## PM launches new scheme for power reforms in rural areas

Patna, Jul 25 (PTI)

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today launched the 'Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana' for power sector reforms in rural areas with a view to ensuring round the clock electricity supply to farmers and rural households. Speaking at the launch of the scheme here, Shri Modi said that development is the panacea for all problems related to poverty and unemployment.

The new power scheme focuses on feeder separation (rural households and agricultural) and strengthening of sub-transmission and distribution infrastructure, including metering at all levels in rural areas.

The scheme is one of the flagship programmes of the Power Ministry and will



facilitate 24x7 supply of electricity. The earlier scheme for rural electrification, Rajiv Gandhi Gramen Vidyutikaran Yojana (RGGVY), which was launched by previous UPA government, has been subsumed in the new scheme as its rural electrification component. The major components of the new scheme are feeder separation; strengthening of sub-

transmission and distribution network; Metering at all levels (input points, feeders and distribution transformers); Micro grid and off grid distribution network & Rural electrification-already sanctioned projects under RGGVY to be completed.

Meanwhile, speaking at the 87th ICAR Foundation Day Celebrations at Patna, the Prime Minister praised

Indian scientists for their work despite budgetary constraints, and emphasized the need for scientific innovations in the agriculture sector to move from "lab to land," so that farmers can benefit from them.

The Prime Minister stressed on the need for value addition in agriculture. He mentioned one of the recent episodes of the radio programme "Mann Ki Baat," where he had spoken about the need to increase production of pulses and oilseeds. He expressed happiness that based on data available so far, there appeared to be a huge increase in the sown area of pulses and oilseeds this year. He said India must aim to become totally self-sufficient in the agriculture sector.

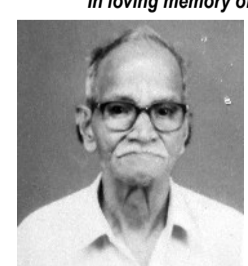

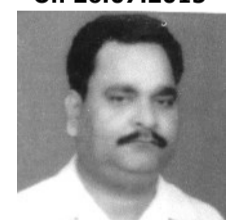

**World's 1st malaria vaccine gets regulatory nod**

New York, July 25  
The world's first malaria vaccine cleared one of the final hurdles as it received a positive scientific opinion from European regulators and now awaits approval from the WHO before it could be administered within the next few years across Africa. The vaccine, named Mosquirix, was Friday given the green light by London-based European Medicines Agency after more than 30 years of research, detailed in 230,000 pages of data. The vaccine will be examined by the WHO which will give



its recommendation in November this year, and if approved, could be administered to children across Africa within the next few years. The WHO said the vaccine will be reviewed for feasibility in field situations in developing countries, its affordability and its cost effectiveness. "It's massively significant,"

said Allan Pamba, vice president for pharmaceuticals in East Africa for GlaxoSmithKline (GSK), which has spent more than USD 356 million to date on finding a vaccine. Researchers and pharmaceutical companies have been trying to develop malaria vaccines for decades. Some vaccines which had been developed in the past failed in their phase three trials. Malaria kills around 600,000 people a year worldwide, most of them children under five in sub-Saharan Africa.

The earlier record was held jointly by Argentina, Peru and Mexico. In these three countries 7,40,870 people had created the record by simultaneous hand-washing on October 14, 2011.
