## India, Seychelles ink six agreements in several fields

New Delhi, Jun 25 India and Seychelles signed six agreements on Monday in several fields including education, cyber security, and cultural exchange. The agreements were signed following delegation-level talks between Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi and President of Seychelles, Mr Danny Antoine Rollen Faure in New Delhi. Both the leaders reviewed the wide-ranging cooperation between the two countries, especially in the fields of defence and security. The visiting dignitary was given a



ceremonial reception at the Rashtrapati Bhawan Monday morning. He also met External Affairs

Minister Smti Sushma Swaraj earlier in the day. They discussed expanding bilateral cooperation in all areas, specially capacity building, human resource development and people-to-people contacts.

## Govt creating robust framework for promoting infrastructure investment in India: FM

New Delhi, Jun 25 Finance Minister Shri Piyush Goyal has said the growing need for multi-development bank in the Asian context resonates with the thrust given by Narendra Modi Government towards creating infrastructure. He was speaking at the Press Conference during the ongoing third meeting of the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank. He said the Bank has matured in a very short period of time, and is rapidly progressing to be one of the world's most important infrastructure financiers. The Minister said neither



the Government of India nor any state govt has, in 70 years, had a single international default. This has made India a good investment destination for

Infrastructure, he emphasized. The Minister also informed that the Bank has already funded six projects in India worth 1.2 billion USD and one more

project has been approved. He also said that the Government is focusing on creating infrastructure by promoting renewable energy and smart cities.

### Monsoon Session of Parliament from July 18 to Aug 10



New Delhi, Jun 25 The Monsoon session of Parliament will be held from 18th July till 10th August. Parliamentary Affairs Minister Shri Ananth Kumar said, it will have eighteen working days. Government is expected to push for Constitutional status for National Commission for

OBC. Other important bills including Triple Talaq, Trans gender Bill, will also be brought in Parliament for passing them. Shri Ananth Kumar said the Government expects constructive cooperation from all political parties to make the monsoon session productive.

### Supreme Court notifies new roster for judges



New Delhi, Jun 25 The Supreme Court has notified a new roster for the allocation of cases to the judges, which will come into effect from July 2 when the top court reopens after summer vacation. The new roster which was released yesterday said that the bench headed Chief Justice of India Dipak Misra

will hear all public interest litigations, besides pleas relating to social justice, elections, habeas corpus and contempt of court. Justice Ranjan Gogoi, who is the senior-most judge after the Chief Justice following the retirement of Justice Chelameswar on June 22, will deal with labour

### PBMC to recommence its drive against encroachments

**No fresh notices to be issued; encroachers asked to vacate voluntarily**  
**Vehicles parked in unauthorized places will be seized**

Port Blair, June 25 The Port Blair Municipal Council will soon recommence its drive against illegal encroachments in its limits. A few months ago, the civic body had swung into action and removed the encroachments on the roads, pavements, platforms and drainage canals in several areas. In a press release received here today, the Secretary, PBMC, Shri Suneel Anchipaka said, under this drive, the PBMC would remove all new encroachments which have cropped up in the

Municipal areas. No fresh notices would be issued to such encroachers. The authority also said that those who encroach upon such places of the municipality should come forward voluntarily to vacate. The PBMC Secretary has asked the residents to desist from doing the unauthorized acts such as erecting grill-fence over on public platform and converting platform into car parking area of their own. They should remove such grill-fence immediately and should not raise the platform.

Such kind of raised platforms cause hardships to pedestrians. The civic body, without prior notice, will remove ramps constructed on platform for any individual's convenience and the expenses would be recovered from the encroacher, the release said. The Secretary, Port Blair Municipal Council also said the municipality would seize the vehicles parked in unauthorized parking places. Pushcarts will be seized if they are parked on road side disrupting free flow of

traffic. The shops mushroomed on platforms or pavements causing hurdle to traffic and free movement of pedestrians will be removed. Those running shops on own buildings or show rooms should not extend their business activities to the platforms, the release added.

Port Blair, June 25 The Secretary (Agriculture/Animal Husbandry/Fisheries), Andaman & Nicobar Administration, Shri Ramesh Verma visited North and Middle Andaman recently. Chairing a meeting with Assistant Commissioner, Diglipur, officials of Agriculture Department, PRIs and progressive farmers of Diglipur zone in the conference hall of APWD Guest House, the Secretary discussed the

flagship programmes being implemented by the Department like Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana, Soil Health Card, Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojana and Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana. **Deepika Kumari wins individual recurve gold at Salt Lake World Cup**

Salt Lake City, US, June 25 Archer Deepika Kumari won her first individual gold medal in six years at the Salt Lake World Cup following a 7-3 win over Germany's Michelle Kroppen in the recurve final. The win ensured Deepika will represent the country at the season-ending Archery World Cup Final in Samsun, Turkey in October. "Finally! That's what I said when I won this gold medal," said Deepika after four silver medal finishes.

In six appearances at the Archery World Cup, Deepika had come back with silver medals in 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2015 but this time she finally got the elusive yellow metal. The last time she won a stage medal was back in 2015 but the last time she won at a stage event on the international circuit goes even further back to Antalya in 2012.

Against her stood indoor world



team champion Kroppen who will be the highest ranked German recurve archer following the tournament. Making her first individual event final, Kroppen had her task cut out from the get go as she was aware she was averaging 9.08 points per arrow compared to Deepika's 9.21 points per arrow.

In the final, Deepika started off better by taking the opening set 29-28 and taking a 2-0 set lead. Both shot 10, 9 and 9 in

the second set to stand level at 28-28 which brought the match down to 3-1. Kroppen won the third set 27-26 and levelled the match at 3-3. Deepika showed her experience in the final two sets as the pressure started to kick in. Kroppen shot a 7 on her third arrow to hand the fourth set (29-26) to the Indian archer. With all to do in the final set, Kroppen scored 8 points on her third arrow and Deepika won the fifth set 27-26 and with that, the match.

**Junior Shooting World Cup: Punjab, Haryana combo power India to pistol gold**

Chandigarh, June 25 Punjab lad Arjun Cheema, a 17-year-old shooting prodigy from Mandi Gobindgarh, and Haryana's Anmol Jain, a 20-year-old marksman from Faridabad, helped India win the team gold in the 50 metre free pistol event in the ongoing ISSF Junior Shooting World Cup on Sunday.

Gaurav Rana, who represents Air Force in national championships, was the third member of the Indian team. The championship is being held in Suhl, Germany. India clinched five medals - two gold, one silver and a couple of bronze medals - on the day. Besides the team gold, Anmol also bagged a bronze in the 50 metre free pistol individual event with a score of 549.

The women's team comprising Neha, Devanshi Dhama and Anushka Patil also gunned down the team gold in women's 50 metre free pistol event. Neha



also won the silver in women's 50 metre free pistol individual event, while Devanshi had to settle for the bronze. She trailed Neha by a solitary point. Neha's cumulative score was 528 - just 2 points behind gold medal winner Yulyana Rohach of Belarus.

In only his second world cup, Arjun has been in scintillating form this year. He helped India to a team gold during the ISSF Junior World Cup in Sydney, earlier this year. Arjun is also

an ace swimmer, and had represented the country in an international junior swimming championship in Austria in 2014.

Seeing little scope of progress in swimming in the country, Arjun gave up the sport and turned to shooting. However, his school timings weren't suitable and was affecting his shooting career. So he joined a private school in his hometown in order to focus on his game.

**India beat Olympic champions Argentina 2-1 in Champions Trophy**

New Delhi, June 25

India avenged their loss semifinal loss at the 2017 Hockey World League Final in December with a 2-1 win over Olympic champions Argentina in the second game of the Champions Trophy. This is India's second game and second win of the tournament after beating Pakistan on Saturday. Goals from Harmanpreet Singh (17') and Mandeep Singh (28') had India in the lead before Gonzalo Peillat (30') reduced the deficit. The win ensures India maintain their place at the top of the Champions Trophy.

Both teams came into the contest on the back of wins on the opening. India over Pakistan and Argentina over Netherlands. There was little to separate the two teams in the first quarter with defence being stretched on either ends. Stick check by Jarmanpreet Singh while tackling Matias Paredes saw India concede the first



penalty corner. That count turned into three following Harmanpreet's brave defending as an onrushing player. Eventually, Argentina failed to score and ended the first quarter in a stalemate.

Two minutes into the second quarter, India scored the opener when a deliberate foul by Maico Casella while tackling Harmanpreet Singh fetched India their first PC. Perfect inektion by Sardar Singh, playing his 300th game, was further improvised by Harmanpreet who kept it low and powerful to beat the keeper. The 1-0 lead in the

17th minute aided India forward and surge to get a second. India doubled their advantage in the 28th minute when a brilliant aerial pass was perfectly picked up by Dilpreet Singh who cautiously played it across the face of goal to Mandeep Singh who made no mistake in deflecting it past the Argentine goalkeeper.

Argentina reduced the deficit immediately with a strong attack, as they forced an error to win a PC in the 30th minute. Peillat thundered a fierce hit in the corner of the goal to beat PR Sreejesh.

**Novak Djokovic ready for Wimbledon despite Queen's final defeat**

London, June 25

Less than a month after casting doubt over his participation at Wimbledon, Novak Djokovic is heading for the tournament as a genuine title contender. Despite coming up just short in a 5-7, 7-6 (4), 6-3 loss to Marin Cilic in the Queen's Club final on Sunday, Djokovic produced one of his best performances since missing the second half of 2017 with an elbow injury. Cilic saved a match point at 4-5 in the second set and then won six consecutive points from 4-1 down in the tiebreaker to level, before going on to win his second title at the Wimbledon warmup.



Djokovic was left in far more optimistic mood than when he came off the court after a French Open quarterfinal defeat to Marco Cecchinato on June 5. "Well, I'm there," said Djokovic, when asked if he's back to top form, singing out his earlier win against Grigor Dimitrov "in straight sets, all straight sets until

today... all in all, I think that the level of my tennis has been as good as it has been the last 12 months."

Djokovic appeared untouchable when completing his career Grand Slam at the 2016 French Open, but his only major final since then came at the U.S. Open later that season.


