Asian Games 2026: Suruchi Singh-Kamaljeet win India's first shooting gold with 10m air pistol mixed team title

Hangzhou, Sept 25

Suruchi Singh and Kamaljeet delivered India their first gold medal in shooting at the Asian Games 2026 on Friday, by winning the 10m air pistol mixed team title. The Indian pair shot an Asian record 484.6 in the final at the Aichi Prefectural General Shooting Gallery to beat the Republic of Korea, who finished second with 478.0. Islamic Republic of Iran took bronze with 415.8. It was India's first Asian Games gold medal in the 10m air pistol mixed team event, improving on the silver won by Sarabjot Singh and Divya TS at Hangzhou 2023.

Indian women's kabaddi team sails into Asian Games final

Nagoya, Sept 25

The Indian women's kabaddi team stayed on course for a fourth consecutive Asian Games gold after marching into the finals with a 48-24 triumph over Nepal in Nagoya on Friday.

The comprehensive win also kept the defending champions' unbeaten run in the ongoing edition intact. India established a sizeable 31-17 lead in the first half, including four all-out and four bonus points. Nepal could never challenge India enough and managed to gather only seven more points in the second half.

The women's team earlier claimed consecutive victories by defeating Iran, Bangladesh and Japan in the group stages. Women's kabaddi became an Asian Games sport for the first time in 2010 and India have dominated every edition so far. India are the defending champions in the men's event as well. The team will be up against Thailand in its semifinal clash.

Asian Games: Gulveer Singh wins silver in men's 10,000m

Aichi-Nagoya, Sept 25

Gulveer Singh created Indian athletics history by becoming the first Indian to win two Asian Games medals in the men's 10,000m after securing silver at the Mizuho Park Athletic Stadium here on Friday. Gulveer clocked 28:29.38 in the 25-lap race to finish second, adding the silver to the bronze he won in the event at the 2023 Asian Games in Hangzhou. He is now the first Indian to stand on the Asian Games podium twice in the men's 10,000m.



Bahrain's Birhanu Balew won gold in 28:27.51, finishing 1.87 seconds ahead of Gulveer, while his compatriot Albert Kiptoo took bronze in 28:34.38. China's Wang Wenjie finished fourth in 28:38.14.

Asian Games 2026: Indian men's kabaddi team storms into finals, demolishes Thailand 66-28

Kakamigahara, Sept 25

Indian men's kabaddi team booked their title defence clash at the ongoing Asian Games 2026 at Aichi-Nagoya on Friday, thrashing Thailand in a largely one-sided semifinal.

India defeated Thailand 66-28, and the eight-time men's kabaddi champions at the Asian Games will now defend their crown against either Iran or Chinese Taipei on Saturday. The Indian men's kabaddi team started off the semifinal clash on a dominating note, taking a 7-1 lead within the first five

minutes. However, Thailand, courtesy of some fine performances from Theerarat Chaisit, who put in a raid to win three points and made Team India get all out, managed a fightback and reduced the deficit to 14-23. Theerarat continued being a lone warrior for his team, but India led 37-18 at half-time. With 11 minutes to go in the match, India hit the 50-point mark, leading Thailand 50-23. India continued to dominate in the final few minutes of the match, with Thailand not getting any space to breathe.

Baranica Elangovan wins Bronze in Women's Pole Vault at Asian Games

Aichi-Nagoya, Sept 25

Indian athlete Baranica Elangovan won the bronze medal in the women's pole vault at the Asian Games at Aichi-Nagoya in Japan today. This marks country's first-ever medal in the pole vault event at the Asian Games.

The 29-year-old athlete secured the podium finish with a best clearance of 4.15 metres. While her compatriot Sindhu Shree Ganesh exited the competition without registering a mark, Baranica stayed in strong contention, navigating the field as Japan's



Misaki Morota led the event. This achievement caps off a standout year for Baranica.
