Counter-terrorism cooperation should be institutionalized at multilateral level: PM

New York, Sept 24
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has called for institutionalising the counter-terrorism cooperation at the multilateral level. Speaking at the Leaders' Dialogue on Strategic Responses to Terrorist and Violent Extremist Narratives, on the sidelines of the 74th UN General Assembly session, Prime Minister said in the fight with terrorism there should be a "qualitative upgradation" in the ongoing cooperation and intelligence sharing through bilateral and regional frameworks. Shri Modi asserted that India will work towards enhancing ongoing cooperation and capacity building of friendly countries in this area.

Secretary (West) in the Ministry of External Affairs, Shri A Gitesh Sarma told reporters in New York after the meeting that Prime Minister said that terrorists should not be allowed to get funds and arms, for this objective to be realised.



He said terrorist attacks should be considered as an act of terrorism -- "not

more or less" or "good or bad".
The Prime Minister also asserted the need to avoid politicization of mechanisms like UN sanction listings and the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) and said that these mechanisms need to be enforced.
Sharing India's experience, Shri Modi told the meeting that democratic values, diversity and inclusive development are the most important weapons against ideologies that promote terrorism, extremism and radicalism.

Fireman KP Mammu of A&N Police Fire Service has brought laurels to A&N Islands by securing gold medals in the sprint events held in National & International level competitions. Shri Mammu remained unstoppable as he clinched 3 Gold Medals in Men's 100 mtr. & 200 mtr. race and Long Jump in the '2019 World Police & Fire Games', held at Chengdu, China in August, 2019. In a highly competitive event having over 200 participants from 75 countries, Mammu achieved this feat in under 45 years category through his sheer determination, hard work & regular practice. Mammu is also the first Islander ever to win gold medals in Long Jump and 100 mtr. & 200 mtr. events in the recently held 'Asian Masters Athletes Annual Championship-2019' at Colombo, Srilanka in which he created new world records. He bagged Gold Medal in 200 mtr sprint in the 1st 'National Fire Service Games & Fire Service Meet' organised by Director General, Fire Service Civil Defence & Home Guard, MHA, Govt. of India, at Nagpur in 2018.
