Initiative to develop and promote Multi-Day Trekking Trails in A&N Islands

The Directorate of Information, Publicity & Tourism (IP&T), A&N Administration, in collaboration with the Department of Environment & Forests and Indiahikes Private Limited, has entered into a Tripartite Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for the identification, development, documentation and promotion of multi-day trekking trails in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

The MoU was signed under the guidance and in the presence of the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, by the Secretary (IP&T), the Chief Conservator of Forests (Territorial),



Forest Department, and the authorised representative of Indiahikes Private Limited.

The initiative seeks to diversify the tourism offerings of the Islands and promote responsible, sustainable and nature-based tourism, while providing visitors with opportunities to explore

the Islands' rich natural landscapes, biodiversity and lesser-known destinations.

The collaboration will also focus on capacity building and skill development of local communities in trekking, guiding, hospitality and other allied tourism services. This is expected to facilitate greater local participation and create livelihood opportunities for communities associated with tourism activities.

The Directorate of IP&T and the Department of Environment & Forest will coordinate with the concerned District Administrations and line

The quartet of Poovamma Raju, Vishal Thennarasu, Vithya Ramraj and Manu TS claimed the silver medal with a timing of 3:14.46, successfully defending the medal they won in the last edition in 2023 in Hangzhou. Bahrain won the gold with Games record of 3:12.87.

SVPMC holds meeting with BWG to strengthen waste management compliance

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 24

Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal convened a meeting with Bulk Waste Generators (BWGs), market associations, hotels, marriage/community halls and other stakeholders to strengthen compliance with the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026 and the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court. The meeting, chaired by Shri Avinash Kumar Singh, Superintendent Engineer, SVPMC, focused on BWG identification and registration, source segregation, timely waste collection and scientific management of wet and dry waste.

SVPMC informed stakeholders that establishments meeting the applicable criteria of 40,000 litres/day water consumption, 100 kg/day waste generation or 20,000 sq. m. floor area will be identified as BWGs and facilitated for CPCB portal

registration. Establishments not falling under the BWG criteria will be required to submit a self-declaration.

To improve collection services, night/early-morning waste collection will resume, with collection commencing around 4 AM. Market associations will provide suitable timings for finalizing market-wise collection schedules. All establishments were advised to maintain 4-way source segregation and keep segregated waste ready for collection as per the schedule.

Special emphasis was placed on wet-waste management. Vegetable markets were advised to ensure proper segregation and explore suitable diversion of vegetable waste to gaushalas, piggeries or other appropriate processing arrangements, wherever feasible. Marriage and community halls were requested to provide advance information

regarding major events generating substantial quantities of waste to enable SVPMC to plan collection and processing arrangements.

The meeting also discussed recovery of applicable user/waste collection charges, reporting of missed collections and promotion of onsite wet-waste processing, including biogas systems, wherever feasible.

SVPMC will continue to coordinate with BWGs and other stakeholders and provide necessary assistance for registration, source segregation, collection scheduling and sustainable waste management.

SVPMC appeals to all establishments and waste generators to cooperate in maintaining source segregation, following collection schedules and ensuring responsible management of wet and dry waste, a press release from SVPMC said.

Andaman & Nicobar Command executed a coordinated sea and air medical evacuation of a 36-year-old Bangladeshi national who sustained severe head and spinal injuries due a fall onboard merchant vessel MV AMRIS, during the intervening night of Sept. 20-21.

Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre (MRCC), Sri Vijaya Puram, received information from the Master of MV AMRIS regarding the injured crew member, who required urgent medical assistance. The Antigua and Barbuda-registered bulk carrier was enroute from Chittagong, Bangladesh to Krabi, Thailand.

On receipt of the information, ANC swiftly coordinated the maritime evacuation and diverted



ICGS Rajdoot, which was on patrol, to the vessel's position. Despite rough seas, darkness and challenging weather conditions, the Coast Guard ship safely reached the merchant vessel and embarked the injured crew member.

The casualty was thereafter transported to Diglipur Harbour. In continuation of the coordinated response, the injured crew member was immediately transferred

at Diglipur for air evacuation to Sri Vijaya Puram by an Advanced Light Helicopter (ALH). The Helicopter undertook the medical evacuation under challenging weather conditions and safely transported the casualty to Sri Vijaya Puram. On arrival, the injured crew member was handed over to the local agent and subsequently shifted to GB Pant Hospital for further medical treatment, a press release from HQ ANC said.
