## Draft Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, A & N Islands, 2018; DSW invites comment & suggestions

The Central Government prepared Model Rules to enable the State/UT Administration to formulate its own UT Rules within the domain of the UT Administration by virtue of the provisions in the RPwD Act, 2016. The Department of Social Welfare, Andaman & Nicobar Administration is the Nodal Department for formulation

of the UT Rules. ## Taking TB diagnosis closer to public

## Medical mobile van equipped with CB-NAAT for testing TB to start functioning within a fortnight

Port Blair, Mar. 26

Good news for the residents of South Andaman, as the first Medical Mobile van equipped with CB-NAAT (Cartridge Based Nucleic Acid Amplification Test) machine and necessary attachments like cartridge, printer, refrigerator and generator for facilitating early diagnosis of MDR-TB and TB in high risk population will be pressed into service within fifteen days. The Govt. of India has supplied a Medical Mobile Van to support the all the States/UTs for undertaking Active Case Finding for diagnosis of TB and the UT of A&N Islands is one among the ten States/UTs to have received this van in the first phase, said Dr. Burma, the Director of Health Services, while speaking to the DT Reporter here today.

To eliminate TB from these Islands by 2025 as per



the national target, the Medical Mobile Van equipped with all the necessary attachments will be accompanied by a Senior Lab Technician and Senior TB Supervisor during its field visit. This will be of immense help to the rural ladies and school going children who cannot come to the Hospital for diagnosis.

A weekly schedule will be prepared for the visit to the villages and accordingly, the Pradhan of the concerned village will be informed about the schedule, about which he/she can sensitize the masses and mobilize them to come for the diagnosis. People coughing for more than two weeks along with other symptoms like fever and weight loss can come and avail free service during the visit of the Medical Mobile Van, said Dr. Burma.

People must make use of the service as India has the highest burden of TB despite intensive awareness and availability of medicines. The Govt. of India's mission to eliminate TB by 2025 can only be achieved if people cooperate with the Health Department and get themselves diagnosed at the earliest. TB is curable and people must not hesitate to take treatment while the social stigmas concerning TB must be thwarted.

**Sports Ministry approves 325-member Indian contingent for CWG 2018**

New Delhi, Mar 26  
The Sports Ministry has confirmed India's contingent for the 2018 Commonwealth Games to be held at Gold Coast City in Australia from April 4-15, which comprises 325 members (221 athletes, 58 coaches, 17 doctors and physiotherapists, seven managers and 22 other officials).  
In individual disciplines, Athletics and Shooting has the maximum representation with 31 and 27 participants respectively, while weightlifting and wrestling will see 16 and 12 contenders, respectively stepping up to the challenge. 10 Indian shuttlers will vie for supremacy at the quadrennial event, comprising the likes of World No. 2 Kidambi Srikanth and No. 3 PV Sindhu (who will be India's flag bearer at the opening ceremony of CWG



2018). "The Indian Olympic Association (IOA), Sports Authority of India, (SAI), National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA), and concerned NSFs may take appropriate measures for conducting the dope tests. IOA may also ensure medical fitness of the team/individual sportspersons prior to their departure." Earlier, the presence of 'extra officials' in the Commonwealth

Games-bound Indian contingent had become a major flashpoint between the sports ministry and the Indian Olympic Association (IOA). The IOA then on Thursday had said that Sports Minister Col Rajyavardhan Singh Rathore had assured it to have a re-look at government's policy of not clearing 'extra officials' for the upcoming Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast.

**Junior Shooting World Cup: 15-year-old Anish Bhanwala secures India's third individual gold**

New Delhi, Mar 26  
Anish Bhanwala, the 2018 Emerging Player of the Year at the third Mahindra Scorpio Times of India Sports Awards (TOISA), climbed atop the podium in the men's 25m Rapid Fire Pistol Junior event at the ISSF Junior World Cup Rifle / Pistol / Shotgun in Sydney, Australia on Monday.  
Bhanwala, 15, first qualified for the final with the highest score, then prevailing over two of his teammates and over three Chinese participants. On the team podium, China secured the gold medal and set a new Junior World Record with 1733 points, while India's Bhanwala, Anhad Jawanda and Adarsh Singh took silver. The bronze medal was awarded to a second Indian team, composed by Sandhu, Japtyesh Singh Jaspal and Mandeep Singh Bhanwala, who was placed 7th in this event at the ISSF World Cup Stage 1 in Guadalajara (MEX), earlier this month — led the match since its very first stage, as he was the only shooter able to nail a perfect 5-hit series during the whole final.



Indeed, after recording the highest qualification score with 585 points, he concluded with 29 total hits, pocketing the first international gold medal of his career in this event. Two Chinese shooters placed alongside him on the Rapid Fire Pistol podium: 19-year-old

Cheng Zhipeng took silver with 27 hits, adding it to the bronze he won at last year's ISSF Junior World Championship in Suhl (GER), while Zhang Jueming (20) finished with 23 and claimed bronze in his first Junior World Cup start ever.

**Australia beat India by 36 runs in fourth match**

Mumbai, Mar 26  
In Women's Cricket, Australia have defeated India by 36 runs in the fourth match of the T-20 Tri-Series tournament in Mumbai today. Chasing, a target of 187, India scored 150, losing five wickets in 20 overs. The Aussies had scored 186

for 5. Earlier, India won the toss and invited Aussies to bat. England is the third participating team in the tournament. As per the tournament schedule, all the three sides will face each other twice. The top two teams will make it to the final which will be held on the 31st of this month.

The ASC condemns cheating of any form in sport. The ASC expects and requires that Australian teams and athletes demonstrate unimpeachable integrity in representing our country," ASC said. Rajasthan Royals will play their first game on April 9 against Sunrisers Hyderabad at the Rajiv Gandhi International Stadium in Hyderabad.
