Operation Sindoor is proof of India's capability to respond decisively to Pakistan's every misadventure: Hon'ble Raksha Mantri

"Yeh Dil Maange More drives India's push for Aatmanirbharta in defence"

New Delhi, July 26 (PIB)

"The success of Operation Sindoor is proof that India possesses the capability to respond to Pakistan's every misadventure with a severity far beyond its imagination," said Hon'ble Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh, reiterating that there would be no talks with Pakistan, and any dialogue would focus solely on PoK, which, he described, as an integral part of India illegally occupied by Pakistan. Addressing the 27th Kargil Vijay Diwas celebrations in Dras today, Hon'ble Raksha Mantri stated that every nefarious act against India's sovereignty would be met with the same resolute response that the Indian Defence Forces delivered to terrorists and their patrons through Op Sindoor with unmatched bravery.

Shri Rajnath Singh asserted that, in Pakistan, the distinction between the military and militants has vanished, with the country making terrorism a part of its state policy. "Pakistan's military not only shelters terrorist organisations but also works with them. That is why, during Op Sindoor, we



made it clear that India no longer views terrorists and the governments that nurture them as separate entities," he said.

threats, exuding confidence that no adversary would dare cast a hostile eye on India while its soldiers guard the nation's borders. Hon'ble Raksha Mantri paid glowing tributes to India's gallant soldiers who sacrificed their lives to defend the motherland during the 1999 Kargil War. He remembered the countless bravehearts, including Param Vir Chakra awardees Captain Vikram Batra and Captain Manoj Kumar Pandey, who continue to inspire the nation, especially the youth. He termed Kargil Vijay Diwas as a day of inspiration for every young person who seeks to understand the distinction between personal success and national duty. "This day teaches us that the spirit of 'sacrifice' and 'service' forms the backbone of any nation," he said. Shri Rajnath Singh highlighted that the Kargil War Memorial reflected the entirety of India as the fallen heroes represented every region of the country. "This wall of unity, despite diversities, stands tall against those who wish to harm us," he said.

Hon'ble Raksha Mantri emphasised that conflicts such as those in West Asia and between Russia & Ukraine have not only tested the capabilities of defence forces but also the resilience, patience and resolve of nations. He asserted that while India has a strong and capable military, safeguarding national security is a shared responsibility of every citizen. Stressing the importance of the spirit of 'Nation First', discipline and a sense of duty, he said every Indian should possess a soldier-like consciousness. "I am not suggesting that every citizen must become a soldier, but should the nation ever face a situation requiring the direct or indirect support of its people, every Indian must be mentally, morally and physically prepared to step forward in defence of the country. Just as every soldier is first and foremost an Indian, the courage, discipline and patriotism of a soldier must always remain alive within every Indian," he added. Shri Rajnath Singh underlined that the vision of Viksit Bharat by 2047 extends beyond economic prosperity, describing it as a commitment to strategic strength, cultural pride and social harmony. He stressed that this vision can be realised only by embracing the same dedication and sense of duty exemplified by the heroes of the Kargil War in every sphere of nation-building.

Hon'ble Raksha Mantri highlighted that the Government, under the leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, is according highest priority to national security and the welfare of soldiers. "Kargil War has taught us that we must remain ever-vigilant at our borders in every season and under all circumstances", he said, pointing out that border infrastructure is being continuously strengthened, with equal emphasis being laid on modernising the military capabilities in sync with the changing times to enhance their operational efficiency.

Drawing inspiration from Captain Vikram Batra's iconic catchphrase 'Yeh Dil Maange More', Shri Rajnath Singh asserted that rapid strides are being made to achieve Aatmanirbharta in defence production, and the Government remains committed to accelerating the progress. "When our government assumed office, India used to import 65 to 70 percent of defence equipment. Today, we're manufacturing 65 percent of our defence equipment on Indian soil. Today, our soldiers possess the indigenously developed air defence control system 'Akash-Teer'. We have developed the next-generation Akash missile. India's first indigenous aircraft carrier 'INS Vikrant', Light Combat Aircraft 'Tejas', Light Combat Helicopter 'Prachand', Advanced Light Helicopter 'Dhruv', Main Battle Tank 'Arjun', 'Pinaka' multi-barrel rocket launcher, 'Astra' air-to-air missile, and modern drones & counter-drone systems are also strengthening the combat readiness of the defence forces. But, 'Yeh Dil Maange More'. We will continue working to manufacture even more modern weapons, next-generation fighter aircraft, submarines, and missiles right in India," he said.

During the event, Hon'ble Raksha Mantri laid a wreath at the Cenotaph and observed silence in remembrance of the bravehearts who made the supreme sacrifice during Operation Vijay in 1999.

A&N Traffic Police urges motorists
to avoid drunken driving

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 26
In view of the recent road traffic accidents, the Andaman & Nicobar Traffic Police has significantly intensified enforcement against drunken driving across Sri Vijaya Puram. The special enforcement drive has been launched with the objective of enhancing road safety, preventing driving under the influence of alcohol, curbing rash and negligent driving, and ensuring strict compliance with the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act. During the current year, a total of 754 motorists have been booked for driving under the influence of alcohol. While 70 motorists were booked during May 2026, the number increased significantly to 168 motorists in June 2026, reflecting the intensified enforcement efforts undertaken by the Traffic Police. This increase is the result of strategically planned enforcement drives conducted at vulnerable road stretches, accident-prone locations, and during high-risk hours. of the 168 vehicles booked during June 2026, 119 were two-wheelers, 39 were four-wheelers, and 10 were auto-rickshaws. Driving under the influence of alcohol is a serious offence under the Motor Vehicles Act. The offence is punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to six months, or with a fine of up to Rs.10,000, or with both. In the case of a second or subsequent offence, the punishment may extend to two years' imprisonment, or a fine of up to Rs.15,000, or both. Motorists found driving under the influence of alcohol will be prosecuted under the relevant provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act. Their driving licences will also be forwarded to the Licensing Authority for suspension in accordance with the provisions of law. In cases involving commercial vehicles, the matter will be reported to the Transport Department for taking appropriate action. The Andaman & Nicobar Traffic Police appeals to all motorists not to drink and drive. Responsible driving saves lives, a press release from SP, Traffic said.
