## अपील



प्यारे द्वीपवासियों,

माननीय प्रधानमंत्री जी ने पिछली "मन की बात" में कहा था - "...आपकी सतर्कता ही आपको कोरोना से बचायेगी। इस बात को हमेशा याद रखिये कि अगर आप mask नहीं पहनते हैं, दो गज की दूरी का पालन नहीं करते हैं, या फिर, दूसरी जरूरी सावधानियां नहीं बरतते हैं, तो, आप अपने साथ - साथ दूसरों को भी जोखिम में डाल रहे हैं, खास-तौर पर, घर के बच्चों और बुजुर्गों को, इसीलिये, सभी देशवासियों से मेरा निवेदन है और ये निवेदन मैं बार-बार करता हूँ कि आप लापरवाही मत बरतिये, अपना भी ख्याल रखिये, और, दूसरों का भी..."। वे पहले भी कह चुके हैं कि "हम लापरवाह हो जाएँ, सावधानी छोड़ दें, ये कोई विकल्प नहीं हैं"।

हमारे द्वीपों में आज 85 active cases की संख्या देखते लगता है कि लोग इस महामारी को गम्भीरता से नहीं ले रहे और सावधानियाँ बरतने की अपनी जिम्मेदारी नहीं निभा रहे हैं, जिससे तेजी से बढ़ रहा संक्रमण गम्भीर होता जा रहा है। एक महीने से ज्यादा COVID free रहने के बाद 25 मई से जब flights शुरू

होनी थी, तब माननीय सांसद और विभिन्न राजनैतिक दलों के निर्वाचित प्रतिनिधियों से सलाह करके व online registrations को देखते हुए प्रशासन ने stranded द्वीपवासियों, students अथवा अन्य लोगों की पोर्ट ब्लेयर व मुख्यभूमि के बीच आवागमन की संख्या का बहुत नजदीकी तक हिसाब लगा लिया था। यह संख्या flights आरम्भ होने के दो सप्ताह के भीतर ही पूरी हो चुकी थी। लेकिन उस संख्या से लगभग पाँच गुना से भी अधिक, अब तक 36000 से ज्यादा लोगों का आवागमन, उन शहरों से जहाँ COVID -19 का संक्रमण सबसे गम्भीर है, हो चुका है व लगातार जारी है। अभी भी हर दिन 500 - 600 हवाई यात्रियों का आना जाना हो रहा है जिसमें कोई बाहर वाले नहीं हैं और इस संख्या में कोई कमी नहीं आ रही है। यह साफ दर्शाता है कि लोगों का इतनी बड़ी संख्या में लगातार आना जाना बहुत जरूरी यात्रा की श्रेणी में तो नहीं हो सकता। साथ ही पिछले 2-3 दिनों से Contacts cases में बड़ी संख्या में वृद्धि यह दर्शाती है कि लोग Basic Safety Protocols जिसकी जिम्मेदारी उनकी स्वयं की है, जैसे - Mask पहनना, 'दो गज की दूरी', Social Distancing, नियमित हाथ धोना/ Sanitizer का उपयोग, इत्यादि का पालन नहीं कर रहे हैं।

द्वीपों में Testing लगभग 53,000 Test Per Million पर देश के सबसे अग्रणी राज्यों में से है। केन्द्र सरकार की guidelines से भी आगे बढ़कर प्रशासन सभी को स्वास्थ्य सुविधायें जैसे बाहर के द्वीपों में जाने वाले लोगों व Vulnerable groups का Institutional Quarantine, नियमित रूप से House - to - House surveillance, इत्यादि लगातार करता रहा है। लेकिन यदि द्वीपवासी अपनी जिम्मेदारी पूरी तरह से नहीं निभायेंगे तो Health Infrastructure के लिये यह एक बहुत गम्भीर चुनौती बन जायेगा। सभी को ध्यान देने की जरूरत है कि प्रशासन की Healthcare सुविधायें असीमित नहीं हैं।

मैं आप सबसे COVID से सुरक्षा में अपनी जिम्मेदारी निभाने की अपेक्षा रखता हूँ व फिर से निवेदन करता हूँ कि अनावश्यक यात्रायें न करें, SOPs का उल्लंघन न करें तथा लापरवाही न बरतते हुए एक सजग द्वीपवासी के रूप में अपना और अपने प्रियजनों का ख्याल रखें व प्रशासन का सहयोग करें।

## Steps to contain spread of COVID-19 in South Andaman District

### Office/workplaces to have staggered working hours with 50% capacity except for those providing essential services

Port Blair, July 25

In order to ensure effective compliance of National directives on COVID-19 management and to contain the spread of COVID-19 in the South Andaman District, the District Magistrate, South Andaman District in an Order No. 861 dated July 25 by virtue of powers vested under the Disaster Management Act, 2005 has issued various directions.

The order states that offices/work places (Both Govt. and Private) should have staggered working hours and should operate at 50% capacity except for those

providing essential services like Health, ANIIMS, PBMC, APWD, Electricity, Revenue Department, Shipping, Transport, Civil Supplies, Police Department etc. Further to the extent possible, work from home should be encouraged by employers.

Similarly, it has also been ordered that shops under the PBMC jurisdiction should not allow more than 5 persons at a time and big showrooms/supermarkets/establishments should operate at 50% capacity and maintain 2 'Gaz ki Doori'.

Buses/Public transport, Ships etc. plying in South Andaman District

should restrict passengers to 50% capacity without fail. For other modes of transport, the following limits are imposed (excluding driver):

- Transport Jeeps/Sumo- 4 passengers
- Taxi- 3 Passengers
- Auto - 2 Passengers

Any person violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable. These orders has come into effect from the midnight of 25th July, 2020 and will remain in force till further orders.

## PIL on contagion of COVID-19 virus in Children Protection Homes

### Division Bench permits functioning of Juvenile Justice Board from Observation Home at Nayagaon as a temporary measure Appreciates steps taken for appointment of members of CWC for N&M Andaman District

Port Blair, July 25

The Hon'ble Division Bench of High Court, Calcutta comprising of Mr. Justice Harish Tandon and Mr. Justice Soumen Sen while hearing a Public Interest Litigation through video conference on 24.07.2020 regarding contagion of COVID-19 virus in Children Protection Homes filed before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, has permitted the functioning of the Juvenile Justice Board (JJB) from the Observation Home for Boys at Nayagaon as a temporary measure till the new building is

constructed after demolition of 'PRAYAS'. The Bench also directed that the Juvenile Justice Board at South Andaman District would be provided with adequate staff so as to facilitate smooth functioning of the JJB at that place. The said Public Interest Litigation was taken up as per the directions of the Hon'ble Court when the matter was taken up earlier on 02.07.2020. The Hon'ble Division Bench observed and appreciated the steps taken by the Secretary for appointment of the Child Welfare Committee (CWC) for North and Middle Andaman District. The Hon'ble Division Bench also observed that the Administration is to take all steps for purchasing computer system and for ensuring connectivity to all the JJB and CWC, presently operational at Andaman & Nicobar Islands. In this matter, the Hon'ble Division Bench also directed the Chief Manager, BSNL, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, to take immediate steps to ensure that all the JJB and CWC have uninterrupted internet

## Number of convoy on ATR restricted to one

### Convoy timing: 10 am from Jirkatang to Middle Strait and 3 pm from Middle Strait to Jirkatang

Port Blair, July 25

In the wake of increase in COVID-19 cases in A&N Islands and in order to prevent spread of COVID-19 in the tribal area, the number of convoy on the Andaman Trunk Road passing through Jarawa Tribal Reserve has been restricted to one only, with effect from July 27, 2020, an order to this effect issued by the Secretary, Tribal Welfare said.

Accordingly, the Order states that only one convoy per day from Jirkatang to Middle Strait and one convoy per day from Middle Strait to Jirkatang will be allowed from July 27 onwards till further order. The timing of convoy will be 1000 hrs from Jirkatang to Middle Strait and

1500 hrs from Middle Strait to Jirkatang.

The health status of the Driver/Crew & Passengers must be undertaken before they cross into other District. Further, the travellers must ensure the following while passing through Jarawa Tribal Reserve -

- Always wear mask,
- Sanitize hands
- Maintain social distancing
- Follow convoy
- Keep vehicle windows closed
- Don't give eatables to tribal area
- Don't stop vehicle in Jarawa area
- Don't allow Jarawa to get into vehicle

**Govt. extends domestic airfare cap till Nov 24**

New Delhi, July 25  
Civil Aviation Ministry has extended its order imposing curbs on airfare till 24th November. The order was issued on 21st May after airlines were allowed to operate after the lockdown.

It had prescribed a range for airfare depending on the flight distance. In the wake of coronavirus outbreak, the Ministry had implemented a cap on domestic flights have a cap on fares with both an upper and lower limit. While the upper price limit is aimed at preventing any sharp rise in fares due to increased demand, the lower limit will help ensure that financial viability of airlines does not suffer amid high costs.
