Yoga does not have a narrow religious connotation: VP

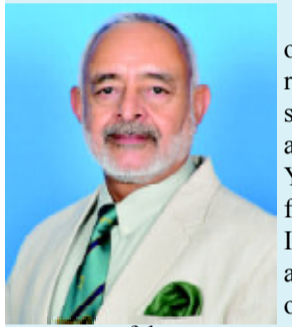


Mumbai, Dec 24

Vijender Singh defends two pro-boxing titles with 10th straight win

Jaipur, Dec 24
Vijender Singh was too good for his opponent. Read into it what you will. On Saturday, just about everything that could go right for Indian pro boxing's poster boy did. Vijender didn't lose a single round, retained his WBO super middleweight Asia Pacific and Oriental titles and took his unbeaten streak to 10-0 with a unanimous 100-90 win over Ghana's Ernest Amuzu.

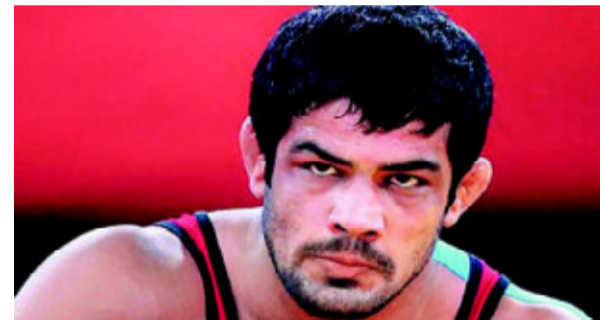


His opponent too played the role he was expected to. The untested, unknown, uni-dimensional Amuzu was ripe for the picking. The 2008 Olympic bronze-medallist took roughly a minute to take measure of his opponent, and spent the next twenty-nine cutting him down to size. Amuzu threw the fight's first punch, a lunging overhead right shielded by Vijender. Mindlessly then, the Ghanaian went for the same punch several times, telegraphing his movements in the process. Vijender would first negate the right hand by initiating

a clinch, and soon started countering with uppercuts, slips and rights of his own. Amuzu later attempted variations, switching levels and taking shots at the body. But by failing to force the proceedings initially, he allowed Vijender to come out of his shell and let loose. Vijender has invariably been the aggressor in all but one of his professional fights. In China's Zulipkaer Maimaitiali, the Indian found his toughest opponent, one who would walk through the punches and land his own. After being pushed to the brink in his

last fight, Vijender came out on Saturday with the guard firmly up. But after quickly realising that Amuzu didn't deserve a lot of respect in the ring, Vijender teed off, putting on a show of pressure fighting and volume punching.

Sushil Kumar top-grosser at Rs 55 lakh in Pro Wrestling League auction



New Delhi, Dec 24
Two-time Olympic medallist Sushil Kumar earned the highest bid of Rs 55 lakh from Delhi Sultans in the Pro Wrestling League (PWL) third edition auction on Saturday. Amongst women, world championship gold medallist Helen Maroulis (under-57kg category) from the United States earned the highest bid of Rs 44 lakh from Haryana Hammers.

India's 2016 Olympic medallist Sakshi Malik was bought by Mumbai Maharathi for Rs 39 lakh. In other bids, Bajrang Punia, who will compete in the 65kg, was bought by UP Dangal for Rs 25 lakh. Vinesh Phogat, who earned Rs 40 lakh, will ply her trade for UP Dangal as well. UP Dangal also bagged Vinesh's elder sister Geeta (62kg) for Rs 28 lakh. Meanwhile, 2016 Rio Olympics bronze medallist Iran's Hassan Rahimi Sabzali, who had an initial base price of Rs. 21 lakh, was bought by Haryana Hammers for Rs 46 lakh.

Selectors pick MS Dhoni for 2019 World Cup; Ravindra Jadeja, R Ashwin left out of South Africa tour

Mumbai, Dec 24
Kedar Jadhav, who suffered a hamstring injury that kept him out of the limited-overs series against Sri Lanka, returns to the India squad for the six-match ODI series against South Africa beginning in February 2018. As many as ten frontline batsmen, including Hardik Pandya and MS Dhoni, are part of a batting heavy 17-member India squad announced by the MSK Prasad-led selection panel on Saturday (December 23). Shardul Thakur, the Mumbai pacer, also finds a place in the squad after missing the limited-overs leg of the Sri Lanka series due to a shoulder injury. Regular skipper Virat Kohli returns to the team after taking a break from the Sri Lanka ODIs and T20Is. The Indian selectors left Umesh Yadav out while including Mohammed



Shami in the squad. Shami last played an ODI against Australia in September 2017. "Shardul will be playing shortly. In fact he will be playing from January 1. Kedar will be alright by the start of the series. He will be playing the T20 domestic games shortly," Prasad, the chief selector, said of the two players returning from their injuries. "Announcing the team

one month before will also help them prepare well. ODI specialists will have enough time to prepare and it's likely they will go in a bit early." KL Rahul, despite his good form against Sri Lanka in the T20I series, continues to remain on the sidelines for the ODI format while Suresh Raina, who recently passed the Yo-Yo test, hasn't yet found favour with the selectors.
