India made history with launch of 104 satellites; says PM Modi

New Delhi, Feb 26 Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today said India created history by becoming the first country to successfully launch 104 satellites at one go. Addressing the nation through 'Mann Ki Baat' programme on All India Radio, Shri Modi said ISRO's cost effective space programme has drawn world wide acclaim.



He said satellites of the United States, Israel, Kazakhstan, Switzerland, Netherlands, and UAE were among those launched by PSLV C 37 on the 15th of this month. He said India's earth observation satellite Cartosat 2D will help in mapping of resources and infrastructure, evaluating development and planning

for urban development. The Prime Minister pointed out that farmers will be greatly benefited by Cartosat 2D as it will help in water resource mapping and monitoring.

Shri Modi said it is also a matter of pride that the

satellite launch is the 38th straight successful PSLV launch. Shri Modi said this is a historic achievement, not only for ISRO, but for the entire country. He also said that the latest ISRO launch was helmed by young scientists as well as

women scientists. He extended his greetings to them for their service to the nation and space technology.

The Prime Minister said India has scaled new heights in the area of defence through the successful test firing of Ballistic Interceptor Missile. During its trial, the missile destroyed an enemy missile at an altitude of about 100 kilometres above the surface of the earth.

Shri Modi said there are only four or five countries in the world who possess this capability. He said the missile can hit enemy targets even from a distance of 2000 kilometres and pre-emptively destroy it in the space itself.

Lt Governor exhorts people to draw inspiration from life of Savarkar



Port Blair, Feb 26 Glowing tributes were paid to the great freedom fighter Veer Savarkar on his death anniversary today. To commemorate the 51st death anniversary of Veer Savarkar, the Maharashtra Mandal, Port Blair organised a function at its premises in which the Lt. Governor A&N Islands Prof. Jagdish Mukhi was the chief guest.

Addressing the gathering, consisting of the 400 followers of Veer Savarkar, who have come here to observe his death anniversary, and members of the Veer Savarkar Vichar Manch, Riwari, Haryana and other people, the Lt. Governor, paying glowing tributes to Veer Savarkar on his death anniversary, said, it is an important day in the history of the country. When Veer Savarkar came here under

punishment to 'Kala Pani', he noticed the incarcerations meted out to the freedom fighters in the Cellular Jail. Veer Savarkar motivated the freedom fighters to revolt against the British yoke and was successful in guiding and leading them against the foreign rulers, said the Lt Governor welcoming the people who are on a visit to the Islands to observe the day. Speaking about the early life of Veer Savarkar, the Lt Governor urged one and all to draw inspiration from his life.

Speaking about the facilities that have been made available in the Islands in the recent times, the Lt. Governor informed the gathering that a direct flight from Mumbai to Port Blair is available today that enabled the followers of Veer Savarkar to reach here directly from Mumbai.

The issue of high airfare, that used to be a great cause of concern from the point of view of a tourist, was taken up with the Civil Aviation Ministry and within 2 months of taking charge as Lt. Governor, 6 new flights were introduced between the mainland and Islands, taking the total number of flights from earlier 12 to 18. The growing competition in mainland and Port Blair sector has led to the fall in the airfares, resulting in the arrival of more tourists, here, which increased to about 38% in last 3 to 4 months, said the Lt Governor.

He further said that to give boost to tourism in Isles, the Administration has taken a number of steps. Connectivity which has been a major issue in these Islands will see a great improvement in the coming days, with the laying of Optical Fiber Cable between Chennai and Port Blair and 5 inter islands. The Cabinet has approved this project worth Rs. 1100 crore in September, 2016, he said.

The Lt. Governor also stated that the Administration is focused on bringing the IT Industry to these Islands. The IT (Contd. on last page)

Improving patient care at GB Pant Hospital Patients need to carry Aadhaar ID during first visit to hospital

Port Blair, Feb 26 In the ongoing digitization effort of Govt. of India, GB Pant Hospital, Port Blair is implementing Hospital Information and Management System (e-Hospital) in collaboration with National Informatics Centre (NIC). The system will improve patient care by digitization and connectivity of all the Departments and Wards of the Hospital in a phased

manner. After 28th Feb., 2017, it will be required by the patients during their first visit to the hospital to carry their Aadhaar ID and get the Aadhaar Number registered to the e-Hospital software alongwith one of their Phone Number. During subsequent/future patient visit to the GB Pant Hospital, there will be no need to carry any identity card. The registered phone

number, Aadhaar number or barcode printed in the old OPD slip will be sufficient to track the previous treatment received at the GB Pant Hospital.

Patients who do not register their AADHAAR ID after 28th Feb., 2017 may experience some delay in OPD registration except for the valid emergency cases, a communication said.

All England Championship for me is like any other Super Series: PV Sindhu

New Delhi, Feb 26
Rio Olympic silver medallist PV Sindhu doesn't want to attach any special significance to the upcoming All England Championship and said she would be treating the prestigious premier event like any other Super Series tournament.
"I consider the All England as like any normal super series tournament. People may think as if it's a big tournament by its name," Sindhu said in an interview
"But as a player, I would be playing the same players who I play in other Super Series matches tournaments, so it is the same for me," said the 21-year-old from Hyderabad who trains at Pullela Gopichand's badminton academy at Gachibowli.
The marquee USD 600,000 tournament is scheduled to be held from March 7 to 12 in Birmingham.
Her mentor and chief coach Gopichand and legendary Prakash Padukone are the only two Indians who have won the All England Championship ever with Saina Nehwal coming tantalisingly close to claiming the title in 2015

before losing to Olympic champion Carolina Marin. However, Sindhu has in the past broken many records when she became the first Indian women's shuttler to win a bronze at the 2013 World Championship and repeating the feat at the next edition at Denmark.
The Indian also had broken new grounds when she became the first Indian shuttler to win a silver at the Rio Olympic Games, losing to Marin in the finals.
"I am preparing well and every match is equally important in the tournament. I have been

playing with boys here which is helpful for me. I'm training hard day and night to achieve the goal," said Sindhu, who will open her campaign against Denmark's Mette Poulsen.
The sixth seeded Indian is likely to meet World No 1 Tai Tzu Ying in the quarterfinals, an opponent she has lost five times including the defeat at the Hong Kong Open.
Asked if she has learnt to handle pressure better now, Sindhu, who became the youngest recipient of Padma Shri in 2015, said: "I have no tension I only play to give my best."

hub will be ready by the time the OFC project is in place by December 2018. Referring to some social issues where the Administration made an immediate intervention, the Lt. Governor said, considering the growing number of oral cancer cases in the Islands which was 50 in 2015 and 86 in 2016, the Administration declared a complete ban on tobacco in these Islands on Oct 2, 2016. People, especially women folk have hailed and supported the decision, said the Lt. Governor, also assuring that the interests of business persons affected due to this ban will be taken care of.
Secondly, the Lt. Governor said that increase in alcoholism has given rise to suicidal tendencies in these Islands. To curb the menace of alcoholism here, some important steps have been taken viz. limiting the bar timings from earlier 12 to 6 hours at present, increasing the prices at par with other cities; the legal age to buy liquor has been increased to 21 from earlier 18. To purchase liquor, now one will have to make cashless transactions. The Administration aims at decreasing alcohol consumption by 20% in a year. Besides, following the order of the Supreme Court, bars will be removed & relocated from the National and State Highways in these Islands too, by March 2017, said the Lt Governor.

The Lt Governor also mentioned about some merits the Islanders possess. He said, Islanders are law-abiding people, while cleanliness is the hallmark here. The Islands are beggar free and people from different regional, linguistic & religious backgrounds live in perfect harmony, and Hindi is the 'Lingua Franca', language of the people here, said the Lt Governor. He also stated that 'Secularism' mentioned in our Constitution can be felt in real terms in these Islands only. People of all religions live together in harmony. He also praised the Islanders for their sense of economic satisfaction, adding that the per capita expenditure by Govt. of India here is the highest. With 86% literacy rate, A&N Islands is only next to Kerala, he said.

The Lt Governor concluded his speech by reiterating the commitment of the Administration to make these Islands a model state, providing better education to its children and looking after the people and working for their all round development. Earlier, the Lt Governor garlanded the bust of Veer Savarkar and also witnessed the picture of Veer Savarkar created through Rangoli by Shri Bhushan Vaidya, a painter and sculptor from Maharashtra.

Dr. Sachidanand Shevade, International Orator & Writer from Mumbai, while speaking, informed the gathering about the unconquerable courage of Veer Savarkar while his stay in Cellular Jail which the Britishers could not break. He called for taking inspirations from the life of Savarkar and other freedom fighters. In his brief address, Shri Shrinivas Sharma Shastri, State President, Veer Savarkar Vichar Manch, Riwari, Haryana also expressed his views and said that Lt.
