, while European shares were also down close to 3 per cent in their early trade.

**Onus on ICC to convince BCCI that  
DRS is error-free: Anurag Thakur**

New Delhi, Aug 24

BCCI secretary Anurag Thakur on Sunday reiterated India's stand on Decision Review System (DRS), stating the onus was on the International Cricket Council (ICC) to convince them that it was 100 percent error-free. "We need to see if the ICC can rise up to the challenge. Some aspects of the DRS like no-ball, bat pad catches and other reviews could be improved further and would be acceptable by us. But we will not accept DRS for LBW decisions. We have major issues about it and unless the ICC makes that foolproof we cannot accept a DRS with LBW," Thakur was quoted as saying by a report in the Times of India.

Previously, the BCCI has opposed moves to use DRS in

Tests involving India as they predictive tracking system, Snickometer and Hot Spot are not completely accurate. Without taking BCCI on board, the ICC cannot afford the costs that come with introducing a universal DRS system. "We do a lot of excellent work. We organise so many matches, tournaments, impart coaching, pay out pensions, player support systems, etc. No other Board anywhere in the world is so proactive. Even within India, no other sport association does even a fraction of what we do for players and the sport. Yet, a minor issue here or there is blown out of proportion and this has put us in a bad light. My task and desire is to change that perception," Thakur further added.

**Usain Bolt wins 100 metres gold at  
world athletics ch'ships**

Beijing, Aug 24

Usain Bolt swept aside a year of poor form and injury to retain his world 100 meters title in nail-biting fashion on Sunday and give his beleaguered sport the boost it so badly needed after three weeks of negative headlines.

Bolt crossed the line in 9.79 seconds - pedestrian by his standards. Yet it very well may have been his greatest race ever.

The International Association of Athletics Federations has been in crisis since the results of thousands of blood tests

were leaked in early August, forcing it to defend the sport against allegations of widespread doping.

In that context, the sprint at the 15th world championships was cast as a morality play, a fight between good and evil and a battle for the soul of the sport. It pitched Bolt, whose status as a sporting icon was recently compared to that of the boxer Muhammad Ali by IAAF president-elect Seb Coe, against American Justin Gatlin, who has lost five years of his career to doping bans.

programme. Dr. B. Gangaiah, Head & Dr. T. Subramani, Scientist (Agronomy) of Natural Resource Management Division and Dr. V. Damodaran, Asst. Chief Technical Officer organized the programme.

At the outset, the ever growing menace of parthenium in A&N Islands in general and Little Andaman in particular, was highlighted. In this awareness programme, information about various aspects like occurrence of parthenium in different places of Little Andaman and its impact on yield and quality of crops, human beings, animals / livestock was explained. Farmers were asked to sow the Cassia seeds in parthenium infected areas.

A community based uprooting campaign of parthenium weed in the village was also organized in which tribal farmers, villagers and students actively participated. The villagers were also informed of its biological control through Zygomorpha bicolorata and the village Captain urged the scientists to explore this option in their village.

At the awareness programme, various vegetable crop seeds were distributed among the tribal farmers for increasing their income in addition to diversifying their food basket.
