Huge quantity of Charas seized by PS Hutbay

Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 25
The team of Police Station Hut Bay has once again demonstrated exemplary professionalism, vigilance and unwavering commitment in the ongoing fight against Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances. In a landmark achievement for A&N Police, a record quantity of contraband has been seized, marking the first ever recovery of such a large quantity of Charas (Hashish) in the history of A&N Islands. The total quantity recovered is 1.141 Kg of Charas (Hashish), which falls under the

category of commercial quantity as defined under the NDPS Act. On 24/03/2026, a credible information regarding Narcotic drugs was received from a reliable source by Inspector Pritam Behari, SHO PS Hut Bay. Acting swiftly on the information, a raiding team comprising of SHO PS Hut Bay was immediately formed. Subsequently, the SHO requested Shri Belthazer, BDO, Little Andaman (Executive Magistrate) along with two independent witnesses to ensure transparency and adherence to legal procedures. Upon reaching the

seashore area, an intensive search operation was conducted in the adjoining jungle based on the specific input. During the search, 1.141 Kg of Charas (Hashish) was recovered and the same was seized on the spot after observing all codal formalities. Upon this, a case under Section 20(b)(ii)(C) of the NDPS Act, 1985 has been registered at PS Hut Bay against unknown person and further investigation is in progress. The entire operation was conducted under the command of Shri. Aditya Kumar, SDPO Swaraj Dweep, a press release from SP (SA) said.

Hut Bay Police apprehend accused from Jharkhand

The Hut Bay Police have achieved a significant breakthrough with the successful apprehension of accused from Jharkhand involved in FIR No. 78/25 dated 27/12/2025 U/s 303(2)/316(2)/318(4)/319(2)/336(3)/338/339/340(2) BNS, 2023 registered at Police Station Hut Bay. Acting on credible intelligence and following sustained

investigative efforts, a dedicated police team comprising of SI Debrata Raha, PCs K Mohan and Mohd. Ayub of PS Hut Bay was deputed to mainland to trace and apprehend accused. Through persistent follow-up and effective coordination with local police authorities, the team successfully located accused and took him into custody. Accused is alleged to

have cheated the complainant through fraudulent means, resulting in significant financial loss. Upon completion of all legal formalities, accused has been brought to Sri Vijaya Puram and produced before the Hon'ble Court and from there he has been remanded to Judicial Custody, a press release from SP (SA) said.

chicks were distributed to local farmers, further strengthening backyard poultry activities in the region. The initiative reflects the Department's strong commitment to enhancing livelihood opportunities, self-employment, and nutritional security among rural households. Broiler quails are gaining popularity due to their fast growth, early maturity, high feed efficiency, and superior meat quality, while their short rearing cycle and minimal space requirement make them highly suitable for small-scale and marginal farmers. Vanaraja birds, known for their hardiness and dual-purpose utility, perform excellently under backyard conditions, providing both quality meat and a steady supply of eggs. Vigova ducks are well adapted to the island ecosystem and are valued for their excellent meat purpose and resilience in water-based and backyard rearing systems. This distribution under the Rotational Programme is a concrete step towards empowering rural farmers with sustainable livelihood options. By introducing diversified poultry species such as quails, Vanaraja birds, and Vigova ducks, the Department aims to ensure higher income and improved nutritional standards across the islands, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

- The social worker members shall be appointed by the State Government on the recommendation of the Selection Committee constituted under Rule 87 of A & N Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Rules, 2023.
- The Social Worker Members shall not be minimum thirty five years of age and shall not be more than sixty five years of age on the date of notification and shall have at least seven years of experience of working with children in the field of education, health, or welfare activities, or should be a practicing professional with a degree in child psychology or psychiatry or sociology or in the field of law.
- As far as possible, the two social worker members so selected for a Board shall be from different fields.
- All members of the Board including the Principal Magistrate, shall be given induction training and sensitization within a period of sixty days from the date of appointment.
- The social worker members of the Board shall be paid not less than Rs. 2000/- per sitting, which shall include sitting allowance, travel allowance and any other allowance, as the UT Administration may prescribe.
- The Board shall sit on all working days for a minimum of six hours commensurate with the working hours of a Magistrate Court, unless the case pendency is less in a particular district and the UT Administration issues an order in this regard.

Term of Members of the Board under Rule 5 of A & N Islands Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Rules, 2023:-

- The term of the social worker member of the Board shall not be more than for a period of three years from the date of appointment.
 - A social worker member of the Board shall be eligible for appointment of maximum of two terms, which shall not be continuous.
 - The members may resign at any time, by giving one month's notice in writing to the State Government.

 - A member of the Committee shall be eligible for appointment of maximum of two terms, which shall not be continuous.
 - The Chairperson and the members may resign at any time by giving one months notice in writing to the State Government.
 - The Chairperson and members of the Committee shall be paid such sitting allowance, travel allowance and any other allowance, as the UT Administration may prescribe, but not less than Rs.2000/- per sitting.
 - The Committee shall sit on all working days for a minimum of six hours commensurate with the working hours of a Magistrate court, unless the case pendency is less in a particular district & UT Administration issue an order in this regard.
