### PM Modi calls on citizens to be part of country's transformation

New Delhi, Mar 26 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi called upon citizens to be the part of the transformation of the country so that the dream of New India can be fulfilled. Sharing his thoughts in the 30th edition of 'Mann Ki Baat' in All India Radio today, Shri Modi said, the desire of 125 crore countrymen for change will lay foundation for a new India. He said, New India is neither a government programme, nor is it the manifesto of a political party, nor is it a project. He said, New India is the clarion call of 125 crore countrymen and it is the essence of the emotions of the Indians wanting to come together and create a



magnificent India. Shri Modi said, there are lakhs of people, who besides their own personal responsibilities, are working selflessly for the exploited, victimised, deprived and for the poor and the oppressed. He said, the belief that service to humanity is service to God, is innate to Indians. The Prime Minister said, if every citizen resolves that he will discharge his duties honestly, it will contribute to the realisation of the dream New India. Shri Modi urged people to be part of the journey from 'Swaraj to Suraj' by making their lives disciplined, and filled with resolve. Remembering Mahatma Gandhi's Champaran Satyagrah which is completing 100 years next

month, Shri Modi said, in India's struggle for freedom, Gandhian thought and Gandhian practice became manifest for the first time in Champaran. He said, it was a turning point in the entire journey of India's freedom struggle. Shri Modi said, the immense power of the common man in the freedom struggle, manifests again in the journey from 'Swaraj to Suraj' for the benefit and happiness of all. Expressing happiness over large number of people participating in the digital payment, Prime Minister said, the poorest of the poor are also making an attempt to learn to do business without cash. ### Govt asks telecom operators to re-verify all mobile subscribers through Aadhar based e-KYC

New Delhi, Mar 26 All existing subscribers of mobile services will have to go for Aadhaar-based re-verification soon. A notification issued by the telecom department said, all telecom operators shall re-verify all existing mobile subscribers (pre-paid and postpaid) through Aadhaar-based eKYC process. Government instructed telecom operators to initiate the process regarding this. Cellular operators' body COAI said its members may meet next week to discuss the modalities of rolling out the verification process for the existing one billion-plus mobile phone users. The operator can re-



verify more than one mobile connection in one service area through a single eKYC but not bulk connections. Verification of a subscriber would not be required in case of conversions - that is pre-paid to postpaid connections or vice versa.

### 94 of 500 cities get ratings under AMRTU

New Delhi, Mar 26 With the exercise of Credit Rating of cities and towns gaining momentum, 94 of the 500 cities included in Smart City Mission and Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation, AMRUT have obtained ratings which are necessary for issuing Municipal Bonds for mobilization of resources. ### Centre chalks out new roadmap to seal International Borders with Bangladesh & Pakistan: HM

Bhopal, Mar 26 Union Home Minister Shri Rajnath Singh today said that the Centre has chalked out a new roadmap to strengthen the border security and plans to seal the International Borders with Bangladesh and Pakistan. He said this while addressing the Passing Out Parade of the BSF assistant commandants at the BSF Academy in Tekanpur of Madhya Pradesh. Home

Minister said four pilot projects have been approved to check infiltration through technical assistance. Shri Singh also warned Pakistan against any attempts to breach ceasefire. Home Minister said, BSF personnel were authorised to take decisive action in the event of shooting by the other side after repeated ceasefire violations.

### Modification to anti-graft law, to protect honest bureaucrats: FM

Mumbai, Mar 26 Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley has said that an erroneous commercial decision of a public servant cannot always be seen as corrupt. He said that the amendments to the anti-graft law would protect the honest bureaucrats. He said the amendments to the anti-graft law have been brought to Parliament and the select committee has suggested some marginal changes in its report. He was speaking at an award function organised by Business Standard in Mumbai last evening. He said the current Prevention of Corruption Act was drafted in 1988 during the pre-liberalisation era in line with the erstwhile needs of the system. The Minister said the fundamentals of the anti-graft law in the liberalisation era have to be changed, where public servants, bankers and politicians are involved in taking commercial decisions now.

### ANIIMS doctors perform surgery of Ameloblastoma in GB Pant Hospital



Port Blair, Mar 26 A 76 yrs old male reported to G B Pant Hospital, ANIIMS, with the chief complaint of pain and swelling in the right lower jaw (mandible) with pus discharge. He was diagnosed to have a non-

cancerous (benign) tumor (Ameloblastoma) of the lower jaw. Tumor was of the size of a tennis ball, which was excised by a team of Doctors led by Dr. Dushyant Koul, HOD, Department of Dentistry, ANIIMS.

The patient is recovering well. This is the first time; such type of tumor of lower jaw has been excised (surgical removal) in the G B Pant Hospital, a communication from Director ANIIMS said.

# India wins 73 medals in 2017 Special Olympics World Winter Games including 37 golds



New Delhi, Mar 26  
India's special athletes gave an impressive performance and won 73 medals in the recently concluded 2017 Special Olympics World Winter Games held in Austria. This year's edition witnessed 2,600 athletes from over 105 countries competing with each other and the Special Olympics Bharat team won 37 golds, 10 silver and 26 bronze medals. This year's Olympics included even disciplines including Alpine Skiing, Snow Boarding, Snow Shoeing, Figure Skating, Speed

Skating, Floor Hockey, Floor Ball (and Unified floor Ball), at the mega event. India dominated in three team events - Floor Hockey (male), Unified Floorball and Traditional Floorball bagging 30 medals in total which was the highest tally in a single day. Along with this, the special women team also won 16 bronze medals. An important gold medal came in The Unified Floorball (Male) event where India defeated Nigeria while the Floor Hockey team crushed Lithuania 7-2. India took its tally to 73 medals by winning

8-0 against Austria. India also won 10 medals in Alpine skiing including 3 gold, 3 silver and 4 bronze medals. The snowboarding team also came out all guns blazing bagging 8 medals that included 4 gold, 2 silver and 2 bronze medals. 5 more medals came in Snow Shoeing and 4 medals were won in Speed and figure skating. In the process, Himachal's Megha became the first Indian to win a gold medal in the games which were held in Graz, Schladming and Ramsau in Austria.

## Sebastian Vettel shocks Lewis Hamilton to win season opening race

Melbourne, Mar 26  
Four-time former world champion Sebastian Vettel won the Australian Grand Prix in Melbourne on Sunday, finishing 9.9 seconds ahead of Lewis Hamilton in his Mercedes. Hamilton began on pole position and led until the first set of pit stops when Germany's Vettel leaptfrogged the Englishman to secure Ferrari's first victory since the 2015 Singapore Grand Prix. Finland's Valtteri Bottas completed the podium on his debut for Mercedes. Vettel held all the aces in the



Melbourne season opener mastering Hamilton by almost 10 seconds and Bottas. While only the first of a 20-race season, Vettel's showing for Ferrari has signalled a possible changing of the guard in the new era of faster and more physical cars.

"We've got a real race on our hands and it's a challenge we will relish. It's going to be great for the fans," declared Hamilton after he failed to make any impression on Vettel's tearaway Ferrari in the closing stages of the 58-lap dash around the Albert Park street circuit.

# Indian batsmen surrender advantage to finish 248/6 on Day 2

Dharamsala, Mar 26  
Indian batsmen frittered away the initial advantage before reaching 248 for six against a disciplined Australia to leave the fourth and final cricket Test evenly poised, here today. India are still 52 runs short of Australia's first innings total of 300 as atleast three batsmen failed to convert their starts into big knocks. With the pitch offering significant turn along with good bounce, batting will only get difficult in the third and fourth innings in what promises to be a battle of attrition in the next three days. Playing a batsmen short, opener Lokesh Rahul's indiscretion cost India dearly. India never got the required momentum after Rahul's ill-timed pull-shot off a Patrick Cummins bouncer. He scored 60 off 124 balls. Cheteshwar Pujara (57) and Ajinkya Rahane (46) also got

starts before Nathan Lyon snuffed them out, extracting sharp bounce from the pitch. India were comfortable placed at 108 for one before Rahul's dismissal and could have pushed for lead but are struggling to level the scores at least. The final session in which India scored 95 runs saw them lose as many as four wickets all trying to be defensive against

Lyon. It could have been worse had Wriddhiman Saha (10 batting) catch would have been taken by Matt Renshaw at first slip. Rahul hit nine fours and a slog-swept six off Steve O Keefe. The Rahul-Pujara duo added 87 runs for the second wicket to lend solidity to the Indian innings after Murali Vijay's (11) early departure.
