HM chairs third meeting of Island Development Agency Development projects on anvil in 26 Islands in Andaman & Nicobar and Lakshadweep

Rs. 650 crore investment expected in various projects; Restricted Area Permit regime to be relaxed for tourism promotion

New Delhi, Apr 25
The Union Home Minister, Shri Rajnath Singh, chaired the third meeting of the Island Development Agency (IDA) in Delhi yesterday. The meeting was attended by Lt. Governor of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) Administrator of Lakshadweep, Cabinet Secretary Shri P. K. Sinha, CEO, NITI Aayog Shri Amitabh Kant, Union Home Secretary Shri Rajiv Gauba, Secretary Defence, Secretary Tourism, Secretary Tribal Affairs and other Senior Officers of Central Ministries of Tourism, Power, Defence, Health, Telecommunications and Civil Aviation. Vice Chief of Naval Staff and Air Commodore from Indian Air Force were also present during the meeting. The Island Development Agency reviewed the progress made towards preparation of Development Plans for identified Islands (four in A&N Islands i.e. Smith, Ross, Long, Avis and five in Lakshadweep i.e.



Minicoy, Bangaram, Thinnakara, Cheriya, Suheli). For these Islands, Final Site Suitability Reports have been prepared, Carrying Capacity determined and Environmental zoning carried out to ensure sustainable development. The CEO, NITI Aayog made detailed presentation giving details of actions taken in pursuance to decisions taken in earlier meetings. The Union Home Minister expressed satisfaction at the progress made since its last meeting held on November 8, 2017 when directions were given to identify additional Islands for sustainable

development and also accord priority to key infrastructure projects. Additional Islands/ Locations in Islands, 12 in Andaman and Nicobar (North Passage, Cinque, Inglis, Viper, Neil (Bharatpur Beach), Ramnagar Beach, Karmatang Beach, Dhaninallah Beach, Kalipur Beach, Rutland, North Bay and Great Nicobar - B Quarry) and 5 in Lakshadweep (Kalpeni, Kadmat, Agatti, Chetlat and Bitra) have been identified by NITI Aayog, in consultation with the UT Administrations, for planning of suitable projects aimed at creation

of more jobs for the Islanders. Community-based tourism would be promoted benefiting the Islanders. Key Infrastructure projects such as creation of jetties/berthing facilities, Roll-on/Roll-off ships; Bridges on Andaman Trunk Road; Upgradation of Diglipur Airport; Construction of Minicoy Airport; Modernization of existing Jetty at Kavarati; Augmentation of Satellite Bandwidth from 1.118 Gbps to 2.118 Gbps in Andaman & Nicobar; augmentation of helicopter services for Islanders and tourists etc. are being accorded priority. With

better communication services, Information Technology based and other Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) would be promoted in the Islands. Further, after carrying out systematic study, 18 Projects, both in Andaman & Nicobar and Lakshadweep, have been identified for implementation, out of which 7 Projects are ready for launch through PPP. 3 such projects in Andaman & Nicobar (one each in Long, Smith and Avis Island) and 3 in Lakshadweep (one each in Suheli, Minicoy and

Rs. 98,000 recovered as penalty in a week

Port Blair, April 25

The Port Blair Municipal Council Solid Waste (Handling & Management) Bye-laws 2017 was notified during May 2017. As per the bye-laws, the definition of Bulk Waste Generator means that on an average waste generation rate exceeding 50 kg per day. However, it is noticed that most of the Bulk Waste Generators are violating the Bye-laws. The PBMC has, time and again appealed to the general public to handover the waste generated to the sanitary workers on usual payment specified under Schedule-III of the Bye-

Laws, 2017. In case of any contravention of the Bye-Laws, fine ranging from Rs. 500/- to Rs. 10,000/- as provided in the schedule-I of the Bye-laws shall be imposed for each occasion of offence. In case repetition of the offence, the fine amount will be doubled. In order to keep the city neat and clean, PBMC has intensified the drive and imposing penalties on the violators. It is pertinent to mention here that during the last one week Sanitary Inspectors has levied penalty an amount of Rs. 98,000/- and the same has been recovered.

The PBMC has also

appreciated that the general public are co-operating with the PBMC and their larger co-operation is much needed to implement the bye-laws in efficient & effective manner.

The latest of the Landing Craft Utility (LCU) Mark IV series ship, INLCU L53, was commissioned into the Indian Navy at Port Blair today, by Vice Admiral Bimal Verma, AVSM, ADC, Flag Officer Commander-in-Chief, Andaman and Nicobar Command. The commissioning ceremony was conducted as per naval traditions and witnessed by many senior officers from the Indian Navy, Army, Air Force and Coast Guard. INLCU L-53 is the third of the eight LCU Mark-IV ships designed and built by M/s Garden Reach Ship Builders & Engineers Ltd., Kolkata. Two ships of the same class, INLCU L-51 & L-52 have already been commissioned in 2017. Speaking on the occasion, the Admiral reiterated the importance of indigenization & self-reliance in ship building and congratulated M/s GRSE for having delivered another fine warship to the Indian



Navy. He said that the commissioning of such ships is an important milestone in the Indian Navy's progress from a Buyer's Navy to a Builder's Navy. The Chairman and Managing Director of M/S GRSE, Rear Admiral V K Saxena informed that the ship is also fitted with an Electronic Warfare suite,

company is planning to offer its 100th ship to the Indian Navy during this financial year itself. This ship is equipped with state of the art systems like Integrated Platform Management System and Integrated Bridge Management System. The ship is also fitted with an Electronic Warfare suite,

and day/night capable armament systems. Displacing nearly 1,000 Tonnes, with an endurance of over 1,500 nautical miles, the ship is capable of moving at sustained speed of 12 knots, the maximum speed being 15 knots. The primary role of this ship is amphibious operations,

Saina, Sindhu, Srikanth enter second round of Asia Badminton Championship



Wuhan, April 25
After stupendous success at the recently-concluded Commonwealth Games, top Indian shuttlers Saina Nehwal, P V Sindhu and Kidambi Srikanth made positive starts to their campaign at the Asia Badminton Championship. While Saina and Sindhu registered straight game victories over their respective rivals to enter the second round, Srikanth had to fight it out in his men's singles opener. Saina, who had clinched a gold medal at Gold Coast, continued her good run as she brushed aside Singapore's Yeo Jia Min 21-12 21-9 while Sindhu, who had lost to Saina in the CWG final to settle for the silver, defeated Chinese Taipei's Pai Yu Po 21-14 21-19 in women's singles competition. Former world no 1 Saina will meet China's Gao Fangjie, while Olympic and world championship silver medalist Sindhu, seeded third, faces another Chinese Chen Xiaoxin next. Top seed and

CWG silver medallist Srikanth eked out a come-from-behind 13-21 21-16 21-16 win over Japan's Kenta Nishimoto in men's singles to set up a clash with Hong Kong's Wong Wing Ki Vincent. However, Sameer Verma's fight against seventh seed Chou Tien Chen of Chinese Taipei ended with a 21-23 17-21 loss. The men's doubles pair of Arjun MR and Ramchandran Shlok and women's combo of Meghana Jakkampudi and Poorvisha S Ram too joined the singles stars

in the second round after pulling off thrilling wins in the opening round. Arjun and Ramchandran had to dig deep into their reservoir before seeing off World championship quarterfinalists Chung Eui Seok and Kim Dukyoung of Korea 25-23 23-21, while Meghana and Poorvisha held their nerves in pressure situations to beat Singapore's Ong Ren-Ne and Wong Jia Ying Crystal 14-21 22-20 21-17 in a women's doubles encounter.

India's Jeremy Lalrinnunga (56 kg) registered his best total of 250 kg to win the silver in Youth section and bronze medal in Junior section at the Asian Youth and Junior Weightlifting Championship at Urgench, Uzbekistan. The 15-year-old Lalrinnunga also created two new national record in Youth boys and junior men during his lift of 250 kg. Sidhant Gogoi, 14, finished with bronze medal with a lift of 243 kg in Youth Boys section.



Earlier two Indian women athletes from Orissa won a silver and a bronze medal. Jhilli Dalabehera (48 kg) clinched the silver medal in junior women after lifting 166 kg (73+93), while Sneha Soren (48 kg) lifted 145 kg (63+82) to bag the bronze medal in Youth Girls.

Afghanistan not to play India in Tests in next FTP

Kolkata, April 25
Afghanistan is set to make its Test debut against India in June this year, but after the historic one-off match the two teams will not face each other in the longer format as per the new proposed Future Tours Programme (FTP) set for 2019-2022. Having earned its Test status alongside Ireland in June last

year, Afghanistan is set to take on India in its historic debut in Bengaluru from June 14. Even though Afghanistan will play all top nations, including Australia and England in the new FTP, the Afghanistan Cricket Board (ACB) has failed to secure any other series against India. "India are a tough team to get hold of because they are very busy. Since we are

not in Test Championship, the inaugural Test match is good enough for us. We are playing 14-18 Tests in new FTP cycle," ACB CEO Shafiq Stanikzai said on the penultimate day of the five-day ICC quarterly meeting. "Against India we will be playing only one Test in Bengaluru as per earlier FTP. The new FTP is from 2019 to March 2022," he added.
