MoHUA rolls out Safai Apnao, Bimaari Bhagao initiative under SBM-U 2.0 Initiative aims to enhance preparedness of ULBs to handle challenges associated with cleanliness and diseases during monsoon season

New Delhi, June 25 (PIB) Come monsoon and the challenges of cleanliness and sanitation are heightened. With this increases the prevalence of waterborne and vector-borne diseases. Recognizing the critical importance of proactive measures to mitigate health risks associated with monsoon, the Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban 2.0 under the aegis of the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA), introduces the Safai Apnao, Bimaari Bhagao (SABB) (1st July to 31st Aug., 2024) initiative. This initiative seeks to enhance the preparedness of Urban Local Bodies, ensuring they are well-equipped to handle the challenges posed by heavy rainfall and heightened health risks during the months of June to August.

Departments and inter-sectoral convergence to deal with the multifaceted challenges associated with cleanliness and diseases during the monsoon season. The need of the hour is to ensure a comprehensive approach through various initiatives around cleanliness and sanitation in the ULBs.

The Safai Apnao, Bimaari Bhagao initiative calls for comprehensive interventions focusing on swachhata, advocacy and inter-departmental convergence to be implemented by all ULBs. The key elements of the campaign will include special cleanliness drives, collection and transportation of waste,

regular cleaning of all community and public toilets, sanitation and hygiene facilities for children, adequate sampling of water quality, supply of safe drinking water, maintenance of water works and planning for IEC and door-to-door mobilization. The initiative also envisages rapid assessments to identify high-risk areas,

adoption of Protect Prevent Treat Strategy (PPTS) and coordination & monitoring. The pre-monsoon and monsoon preparedness activities for 8 weeks will comprise various launching events on Diarrhoea management, drives to ensure visibly higher order of cleanliness, (Contd. on last page)

Pahargaon Police cracks multiple burglary cases and recovers gold ornaments worth Rs. 40 lakhs

Port Blair, June 25 In a resolute demonstration of zero tolerance towards crime, the South Andaman District Police have successfully resolved a series of house burglary cases, resulting in recovery of approx. 600gms of stolen gold ornaments valued at Rs 40 lakhs and the apprehension of the perpetrator.

Between June 16 and June 21, a spate of house burglaries were reported in Port Blair, leading to 04 FIRs being lodged at Pahargaon and Chatham Police Stations U/s 457/380 of IPC vide FIR Nos 103/24 dated 16/06/2024, 109/24 & 110/24 dated 21/06/24 at Pahargaon and 38/24 dated 17/06/2024 at Chatham. These incidents occurred during the absence of house owners with their residences being locked from the outside, providing an easy opportunity for the accused to execute the crimes. The burglar targeted jewelry and cash in all instances. Under the leadership of Inspector Rahul,

SHO PS Pahargaon, a dedicated team comprising of SI S Viswanand, SI Sudhir Kumar, HCs Ravi Kumar Limbu, Sunil Singh Yadav and PCs Ashish Kr. Singh, D Shiv Kumar, S N Pathak, Neelkanth & Santosh Lall was constituted. The team conducted an exhaustive search, collected fingerprints from the crime scenes, utilized sniffer dogs and meticulously reviewed approximately 15 kilometers of CCTV footage. These efforts led to the identification and arrest of the culprit, facilitating the recovery of approx. 600 gms of stolen gold ornaments valued at approximately Rs 40 lakhs.

The accused identified is Irshad Azad, S/o Abdul Azad, 29yrs old, Pvt. Worker, R/o Shadipur, who was also previously arrested in 16 lakh gold jewelry theft case at PS Aberdeen vide FIR 25/24 dated 29/01/2024. The accused knew about CCTV cameras in the area. Before entering their view, he

covered his face to avoid being recognized. He used different hidden paths to reach the victims' homes and left by different routes to hide his movements. The breakthrough in the case underscores the meticulous investigative approach, leveraging advanced CCTV analysis, intelligence gathering and cohesive team work.

The entire operation took place under the close supervision of Shri Vikas, IPS, Sub Divisional Police Officer, South Andaman and the overall supervision of Smti Niharika Bhatt, IPS, Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District. The general public have been encouraged to install CCTV cameras in their homes and promptly report any suspicious activity to the Police via 112 or the contact numbers 03192-232100, 03192-236641 and 03192-250525. The identity of the informant will be kept secret, a press release from SP (SA) said.

that the boat, which had departed from Junglight harbour, Port Blair for fishing on 13th June, 2024 with nine crew, was experiencing seawater ingress from the propeller shaft entrance and a loss of propulsion due to engine pulley misalignment.

The technical crew promptly arrested the flooding and realigned the engine pulley to restore propulsion. Despite the adverse sea conditions, the ICGS Rajkiran successfully transferred the fishing boat to ICGS C-414 at 2330 hours on 20th June, 2024. ICGS C-414 then escorted the vessel to Campbell Bay Harbour for defect rectification and safety measures.
