India & Cuba sign MoUs to enhance co-operation in field of Biotechnology, traditional medicine & homoeopathy

Havana, June 23
India and Cuba have signed two MoUs in the field of biotechnology, traditional medicine and homoeopathy. The agreements were inked following delegation-level talks between President Shri Ram Nath Kovind and his Cuban counterpart Mr Miguel Mario Diaz-Canel at Revolution Palace in Havana yesterday. The two countries agreed to enhance cooperation in biotechnology, renewable energy and traditional medicine. Cuba also reiterated its support to India's candidature for a permanent seat in UN Security Council. Earlier, giving a keynote



speech at the Havana University, the President said, mutual respect and solidarity among developing countries form the core of South-South

cooperation. He said, its success must encourage our developed country partners to see how best these modalities can be utilised by them as well.

Shri Kovind also visited the Centre for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology where he saw PowerPoint Presentation on Cuban

pharmaceutical industry. He paid tributes at the statue of Mahatma Gandhi. He also paid his respects to Cuban National Hero Jose Marti at his memorial at Revolution Square. Briefing media on the conclusion of President's three-nation visit, Secretary (East) in the Ministry of External Affairs, Ms. Preeti Saran said, India has a strong, cordial and friendly relations with Cuba. She said, both countries are founding members of Non-Aligned Movement and have stood for South-South solidarity. She said, the two countries have collaborated very closely in United Nations and other forums.

Kaliningrad, Russia, June 23
A thunderous strike by Granit Xhaka and a superb last-minute breakaway goal by Xherdan Shaqiri gave Switzerland a dramatic 2-1 win over Serbia in a swashbuckling World Cup Group E match on Friday. Serbia went ahead with an Aleksandar Mitrovic header after five minutes to the delight of their fervent supporters at the Kaliningrad stadium. Xhaka silenced the Serbian contingent in the 52nd minute, however, when he left fly with a left-foot shot which flew into the net from 25 metres before Shaqiri broke away to win the game at the death. The result left Brazil, 2-0 winners over Costa Rica, top with four points, ahead of Switzerland on goal difference with Serbia on three. Brazil and Serbia meet in their final game while the Swiss face Costa Rica, already eliminated after losing their first two games. Serbia made a flying start and Mitrovic forced Swiss goalkeeper Yann Sommer into an early save with a close-range header.
