Govt will introduce Road Transport and Safety Bill soon, says PM

New Delhi, July 26
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today said government is going to introduce the Road Transport and Safety Bill very soon which will offer cash less treatment to accident victims. In his Mann Ki Baat programme on All India Radio, Shri Modi expressed concern over high number of deaths on Indian roads. He said one death occurs in the country every four minutes and every life is very precious. Shri Modi said a toll free number 1033, ambulance for patients and how the victim will be treated well in the first 50 hours after the accident occur will be given priority in



the proposed bill. Speaking on the 10th edition of Mann ki Baat, the Prime minister paid glowing tributes to the martyrs of the Kargil war. Shri Modi complimented the farmers for 50 per cent increase in sowing of pulses and 33 per cent in oil seeds in this season. Shri Modi said, mygov portal which started on July 26th last year has been instrumental in public participation in developmental activities of the government. He said over two crore people have accessed my gov during this

period. The Prime minister said he has been receiving comments on Mygov about his Independence Day speech. Emphasising on the development of the North Eastern states, the Prime minister said the bureaucrats from Centre have been asked to camp for seven days in the each north eastern states to have a first hand account and solve the problems. Government trying to minimise road accidents: Minister

New Delhi, July 26
The central government was concerned over the large number of road accidents in India and was trying to "minimise" them, union Minister Shri Nitin Gadkari said on Sunday. A large number of people die or get injured every year in road accidents and the government was trying all possible ways to reduce the number of casualties, the minister for road transport, highways and shipping told a TV channel right after Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi expressed concern in his 'Maan Ki Baat' radio programme over the increasing number of

road accidents. "Five lakh road accidents take place every year. Three lakh people get injured and 1.5 lakh die. We are trying to identify the vulnerable spots and widen the roads to ease congestion. We are trying to minimise the accidents," Shri Gadkari said. Earlier in the day, Shri Modi said the central government will soon implement the National Road Safety Policy and cashless treatment for road accident victims. "The statistics on road accidents in our country are shocking. There is an accident every minute. And due to road accidents, there is a death every four minutes," he said in his monthly radio address.

Centre Mulling Crop Insurance Scheme: Union Minister

Bangaluru, July 26
BJP-led NDA government is mulling a crop insurance scheme as part of its policy to address problems plaguing farmers and the agriculture sector, Parliamentary Affairs Minister Shri M Venkaiah Naidu said today. This was part of its thrust on four Is for the sector - irrigation, infrastructure, interest rate and insurance, he said. "What is to be done is we need to go for agriculture crop income insurance... that is the need of the hour. So the government is looking into that," he told PTI. The Minister, on a visit to a village on the outskirts of the city which he had adopted, earlier held a meeting with agricultural scientists at the University of Agricultural Sciences. He, however, said the Centre and the states should join hands to implement the insurance scheme because vast resources were required for it. "Unless Centre and states join together in the scheme, it is not easy to implement because the

resources required is vast and the sector is a challenging sector," he said. The Centre was going to give Rs. 8,50,000 crore rupees, but that may not be sufficient, he added. Government was also looking at ways to further reduce the interest rate on farm loans and Union Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley had been asked to look into it, he said. "We are looking at reducing interest rates further... I had asked the Finance Minister to reduce the rates - he says unless the economic situation improves and growth rate increases... (it can't be done)," he said. On solving loan related problems in agricultural sector, Shri Naidu said the Centre wants to reverse the trend of farmers availing loans from private moneylenders to financial institutions. "The World Bank study says only 45 per cent of the farmers are getting loans from institutions. The remaining loans they are getting from private lenders, so we want to reverse that," he said.

New Delhi, July 26
Defence ties between India and Japan are set to grow stronger with both coming together for Malabar naval exercises in October and exploring possibility of having joint air exercises. Japanese defence sources expressed satisfaction at the growth trajectory in the defence ties saying, "the direction is right. We need to work on it more". "Japan is happy to be invited for the Indo-US naval exercise 'Malabar' slated for October in the Bay of Bengal," the sources told PTI, adding that the next step hopefully will be joint air exercise. It is not just the cooperation at the level of forces that both countries are looking at. "There is a huge opportunity present in the defence manufacturing too especially in the context of Make in India," Indian defence sources said. The importance that Japan puts on defence ties with India can be seen from the fact that the Japanese Embassy has added two more defence attaches here - one each from the Air Force and Coast Guard -- this

year. "At present, there are only four countries other than India to which Japan sends its attaches from the three services and the Coast Guard. This shows how much importance we attach to the defence and maritime cooperation between Japan and India," Japanese Ambassador to India Takeshi Yagi said. Amid increasing

Indian archery teams to target Rio Olympics quota berths in Copenhagen World Championships

New Delhi, July 26
Indian archery teams would be targeting Rio Olympics quota berths in the eight-day World Championships beginning in Copenhagen today. Six Indian recurve archers who include experienced trio of Olympians-Jayanta Talukdar, Rahul Banerjee and Mangal Singh Champia would look to give India some reason to rejoice. Even as the team is together for the first time since 2010, their experience would matter the most as the duo of Rahul and Jayanta, who were part of London 2012, will look to complement Champia, who was the only member in the Beijing-bound 2008 contingent. Women's team will bank on former world number one and Olympian Deepika Kumari as it remains to be seen how the Ranchi girl performs as her turn of shooting would be last in the team after the duo of Laxmi Rani Majhi and Rimil Buriuly. But women's team coach Purnima Mahto is confident of winning a team berth.

India need to figure among top 16 teams after two rounds of 70 metre-target shooting. In the elimination round, they have to win at least one match to book a team berth. In individual category, one Indian can win Rio berth if he or she finishes among top 32. However, world championship is

not the only qualification event as the archers will have a second chance at the Asian Archery Championship, which will be held in Bangkok in November. The tournament has a record 623 participants from 96 countries vying for top honours in four competitive disciplines.

Amit Mishra, Prayan Ojha return with rich hauls as Australia A match ends in draw

Chennai, July 26
Left-arm spinner Prayan Ojha turned out to be the biggest gainer while comeback man Amit Mishra got five wickets and more importantly vital overs under his belt as the first unofficial 'Test' match between India A and Australia A ended in a tame draw.
Chasing a target of 240, Australia A reached 161 for four in 46 overs when the umpires decided to call off the match after the two captains shook hands. For Ojha, a match haul of 6/132 (5/87 & 1/45) will do his confidence a world of good. Mishra on his part bowled close to 40 overs across both innings and a return of five wickets could be considered a decent

performance.
Earlier, India A declared their first innings at 206 for eight, starting from their overnight score of 121 for three.
India on Saturday batted 32.3 overs as young Shreyas Iyer (33) again chipped in with a useful contribution while Karun Nair (23) failed once again.
Pacer Gurinder Sandhu (2/27) and part-time seamer Marcus Stoinis (2/17) were the most successful bowlers while left-arm spinner Steve O'Keefe took his match-haul to eight wickets with 2/81 in the second innings.
The next match, starting July 28, will feature Test captain Virat Kohli. He will in all likelihood replace Karun in the starting XI as he has failed in both innings.

Usain Bolt bounces back with 100 metre win in London

London, July 26
Olympic champion and world record holder Usain Bolt made an impressive return to competition with a win in the 100 metres at the Diamond League meet here.
Bolt, hampered by injury for much of this year, prevailed in his first competitive heat in six weeks with a time of 9.87 seconds on the same track at the London Olympic Stadium where he delivered three gold—medal—winning performances during the 2012 Games.
The Jamaican sprinter's time was much better than the 10.12 seconds he managed in his only other 100 metre run this year, at

an event in Rio de Janeiro in April.
Bolt, 28, outpaced US runner Michael Rodgers to claim the victory on Friday.
"Overall, it was a good run. I wanted to run faster but my start was very poor and that threw me off. It was all downhill from there," Bolt said after the race.
"I need to work hard ahead of Beijing. I have to keep pushing myself," he said, referring to next month's world championships in the Chinese capital.
The field in Beijing will include US sprinter Justin Gatlin, who ran this year's best time in the 100 metres — 9.74 seconds — on May 15 in Doha.

FIFA puts troubles aside at glitzy World Cup draw

Saint Petersburg, July 26
FIFA put its problems to one side and began the countdown to the 2018 World Cup finals on Saturday when Russian president Vladimir Putin and FIFA chief Sepp Blatter reassured the nation the tournament would go ahead as planned.
A glitzy preliminary-round draw ceremony was beamed live to 170 countries around the world, sending a powerful message that the finals would take place no matter what enquiries are going on over alleged voting irregularities which secured Russia the hosting rights five years ago. Blatter confirmed that Russia

would stage the tournament, saying that the FIFA executive committee had "full trust and confidence". Putin told the global audience that "Russia will be fantastic hosts." Putin also pledged to host a World Cup — in a country where racism is rife at soccer matches — promising both domestic and foreign players and fans would feel at home at a "grandiose international sporting festival". All 209 FIFA members registered to take part in the finals, and although 22 teams have already been eliminated, 851 matches will be played over the next 32 months to establish the 31 teams who will join Russia at the tournament in June 2018.

Security grid needs to come together to counter ISIS: Indian Army

Drass (J&K), July 26

A top Army commander today said there are no large footprints of ISIS in Jammu and Kashmir but the outfit was "creeping towards this side" and the security grid has to stop the "terrible" organisation from getting a foothold in the country. Northern Army Commander Lt General DS Hooda also expressed concern over a number of youth joining militancy, but said the numbers were not large to transform the security situation in Jammu and Kashmir. Speaking to reporters after laying wreath at the war memorial here and paying homage to the martyrs of the 1999 Kargil war, he said, "There are no large footprints of ISIS in Jammu and Kashmir. Yes, there are incidents of flag waving that we have seen. Is it a matter of concern, yes it is. Because

ISIS is such an organisation with such radical sort of ideology and views that we should make sure that it doesn't even get a hold and it has no place in a democracy. "And therefore, there is a reason for us to see how to fight this ideological battle and frankly that is the plan at which it will get fought. So for us who are concerned with security and those concerned with governance, everybody has to put his head together and make sure that this very terrible organisation, if I may call it, doesn't get a foothold in India," he said. The army commander said the creeping of ISIS into the region is a matter of concern. "We are seeing it (footprints of ISIS in the region) slowly. We have already seen it in Afghanistan. There have been numerous incidents of conflict between ISIS and the

Afghan Taliban. The ISIS is trying to gain some influence in Afghanistan. We have also seen factions of TTP which operates in Pakistan which has pledged their allegiance to ISIS. "So there is a creeping towards this side and definitely it is a matter of concern that their coming into closer and closer into our region," he said.
