PM asks officials to address call problem urgently



New Delhi, Aug 25
 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has voiced serious concern over call drops and directed officials to resolve the problem urgently besides ensuring that it does not extend to data connectivity. Reviewing the progress of digital infrastructure, rural infrastructure and connectivity sectors, he also pushed for ensuring the implementation of a proposal to electrify all villages of the country within

1000 days, an announcement he made in his Independence Day address earlier this month. While reviewing the status of mobile connectivity in the country, Shri Modi expressed serious concern over the issue of call drops, which he observed, directly affects the common man, a PMO statement said about the meeting held last evening. He asked officials as to what was being done to address this problem and directed

them that steps be taken urgently to resolve the problem, it said. The Prime Minister also asked the officials to ensure that the problems in voice connectivity do not extend to data connectivity in the future, the statement said. Officials were directed to explore the possibility of leveraging existing resources, including railway and other communication infrastructure, to provide mobile connectivity in remote, unconnected areas.

Govt launches 'Sehat' to provide healthcare facilities in rural areas

New Delhi, Aug 25
 The government today launched a telemedicine initiative Sehat in collaboration with Apollo Hospitals to provide healthcare facilities in rural areas. Under the initiative people will be able to consult doctors through video link and also order generic drugs. The initiative was launched by Communication and IT Minister Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad at a function in New Delhi. Speaking on the occasion, Mr Prasad said that the Common Service Centres (CSCs) have been

delivering tele-consultation services with support from Apollo and Medanta Hospitals in some areas. He said, now with this initiative the tele-consultation services are being extended to 60,000 centres across the country. He said, quality and affordable healthcare is one of the emerging need for citizens in rural areas. He said, the CSCs will also provide diagnostic services and promote sale of generic drugs through collaboration with Health Ministry by setting up Jan Aushadhi Stores.

Govt to extend implementation of APY through post offices soon

New Delhi, Aug 25
 Government will soon extend the benefit of the Atal Pension Yojana (APY) through Post Offices across the country to bring more people under its ambit. Currently the scheme is being implemented through banks. Responding to listeners queries during the Public Speak programme of All India Radio, Chairman of Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority, Shri Hemant Contractor said the implementation of the scheme through post offices will help the people particularly from rural areas to avail its facilities. Financial Services Secretary Hasmukh Adhia said, under the Atal Pension Yojana subscribers can get a fixed minimum



guaranteed monthly pension ranging from one to five thousand rupees at the age of 60 years. He said the pension will be passed on to the spouse on the death of the subscriber and thereafter, the pension corpus would be paid to the nominee. Dr. Adhia said the scheme is open for every section of the society having minimum age of 18 years and maximum 40 years.

Panchayat & Municipal Election-2015

608 more nominations filed on penultimate day

Port Blair, Aug 25
 A total number of 1107 nominations have so far been received for various posts in the Panchayat and Municipal Elections-2015. On the sixth day of filing of nominations today, as many as 608 nominations were received, the highest total so far being 759 for Gram Panchayat Member, followed by 107 for Gram Pradhan, 92 for Panchayat Samiti Member, 89 for Municipal Ward and 60 for Zila Parishad. To bridge the

communication gap in receiving the details of nominations timely from concerned Returning Officers, VHF facility of Police Department is also being used for collection of the same. Meanwhile, it is brought to the knowledge of all Returning Officers and Presiding Officers that adequate care needs to be taken while dealing with electoral roll as it is an essential and equally important component in the process of election.

Accordingly, it has been instructed that the electoral rolls which will have supplementary roll along with the mother roll be scrutinized properly and deletions in the supplementary roll may be first taken into account while verifying the eligibility of any elector prior to issuance of postal ballot. A necessary instruction to this effect is also given to all Presiding officers while using electoral roll in polling stations. A SMS based facility has

been developed to facilitate the voters to know their name, polling station details and voters serial number etc. by typing his/her 10 character EPIC No. e.g. "PRI122868" and sending SMS to 9434289934. Keeping in mind a large number of requests for exemption from election duty it is made explicitly clear that such requests shall be considered in genuine cases and extraordinary circumstances only.

Power sector lights up; LED bulbs in vogue **More than half of India received normal monsoon: IMD**

New Delhi, Aug 25
LED bulbs are slowly but steadily making inroads in middle class families. Special stalls were pitched recently in the government offices complex in New Delhi and people, flaunted ID proof and latest power bill, to purchase LED bulbs at a highly subsidised price. Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi had launched LED based home and street lighting programme on January 5 this year. The plan envisages to cover 100 cities by March next year and balance by March 2019, targeting 77 crore ordinary bulbs and 3.5 crore conventional street lights. "For us LED bulbs are simple mathematics. They save money on power bill, and it should be made freely available in markets if the government is serious in energy conservation", said Ramadheen, a staff member in one of the offices in nearby buildings while watching brisk sale of bulbs. Informatively, 77 crore incandescent bulbs were sold in 2013-14 which if replaced by LEDs will result in reduction of 20,000 MW load and energy savings of 100 billion kWh (Kilowatt hour) every year. Total saving in electricity bills of consumers will be Rs 40,000 crore every year, considering average tariff of Rs 4 per kWh. Average reduction of electricity bill of consumers is pegged at Rs160-400 per year per LED



(light emitting diode). There are 3.5 crore street lights in the country with a load of 3,400 MW which can be reduced to 1,400 MW by replacing conventional street lights with LED based street lights which could lead to saving of about 9,000 million units annually worth Rs 5,500 crore to municipalities annually. Now 100 cities have been taken up for coverage under Street Lighting Programme (SLP) and Domestic Lighting Programme (DELP). As many as 186 cities have been enrolled in the DELP programme. Work has been completed in some places in Andhra Pradesh (Guntur, Anantpur, Srikakulam, West Godavari) and Puducherry. About one crore LEDs have been distributed. Distribution is in progress in Delhi, Jaipur, Ajmer, Jodhpur, Thane, Mulund, Bhandup, Ratnagiri, Kanpur and Varanasi. Agreements with 63 cities were signed in Andhra Pradesh, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Delhi NCR and

agreements with 68 more (Maharashtra, UP, AP and Himachal Pradesh) are in final stages. The government plans to distribute 15 crore LEDs by March 2016. Officials say 302 ULBS have enrolled in the programme. Meanwhile, work in six ULBS - Vizag, Jhalawar, Mt Abu, Pushkar, Neelimarna and Agartala has been completed with 2,07,00 street lights replacement. Installation is in progress in 88 ULBs in Delhi, Rajasthan and AP to replace 9.3 lakh lights. Agreements with 90

Researchers are 'one step closer' to universal flu vaccine

Washington, Aug 25
Researchers say they are closer to developing a vaccine to give life-long protection against any type of flu, after promising trials in animals. Two separate US teams have found success with an approach that homes in on a stable part of the flu virus. That should remove the

Amid LED bulbs replacing ordinary bulbs and CFLs, officials giving overall power scenario, say power generation growth was highest this year in 20 years - 8.4%, coal production growth most in 23 years - 8.3%, and solar capacity increased by 42%. On the emerging scenario, Power Minister, Shri Piyush Goyal says a slew of measures were taken to ensure 24x7 power supply round the year. Steps are under way to amend the electricity bill. Future plans launched include more than five-fold increase in renewable energy capacity to 175,000 MW by 2022 (Organised Renewables Financing Conference, RE-Invest 2015 which attracted commitments of 273,000 MW) and five new UMPPs (ultra mega power projects) in plug-n-play mode (total 20,000 MW). Other aims are

reduction in peak load shortages through revival of stranded gas based power plants through transparent e-bidding, Rs 1.09 lakh crore investment in sub-transmission and distribution through Deen Dayal Upadhyay Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY) and Integrated Power Development Scheme (IPDS) and Rs. 1 lakh crore of new transmission projects to be bid out in the current year. Clean energy will be prioritised with 25 solar parks of about 100 MW each planned and a Rs 38,000 crore green energy corridor being set up to transmit renewable energy.

New Delhi, Aug 25
More than half of India has received normal rainfall while some regions in central and southern parts have got deficient rains so far. According to the India Meteorological Department data, of the 36 sub-divisions across the country, 20 have received normal monsoon. The data shows that 58 per cent of the country has received normal rainfall, 29 per cent witnessed deficient and 13 per cent excess. Overall, a deficiency of nine per cent was recorded in the whole country. Among the



four divisions, northwest received the most rains with only two per cent lesser than the normal levels followed by a deficit of six per cent in the east and north east, 11 per cent in central India and 20 per cent in southern peninsula. In a positive sign, no sub-division has recorded "scanty" or "no-rain" precipitation.

World's oldest flowering plant may be 130-million-year-old

Washington, Aug 25
Scientists have identified a 125 million- to 130 million-year-old freshwater plant, a contemporary of dinosaurs, as one of earliest flowering plants on Earth. The finding represents a major change in the presumed form of one of the planet's earliest flowers, known as angiosperms, researchers said. "This discovery raises significant questions about the early evolutionary history of flowering plants, as well as the role of these plants in the evolution of other plant and animal life," said David Dilcher, paleobotanist at the Indiana University in US. The aquatic

plant, *Montsecchia vidalii*, once grew abundantly in freshwater lakes in what are now mountainous regions in Spain. Fossils of the plant were first discovered more than 100 years ago in the limestone deposits of the Iberian Range in central Spain and in the Montsec Range of the Pyrenees, near the country's border with France. Also previously proposed as one of the earliest flowers is *Archaeofructus sinensis*, an aquatic plant found in China. "A 'first flower' is technically



a myth, like the 'first human,'" said Dilcher. "But based on this new analysis, we know now that *Montsecchia* is contemporaneous, if not more ancient, than *Archaeofructus*," he said. "The reinterpretation of these fossils provides a fascinating new perspective on a major mystery in plant biology," said Donald H Les, a professor of ecology and evolutionary biology at the University of Connecticut.

Based on the recommendations of the Committee and after due scrutiny, Anoop and Naval's names were approved on the basis of current performance (2011-2014), while Nihar Amin (swimming), S. R. Singh (boxing) and Harbans Singh (athletics) were selected in the 'Lifetime Achievement Category' in which achievements over a period of 20 years is taken into account.

The award, instituted in 1985, is given to honour eminent coaches who have successfully trained sportspersons or teams and enabled them to achieve outstanding results in international competitions. Three-time national champion and international wrestler, Anoop has guided top grapplers such as Sushil Kumar, Yogeshwar Dutt, Satyawart Kadian, Bajrang, Amit Dahiya, and around 58 wrestlers to achieve their dream. Romeo James (hockey), Shiv Prakash Mishra (tennis) and TPP Nair's (volleyball) names were approved for the Dhyana Chand Award. For Rashtriya Khel Protsahana Purushkar, Directorate General

of Military Training was selected in 'identification and nurturing of budding/young talent' category, while Coal India Limited has been nominated in 'encouragement to sports through corporate social responsibility' category. Sports Coaching Foundation, Hyderabad has been in 'sports for development' category. Dronacharya awardees and Dhyana Chand awardees will receive statuettes, certificates and award money of Rs. 5 lakh each. Rashtriya Khel Protsahana Puruskar awardees will receive certificates and trophies. The awards are to be given away by President Pranab Mukherjee on August 29, National Sports Day.

ICC rankings: Kohli drops out of top 10, Ashwin moves up

Dubai, Aug 25 India's Test captain Virat Kohli has dropped out of ICC's top-10 list for batsmen in the five-day format, but R. Ashwin's remarkable outing in the ongoing series against Sri Lanka helped him earn a place to eighth in bowling while holding the second spot in the all-rounders' rankings. Meanwhile, Sri Lankan batting legend Kumar Sangakkara finished his glorious career at seventh spot while another illustrious retiree, Australian captain Michael Clarke has finished his 115-Test career in 25th spot. Sangakkara, who scored 32 and 18 in Sri Lanka's 278 runs defeat at the P. Sara Oval, first reached No. 1 in the Test batting rankings in December 2007 against England after innings of 92 and 152 in Kandy. Sangakkara spent a total of 97 Tests and 812 days as the No. 1 Test batsman in the world and was last number-one in December 2014, before losing the top spot to AB de Villiers. His highest-ever points tally was 938, achieved on 1 December 2007, and that total is the highest-ever achieved by a Sri



Lanka batsman to date and the joint sixth-highest of all-time. While Clarke surged to the top of the rankings in August 2009 and did so for the last time in February 2013. During this period, he topped the batting rankings on several occasions

(totalling 11 Tests and 70 days). Clarke is one of the 30 internationals, including eight Australia batsmen, to reach 900 points, which was incidentally his highest points tally that was achieved after the 2012 Boxing Day Test against Sri Lanka.

World Championships: Usain Bolt, Justin Gatlin cruise into 200m semi-finals

Beijing, Aug 25 Usain Bolt and Justin Gatlin cruised into the semi-finals of the men's 200m at the world championships in Beijing on Tuesday. Just two days after their explosive 100m showdown at the Bird's Nest in which Bolt came out victorious by just one-hundredth of a second, the Jamaican clocked 20.28 seconds to win his heat. Bolt eased up with fully 50 metres to go after he came off the bend ahead of the field in a first successful step in his bid to

retain his world sprint double. Gatlin, who has served two doping bans and whose defeat by Bolt was heralded by some as symbolic given the doping issues in which track and field finds itself mired, dominated his heat, winning easily in 20.19sec. Also going through will be Japanese teenager Abdul Hakim Sani Brown, the 16-year-old clocking 20.35sec behind Gatlin in an impressive first outing in the worlds. The semi-finals are scheduled for Wednesday and the final on Thursday.

Countdown for launch of GSAT-6 to start today

Bengaluru, Aug 25 The countdown for the Thursday launch of India's latest communication satellite GSAT-6 will begin tomorrow, Indian Space Research Organisation said today. Mission Readiness Review (MRR) committee and Launch Authorisation Board (LAB) have cleared the starting of the 29-hr countdown at 1152 hrs, ISRO said. The launch of Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle (GSLV) D6 carrying GSAT-6 is scheduled at 1652 hours on August 27 from Satish Dhawan Space Centre at the spaceport of Sriharikota in Andhra Pradesh. GSAT-6 is the 25th geostationary communication satellite of India built by ISRO and 12th in the GSAT series. GSAT-6 provides communication

through five spot beams in S-band and a national beam in C-band for strategic users, ISRO said. The cuboid shaped GSAT-6 has a lift-off mass of 2117 kg. Of this, propellants weigh 1132 kg and the dry mass of the satellite is 985 kg, it added. One of the advanced features of GSAT-6 satellite is its S-Band Unfurlable Antenna of 6 m diameter. This is the largest satellite antenna realised by ISRO. This antenna is utilised for five spot beams over the Indian mainland. The spot beams exploit the frequency reuse scheme to increase frequency spectrum utilisation efficiency, ISRO

said. ISRO said after satellite's injection into GTO (Geosynchronous Transfer Orbit) by GSLV-D6, ISRO's Master Control Facility (MCF) at Hassan takes control of GSAT-6 and performs the initial orbit raising manoeuvres by repeatedly firing the Liquid Apogee Motor (LAM) on board the satellite, finally placing it in the circular Geostationary Orbit. After this, deployment of the antenna and three axis stabilisation of the satellite will be performed. GSAT-6 will be positioned at 83 deg East longitudes, it added. The mission life of the satellite is for nine years.

Port Blair, Aug 25 Heavy rain (07-12 cm) may occur at isolated places over Andaman and Nicobar Islands during next 48 hours. Under the influence of moderate to strong South West monsoon current, strong Southwesterly wind speed between 30 and 40 kilometer per hour gusting to 45 kilometer per hour and generally rough seas is likely along and off Andaman and Nicobar coast. Fishermen have been advised to be cautious while venturing in to the sea.
