Full swing preparations are on to celebrate the 71st 'Republic Day' in a befitting manner in these Islands too together with the rest of the country on January 26, 2020. The Republic Day is celebrated with grandeur every year with ceremonious Parade.

In the Islands, the main function for the Republic Day will be held at the historic Netaji Stadium on Jan. 26 wherein the Lt Governor, A&N Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) will unfurl the National Tricolour. As per the minute to minute programme chalked out for the Republic Day-2020, the Lt. Governor will unfurl the National Tricolor at 8:35 am and simultaneously there

will be fly past by MI-17 helicopter carrying National Flag. This will be followed by the presentation of medals, gallantry awards & distribution of Commendation Certificates by the Lt. Governor. Soon after the presentation of awards, the Lt. Governor will address the Islanders.

The main attraction of the Republic Day is the march past in which the contingents of Defence Forces, Police, NCC, troops from School (Boys & Girls) will participate. Tableau presentation, daredevil motorcycle show by IRBn and cultural programme by school children will add grandeur to the Republic Day function at Netaji Stadium which will conclude with the National Anthem. Before arriving at the Netaji Stadium for the main function, the Lt. Governor will visit National Memorial Cellular Jail and place wreath at the 'Martyr's Column' there.

India beat New Zealand by 6 wicket at Eden Park in Auckland

Auckland, Jan 24
In cricket, India have won the first T20 International of five-match series against the New Zealand by six wickets. Visitors achieved the target of 204 in just 19 overs losing four wickets at Eden Park in Auckland.
For India, KL Rahul made 56, skipper Virat Kohli scored 45 and Shreyas Aiyar made 58 runs.
Earlier, put into bat first, New Zealand scored 203 for five in the stipulated 20 overs. Colin Munro and Skipper Kane Williamson smashed quick-fire half-centuries.
The second T20 will also be played at Eden Park in Auckland on Sunday while third T20 will be held at Hamilton on 29th of this month.



The 4th T20 will be played at Wellington on 31st January while final and the 5th match will be held at Mount Maunganui on 2nd February.

Virat Kohli stays on top, Ajinkya Rahane moves upward in ICC Test rankings

Dubai, Jan 24
India skipper Virat Kohli maintained his top spot in the ICC Test Rankings for batsmen which were updated on Friday. Cheteshwar Pujara has been able to retain his sixth position whereas Ajinkya Rahane moved up by a place and is currently at the eighth spot.
In the latest rankings update that also includes the Port Elizabeth Test, which England won by an innings and 53 runs to go 2-1 ahead in the four-Test series against South Africa, sees Ben Stokes equal his career-best second ranking among all-rounders after his knock of 120.
Stokes has moved back to the spot he had occupied in August last year while he is presently ranked 10th among batsmen



and 29th among bowlers. Off-spinner Dominic Bess's five-wicket haul in the first innings has lifted him 49 places to 62nd, while Curran, Jack Leach and Stuart Broad have gained one slot each in the bowlers' list. Sri Lanka's Angelo Mathews has advanced eight places to reach 16th position after his unbeaten 200 in Harare helped his side win by 10 wickets in Harare to take a 1-0

lead in the two-Test series against Zimbabwe. The former Sri Lanka captain's best ranking was third, achieved in August 2014, while he has also been among the top 10 among batsmen in ODIs.
Team India's next assignment in Test cricket is against New Zealand where both the teams will contest in two matches beginning February 21.

Indian Grandmasters B Adhiban and S L Narayanan registered impressive wins in the third round of the Masters' category of the ongoing Gibraltar chess festival.
Adhiban and Narayanan scored superb wins over Martin Petrov of Bulgaria and Tingjie Lei of China while young GM Raunak Sadhwani securing 1.5 points shared the point with higher-ranked David

Navara.
Apart from Adhiban and Narayanan, there are a few other Indians on 2.5 points, including Vaibhav Suri and Karthikeyan Murali. Young Grandmaster R Pragnanandhaa beat International Master Padmini Rout to take his tally to 2. He had lost to fellow Indian P V Nandhidhaa in the opening round. D Gukesh, another rising star from India and the

second youngest GM ever, was held to a draw by Adrian Gschnitzer. GM Karthikeyan Murali, took a draw against Ori Kobo to take his tally to 2.5. Georgia's Ivan Cheparinov, Kyrsa Leandro of Argentina, Vasif Durarbayli of Azerbaijan, Pier Luigi Basso of Italy and Maksim Chigaev from Russia are ahead of the field with three points after the third round yesterday.

Four countries to qualify for T20 World Cup 2021 from 16-team ICC Qualifier

New Delhi, Jan 24
International Cricket Council (ICC) has confirmed that four among 16 countries will qualify for the tournament proper of ICC World T20 scheduled to be held in India in 2021. The event replaces the eight-team Champions Trophy ODI tournament that was last held

in 2017 in England.
An ICC release said, 11 regional qualification tournaments will take place across the five ICC regions (Africa, Americas, Asia, East Asia Pacific and Europe) with eight teams progressing to one of two global qualifying events. The 12 teams, which make

round two of the ICC T20 World Cup 2020 in Australia will gain automatic entry into the event the following year.
All Members who meet the ICC Event Participation Criteria (EPPC) will be eligible to participate in the qualification for the ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2021.
