Extensive exercise on agricultural reforms being undertaken so that farmers get fair price for their crop: PM Modi

New Delhi, Mar 25 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today said, an extensive exercise on agricultural reforms is being undertaken across the country to ensure that the farmers get a fair price for their crop. Sharing his thoughts in the 42nd edition of his 'Mann Ki Baat' programme on All India Radio, Shri Modi said, Government is connecting local village mandis to wholesale markets and subsequently with the global market. He said, 22,000 rural haats in the country will be upgraded by creating the necessary infrastructure. Shri Modi said, India has now moved ahead from the



conventional approach in the health sector. All Departments and Ministries are working together for 'Swasth Bharat' and stress is being laid on affordable health

along with preventive health. Extensive work is also going on to set up Health Wellness Centres across the country. Sanitation coverage has almost doubled and risen to

around 80 percent. Referring to Ayushman Bharat Yojana, Shri Modi said, government and insurance companies will jointly provide 5 lakh rupees for treatment to

about 10 crore families. Shri Modi appealed to the listeners of 'Mann Ki Baat' programme to provide information about Jan Aushadhi Kendras to the needy ones as it will cut their expense on medicines. He said, the cost of heart stent for heart patients has been reduced to 85 per cent and knee implants cost has also been regulated and reduced by 50 per cent to 70 per cent. Shri Modi also said, a target has been fixed to make the country TB-free by 2025 and sought people's co-operation to create awareness on it. IRDAI extends deadline for linking Aadhaar with various insurance policies

New Delhi, Mar 25 Insurance regulator IRDAI has extended the deadline for linking 12-digit unique identity number Aadhaar with various insurance policies until the Supreme Court decides on the matter. The apex court has extended the deadline of linking Aadhaar till the matter is finally heard and the judgment is pronounced. The IRDAI's decision to indefinitely extend the March 31 deadline comes in wake of the Supreme

Court order. In a circular to insurers, IRDAI said, for existing insurance policies, the date of linking Aadhaar is extended till the matter is finally heard and the judgment is pronounced by Supreme Court. In case of new insurance policies, the regulator said, the policy buyer is allowed six months from the date of commencement of account based relationship to submit the Aadhaar number and PAN/Form 60 to the insurer. The IRDAI said, in absence of Aadhaar, client

shall submit any of the officially valid document as mentioned in the Prevention of Money-Laundering (Maintenance of Records) Rules, 2005. As per norms, Non Resident Indian policy holders are not required to surrender their policy for not having Aadhaar number. In absence of Aadhaar, NRI/Persons of Indian Origin/Overseas Citizens of India too can submit any of the officially valid documents as per the PMLA.

Commercial vehicle owners asked to park vehicles in designated parking spaces

Port Blair, Mar 25 In spite of having designated parking spaces, Commercial Vehicles have been found parked on road side/public places congesting the effective road space. The roads and footpaths are meant exclusively for free flow of vehicular traffic & pedestrians, thereby capturing of roads, footpaths, pavements & way side amenities by illegal & unauthorized parking of vehicles is a strict violation of MV Act.

The State Transport Authority has asked the commercial vehicle owners to park their vehicles in their designated parking space as mentioned in the Permit of the vehicle. They have been directed to refrain from the practice of parking their vehicles on roads, footpaths etc. The vehicle owners have been informed that any commercial vehicle found abandoned or left unattended on a public place or is parked in a place other than its designated

Australian captain Steve Smith, Vice-Captain David Warner step down over ball-tampering row

Cape Town, Mar 25
Australian captain Steve Smith and vice-captain David Warner have stepped down from their positions for the rest of the third Cricket Test against South Africa a day after a ball tampering incident. Smith said yesterday that the team's leadership group had spoken about a plan to taper with the ball, carried out by batsman Cameron Bancroft. Smith admitted that it was a big mistake. Tim Paine will be captain for the rest of the match, although Smith and Warner will continue to play. The ball-tampering incident took



place on the third day of the third Test in Cape Town escalating the tension around what has been an ill-tempered four-match series, which is level at 1-1. Bancroft said, he had been charged by the International Cricket Council with attempting to

change the condition of the ball. Cricket Australia Chief James Sutherland said, the Test match needs to proceed, and in the interim they will continue to investigate the matter with the urgency that it demands.

Federer to lose No. 1 ranking after shock loss to Kokkinakis

Miami, Mar 25
Roger Federer's latest reign atop the world rankings will end after the Swiss great's shock loss to Australian qualifier Thanasi Kokkinakis in the second round of the Miami Masters. Kokkinakis, ranked 175th in the world, needed a wild card just to get into qualifying. But he showed nerves of steel in a 3-6, 6-3, 7-6 (7/4) triumph over 20-time Grand Slam champion Federer. Federer, who won his 20th



Grand Slam crown at the Australian Open, regained the number one spot in February after winning the ATP title in Rotterdam but needed to reach the quarter-finals to remain at the summit. Instead he'll be replaced by Spain's Rafael Nadal when the rankings are released at the

end of the tournament. "I deserve it after this match. That's how I feel. Just so bad," said Federer, adding that he "could never get to any level that I was happy with today". "Sometimes you have these matches," he said. "Sometimes you find a way through. I just couldn't get it done today." The 36-year-old wasted no time in announcing he'll skip the clay-court season, including the French Open, just as he did last year after winning titles in Indian Wells and Miami.

Formula One: Ferrari's Sebastian Vettel wins Australian Grand Prix

Melbourne, Mar 25
Sebastian Vettel won a thrilling duel with world champion Lewis Hamilton to steal the season-opening Australian Formula One Grand Prix in Melbourne on Sunday. The four-time world champion got the jump on the Mercedes ace off a miscalculation on the pit stop under Virtual Safety Car conditions and held off Hamilton for his second straight win in Melbourne and third overall. Ferrari team-mate Kimi Raikkonen held off Australian Red Bull racer Daniel Ricciardo to take third and join Vettel on the podium. It was Vettel's 48th win in his 200th GP and follows his earlier



wins in Melbourne in 2011 for Red Bull and last year for Ferrari. Hamilton, starting off the pole, got out of his car and looked a bit bewildered as he removed his helmet, wondering how exactly that race got away from him. Vettel pitted for a new set of softs and emerged from the pits ahead of Hamilton, gaining around 10 seconds thanks to the deployment of the Virtual Safety Car (VSC). Vettel retained his lead as the race was restarted and built a lead of seven-tenths of a second over Hamilton mid-race. Hamilton made an error as he locked up at turn nine and fell 2.8 seconds behind Vettel with 11 laps remaining.

India women lose to England by 7 wickets in 2nd match of tri-nation T-20

Mumbai, Mar 25
In Women's Cricket, India lost to England by 7 wickets in their second match of the tri-nation Twenty-20 series at the Brabourne Stadium in Mumbai today. Put in to bat, the hosts had posted 198 for 4, riding on Smriti Mandhana's 76 and Mithali Raj's 53. In reply, opener Danielle Wyatt scored her second T-20 century as England overhauled the target with 8 balls to spare. Danielle made 124. Earlier, England had won the toss and opted to field. This was India's second defeat in a row, while for England, it



was their second win. India had lost its opening game against Australia by 6 wickets, while England defeated the Aussies by 8 wickets. All the three sides will face each other twice in the tournament and the top two will make it to the summit clash which will be played on the 31st of this month.
