Pune, Jun 22

HRD Ministry issues fresh guidelines for Selection of Teachers for National Awards

New Delhi, Jun 22
Human Resource Development Ministry has issued fresh guidelines for Selection of Teachers for the National Awards. In a statement, the Ministry said, teachers of Government schools can now send their entries directly for the awards. This is a new initiative, as

earlier entries were selected by the State Governments. The purpose of the National Award to Teachers is to celebrate the unique contribution of some of the finest teachers and to honour those teachers, who have not only improved the quality of school education but also enriched the lives of

students. The Ministry said, all the applications would be received through an online web portal which would be developed and managed by the Administrative Staff College of India. An independent national jury will finalise the nominations for the awards.

Over 1.50 lakh wellness centres will be set up by 2022: Minister

Shimla, Jun 22
Union Minister Shri J P Nadda today said over 1.50 lakh wellness centres will be set up by 2022 across the country and each centre will have yoga facility. The Minister of Health and Family Welfare said this at an event to mark

the fourth International Yoga Day in Shimla yesterday. He said that 1.50 lakh health Sub Centres and Primary Health Centres would be upgraded into Wellness Centres with modern facilities for treatment.

Sub-Saturn like Planet discovered around a Sun-like star

New Delhi, Jun 22
A team of scientists and engineers led by Prof. Abhijit Chakraborty of Physical Research Laboratory (PRL), Ahmedabad, discovered a sub-Saturn or super-neptune size planet (mass of about 27 Earth Mass and size of 6 Earth Radii) around a Sun-like star. The planet will be known as EPIC 211945201b or K2-236b.



Telescope at PRL's Gurushikhar Observatory in Mount Abu, India. Only 23 such planetary systems (including this discovery) are known to this date with masses between 10 and 70 Earth mass and size of 4 to 8 Earth radii with such precise measurement of mass. This discovery is very important for understanding the formation mechanism of such super-Neptune or sub-Saturn kind of planets, that are too close to the host star

and as well as planet formations around Sun-like stars. With this discovery, India has joined a handful of countries, which have discovered planets around stars beyond our solar system. Further, PARAS is the first of its kind spectrograph in Asia, which can measure the mass of a planet going around a star. Very few spectrographs exist around the world that can do such precise measurements.

Government bans Indian affiliates of al-Qaeda & ISIS

New Delhi, Jun 22
The centre has banned the Indian affiliates of al-Qaeda and Islamic State of Iraq and Syria (ISIS). The Home Ministry's order says the two terror outfits are banned as they are involved in radicalising the Indian youths for 'global jihad' and acting against the Indian interests in the

Indian sub-continent. The order also bans Islamic State in Khorasan Province/ISIS Wilayah Khorasan, an Afghanistan-based affiliate of the ISIS. The ISKP/ISIS Wilayah Khorasan is also promoting and encouraging terrorism in the Indian Sub-continent, the order said.

The 72nd meeting of the Sub-Committee to the District Level Task Force Committee (SCDLTFC) pertaining to Little Andaman was held in the Office of the Tehsildar, Hut Bay under the chairmanship of Shri Ramesh Kumar, Tehsildar-cum-Executive Magistrate, Little Andaman today for processing of the loan applications received from concerned area under PMEGP scheme of KVIB. Shri Asamanja Halder, Pradhan, Gram Panchayat, Ramkrishnapur, Smti. Geetha Rao, Pradhan, Gram Panchayat, Hut Bay, Shri Festus Nathaniel, Secretary, Tribal Council, Harminder Bay and other members were present during the meeting. Altogether, the loan cases of

Hockey: India aim for maiden CT title; play Pakistan in opener

New Delhi, June 22
The Indian hockey team would be aiming for a fresh start, putting behind the disappointment of a poor Commonwealth Games campaign, when it begins its pursuit of a maiden Champions Trophy title, taking on arch-rivals Pakistan in the opening clash, in Breda (Netherlands) on Saturday. Asian champions India have never won the Champions Trophy in its last 36 editions but will be hoping to claim the feat in the tournament's last edition here. The best India has fared in the tournament was the runners-up finish at the 2016 event in London, losing to Australia in a shoot-out. Claiming the title would be easier said than done for the eight-time Olympic champions as they come into the tournament on the back of a disastrous campaign at the Gold Coast Commonwealth Games, where they finished fourth. The disappointing finish triggered a change in head coach's position with Harendra Singh taking charge from Dutchman Sjoerd Marjine, who moved back to his old position as coach of the Indian women's team. World's best six teams compete in the Champions Trophy and



this year's line-up include reigning Olympic champions Argentina, world no.1 Australia, Belgium, hosts Netherlands, Pakistan besides India. India will open against Pakistan before taking on Argentina (on June 24), Australia (June 27), Belgium (June 28) and Netherlands (June 30). Even though India (6th) are way ahead of Pakistan (13th) in the world rankings, but there is hardly any gap between

ICC Test rankings: Dhawan reaches career-best 24 spot, Vijay & Jadeja move up too

Dubai, Jun 22
In the latest ICC Test rankings, Indian opener Shikhar Dhawan moved up 10 places to achieve a career-best 24. His teammates Murali Vijay and Ravinder Jadeja also moved up. Dhawan's knock of 107 in the historic Bengaluru Test against Afghanistan saw him become the first Indian to complete a century before lunch on the opening day of a Test match. Vijay's innings of 105 has lifted him six spots to the 23rd



position. India spinner Jadeja inched up one slot to third position after claiming six wickets in the Bengaluru Test. Fast bowlers Ishant Sharma and Umesh Yadav have also made northward movement. India also maintained the top spot in the team rankings.

11-year-old makes history as first Indian ball girl at FIFA World Cup

New Delhi, June 22
Eleven-year-old Nathania John K from Tamil Nadu today became India's first FIFA ball girl when she led Brazil on to the field in their game against Costa Rica at Arena St Petersburg. That is, Nathania, who hails from the Nilgiris and is a footballer herself, became the first Indian girl to be an Official Match Ball Carrier (OMBC). A class six student of Rishi Valley School in Chittoor, Andhra Pradesh, Nathania got the opportunity to travel to the FIFA World Cup after winning a contest organised by FIFA sponsor KIA. She was selected as OBMC along with a 10-year-old boy Rishi Tej, who hails from Karnataka. "I am still in a daze. It is very



unusual for an Indian to participate in the World Cup," said Nathania said before she left for Russia. Still, the aspiring footballer is confident enough to know why she was selected. "I play as a centre forward for my senior school team. So, I was at ease when they asked me (during the KIA contest) to show my dribbling, juggling and penalty shooting skills. I have seen that girls don't play

much football in India," said Nathania. The 11-year-old girl is thrilled, of course, but there is one thing that was disappointing for her. She's a fanatic Lionel Messi supporter, but she's not going to be a ball carrier in an Argentine game. Worse, Argentina - and Messi - have been having a horrendous run at this World Cup so far; the team was thrashed 3-0 by Croatia yesterday.
