- Spices like Haldi (Turmeric), Jeera (Cumin), Dhaniya (Coriander) and Lahsun (Garlic) are recommended in cooking.

AYUSH Hospital and its others branches located at different places from Diglipur to Campbell Bay. Consuming 1-2 tea spoon of Chawanprash on empty stomach will be very helpful in boosting immunity. Diabetic patients can take sugar free chawanprash, he said. These medicines have proved to be boosting the body's immunity and it is being included in the kits provided to the ILI / SARI and contact of COVID positive patients in A&N Islands.

during the present pandemic period. He suggested to avoid foods like curds, banana, cooled drinks, refrigerated items which may trigger respiratory symptoms. Drinking 150 ml of herbal tea/ decoction (made by boiling tulsi (Basil), dachini (Cinnamon), kalimirch, ginger, munaka (raisin) in water and consuming it by adding jaggery or fresh lemon juice once or twice a day will be very helpful in fighting viruses. Gargling with warm water twice a day, steam inhalation and daily practice of yoga, pranayama and meditation will also help in fighting the viral infections. These measures are advocated in addition to the COVID appropriate behaviour, he added.
To avoid overcrowding at AYUSH Hospital, the general public can consult doctors through telephone and highlight their health problems. The district wise figure administering of COVISHIELD doses to the eligible beneficiaries on April 25 by the Health Department states that in South Andaman 913 persons above 45+ were administered the vaccine, in North & Middle Andaman District 278 persons and in Nicobar District 53 were vaccinated, a press release from DHS said.



Over 14 crore 9 lakh Covid-19 vaccine doses administered in country so far

New Delhi, April 25
India's vaccination drive against COVID-19 crossed another milestone today with administration of over 14 crore 9 lakh doses within 99 days of the World's largest vaccination programme. The Health Ministry has informed that with more than 25 lakh 36 thousand doses of COVID vaccine administered in the last 24 hours, India has become the fastest country to administer over 14 crore doses in a record time.
Since Prime Minister Narendra Modi's clarion call for maximum and best utilisation of health resources in the country, the number of total Covid Vaccination Centres have increased significantly. The number of Covid Vaccination Centres in the country increased from nearly 45 thousand to nearly 65 thousand registering a growth of over 20 thousand centres in a short span of time.
The Health Ministry has informed that so far more than 11 crore 85 lakh people in the country have received the first dose of COVID vaccine whereas nearly 2 crore 22 lakh have been fully vaccinated with both the required doses. From the 1st of next month, which is also the third phase of the largest vaccination drive, everyone above the age of 18 years will be eligible to take COVID vaccines. The registration for the 3rd phase will begin this Wednesday on the cowin platform and Aarogya Setu App.
