Port Blair, Feb. 24 The UT Administration is committed to achieve the ambitious vision of the Govt. of India to ensure Food for All throughout the country through National portability irrespective of their native State/UT under the National Food Security Act, 2013 (NFSA). To implement the scheme in true letter and spirit for establishing the veracity of the beneficiary for keeping proper accountability of the utilization of highly subsidized foodgrains, the beneficiaries above 65 years of age or differently abled having no other adult family member (16 to 65 yrs) listed in their respective Ration Card and are not in a position to visit the FPS, special dispensation under NFSA i.e. feature of 'Nomination Policy' is available under which the above said eligible households can nominate any two persons either of whom can draw PDS items on his/her behalf subject to conditions like the Nominee must be a PDS beneficiary tagged to the same FPS; foodgrains should be issued to the nominee only after proper authentication/identification as in case of any other beneficiary and FPS dealer or his/her family members cannot be authorized as a nominee. This facility is also extended for all such beneficiaries covered under tide over allocation

Initiative towards cashless transaction Transport Deptt. introduces POS devices for payments through Debit/Credit cards

Port Blair, Feb. 24 Improvement of public service in the UT has always been the main focus area of the Administration for which many proactive steps have been taken. It was observed that for urgent/immediate requirement of cash by the general public availing the services of Motor Vehicle Department/other services, they were required to travel to avail the ATM facility. To resolve their problems, a SBI ATM Outlet was established in the premises of Transport Department and inaugurated on 05.09.2018. Now, taking that forward and keeping in mind the Govt. of India's 'Cashless India' programme, the Department has introduced new POS (Point-of-Sale) devices for payments with Debit/Credit cards. A facility to make UPI payment (Google pay, Paytm, Phonepe, BHIM etc) by scanning the QR code is also available



General public availing POS facility in this device. The facility was inaugurated by Shri Prateek Raj Yadav, Director of Transport in the State Transport Main Office, Port Blair today in the presence of all employees and public in a simple function. This facility will benefit the public greatly by eliminating the need to carry cash and direct cash

transaction between the citizens and employees. It will also put an end to crowded ATMs during COVID-19 pandemic. This is a first step towards GOI's 'Cashless India' programme in Transport Department. In due time, POS machines will be made available in all the other counters of Transport Department handling cash transactions, a press release from Directorate of Transport said.
