

India, Seychelles ink five pacts in taxation, agriculture, maritime security



New Delhi, Aug 26
 India and Seychelles today inked five agreements in different sectors including taxation, agricultural research and maritime security. In his statement after holding talks with visiting President of Seychelles Mr James Alix Michel, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi termed Seychelles as a key strategic

partner. Shri Modi said, the two countries have excellent cooperation, especially for maritime security in Indian Ocean Region. The Prime Minister said, India will provide second Dornier maritime patrol plane to Seychelles. He said, today's Air Services Agreement will enable more

and easier connections between the two countries. Shri Modi appreciated Seychelles' support for India's candidature for permanent membership of expanded United Nations Security Council. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi said, bilateral agreement for cooperation on blue economy is a huge step forward in the relationship and in promoting sustainable ocean economy in the region. He said, India is looking forward to cooperate in Space, including in the areas of managing land and marine resources, fisheries advisory, weather forecasting and disaster management. Shri Modi expressed confidence that this milestone year for the relationship between the two

countries will be the spring board for taking strategic partnership to a new level. President Mr James Alix Michel said, his visit to India will further strengthen the strategic and bilateral relations. Earlier, the visiting dignitary was accorded ceremonial reception this morning at the forecourt of Rashtrapati Bhavan. President Shri Pranab Mukherjee and Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi were present at the reception. Mr Michel inspected the Guard of Honour, at the ceremonial reception. The visiting dignitary also laid wreath at the Samadhi of Mahatma Gandhi. The President of the Republic of Seychelles is on a three day visit to India.

Panchayat & Municipal Election - 2015

Altogether 2960 nominations received for the polls

Port Blair, Aug 26
 The process of filing nominations for the Panchayat & Municipal Elections - 2015 has been completed peacefully. On the final day of filling of nominations for the Elections, a total number of 1853 nominations were received for various posts. Altogether 2960 nominations were filed/ received for the Panchayat Election - 2015 - the highest number being 2035 for Gram Panchayat Member. The scrutiny of nominations shall be done tomorrow (Aug 27, 2015) amidst adequate security arrangement and videography shall also be

done of the process for Municipal seats. The Returning Officers are informed that nominations will not be rejected for non receiving of Form-A and the same shall be made available by the office of the Director, Panchayat & Municipal Elections if not provided yet. The first round of training of Presiding Officers/Polling Officers were held today on 26th August, 2015. Out of 896 polling officials, 744 persons attended the training and the remaining have been directed to attend the training on second day without fail. Show cause notices have been issued to the polling

personnel who have failed to attend the training even after receiving the notice and the process of registering of FIR and disciplinary action upon the concerned officials have been initiated. The employees engaged for election duty are again directed to report for their duty immediately and any request for exemption from election duty shall be considered in genuine cases and extraordinary circumstances only. The departments are requested to not to sanction leave to their staff related to election duty without obtaining concurrence from Director

Panchayat and Municipal Elections. The Bar licencedes and ANIIDCO Ltd have been directed to submit the daily report of their sale of liquor in the prescribed format. The teams constituted for enforcement of modal code of conduct have also been entrusted the responsibility of monitoring and keeping vigil on bars/liquor shops. The intelligence personnel are also being deployed in civil dress to check any irregularity in the sale of liquor so as to prevent its misuse in the forthcoming elections. On the completion of the

 The Seventh Pay Commission set up by the govt to revise remuneration of about 48 lakh central government employees and 55 lakh pensioners will submit its report next month, said its Chairman Justice A K Mathur. "The Commission will submit its report by the end of September," Justice Mathur said on Tuesday. The Commission, which was set up by the UPA government in February 2014 to revise remuneration of central government employees, Defence personnel and pensioners, was required to submit its report by August-end.

A&N Police rescues 10 crew from agrounded vessel

Port Blair, Aug 26
 The A&N Marine Police Control Room have rescued 10 crew members of a vessel named 'Lusia' which ran aground off Flat Island due to rough sea conditions. According to a press release, the State Control Room informed the Marine Police Control Room that a fishing vessel 'Lusia' with 10 crew on board under the influence of strong south west monsoon current and the wind speed was engulfed in rough sea conditions and was agrounded at latitude 12o 23' N and longitude 92o 41'E off Flat Island, west coast of Kadamala Island.

Upon receipt of the information, the Marine Police swung into action and rescue teams from the coastal police stations Kadamala was rushed by Fast Interceptor Boat M.V.Suntook to the spot. Another team departed by jungle track to the nearby coast where the vessel was agrounded. The rescue team, endangering their lives, in such turbulent sea conditions, rescued all the crew from the agrounded vessel and brought them to PS Kadamala today (26.08.15) at 0300 pm, the SP, South Andaman said in a press release here today.

Taxonomists reclassify Indian bird species

New Delhi, Aug 26

The majestic Asian Paradise Flycatcher found in many parts of the country is becoming more Indian these days. The bird, which is present in South Asian countries - Afghanistan to Bangladesh and Sri Lanka - will henceforth be known as Indian Paradise Flycatcher, following a new taxonomic assessment.

Though the common name of the species has been modified, it will retain its scientific name *Terpsiphone paradisi* and remain the parent species. Bird taxonomists have separated the subspecies found in the Nicobars.

The new subspecies has been rechristened as Blyth's Paradise Flycatcher and assigned a new scientific name *Terpsiphone affinis nicobarica*. Besides the Indian Paradise Flycatcher, a few more bird species found in India and other parts of the world have been renamed this month as part of an annual exercise.

The renaming of birds and associated "changes are inevitable as new techniques and better understanding of taxonomy cause a rearrangement - even in a relatively well-studied group of creatures like birds," according to eBird India, an online platform of ornithologists and birders. Each year, the bird taxonomists release the



updated list in August and the Cornell Lab of Ornithology has taken up the responsibility of "maintaining the ever-changing list of species, subspecies, English names, and approximate distributions," it has been pointed out.

Molecular taxonomy is the tool for identifying species. If two individuals of a species show genetic differences or exhibit genetic distances in its DNA analysis, such individuals can be considered as belonging to two different species. This is the case with the Purple Swamphen and other species which have been reclassified. The erstwhile Purple Swamphen has been split into six species in the process, explained an ornithologist.

The Purple Swamphen found in India has been reclassified as Grey-headed Swamphen and it will carry the scientific name *Porhyrio poliocephalus*. The literal meaning of *poliocephalus* is grey-headed. Interestingly,

the Purple Swamphen was renamed so a few years ago. Originally, it was called Purple Moorhen.

Common Buzzard (*Buteo buteo*) has now got a new

species. The buzzard, found in the Himalayas, will from now be known as *Buteo buteo burmanicus*. Taxonomists have split the Scaly Thrush into four species. "Two of the new species are found in India, the Nilgiri Thrush (*Zoothera neilgherriensis*) of the Western Ghats and the Scaly Thrush (*Zoothera dauma*) of central, northern and north-eastern India. A close neighbour is the Sri Lanka Thrush (*Zoothera imbricata*), which is endemic to Sri Lanka," according to the website.

Remote-controlled NASA aircraft set to track hurricanes

Washington, Aug 26

In a first, a unique remotely piloted aircraft from NASA is set to take off this week to improve track and intensity forecasts of hurricanes as part of the new generation weather forecast observations tools.

From now until the end of September, the aircraft called Global Hawk will fly over the Atlantic Ocean basin to collect data on temperature, moisture, wind speed and direction. The Global Hawk is equipped with instruments to profile the inner workings of storms.

"We are flying the Global Hawk above hurricanes and other severe storms to refine it as a new, powerful tool to better forecast

where hurricanes go and how intense they are," said Robbie Hood, director of unmanned aircraft system programme at the US National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA). Scientists will also test whether the data from the Global Hawk can help replace data collected by satellites in the unlikely event that a satellite goes down.

Global Hawk flies higher and longer than any manned aircraft.

It allows data collection from 60,000 feet, an altitude nearly twice as high as manned aircraft, to the ocean surface. It can gather weather data continuously for up to 24 hours.

World's largest solar power station to come up in Madhya Pradesh!

Bhopal, August 26

Madhya Pradesh will house world's largest 750 Mega Watts (MW) solar power station in Rewa district, State's Energy Minister Shri Rajendra Shukla said. "Global tenders for commissioning the solar power station in an area over 1,500 hectares at Bandwar region in Gudh tehsil of Rewa, will be invited shortly," Shukla said. He said that if all goes well, the plant will start generating solar energy by March 2017. The project -- Rewa Ultra Mega Solar -- is



a joint venture of Solar Energy Corporation of India and MP Urja Vikas Nigam, where in both parties have 50 per cent stake, he added. According to him, the project will come up on

barren government land and one MW power generation needs two hectares tract of land. The minister said the cost of generating one MW solar energy comes to around Rs 7.6 crore.

At present, world's largest solar power project -- Ivanpah Solar Power Facility of 392 MW -- is at Mojave deserts in California, United States, the Minister informed.

In February last year, Shri Narendra Modi, as BJP's Prime Ministerial candidate, inaugurated Asia's largest solar power project at Neemuch.

As per reports, Welspun's solar power project in Neemuch, some 400 km from here, had come up at a cost of around Rs 1,100 crore on 305 hectares of land.

Gene responsible for obesity in Indians identified

Hyderabad, Aug 26

The gene is present in everyone, but a mutation can cause the person carrying the gene to become obese. For the first time, Indian researchers have been able to isolate a gene associated with obesity which is specific to the Indian population. This is important, as identifying the genetic determinants of body mass index (BMI) will go a long way in better understanding the biological basis of overweight and obesity.

The aim of a study undertaken by research team led by Dr. Kumarasamy Thangaraj of the Hyderabad-based Centre for Cellular and Molecular Biology (CCMB) was to find a novel locus in Indian population. To do that, they



polymorphism) markers distributed throughout the genome were analysed. "We found one SNP marker (which is within a gene) of THSD7A was significantly

associated with obesity. This gene has not been associated with obesity in the Indian population," said Dr. Thangaraj. The aim of the study was to find a novel locus in the Indian population.

To reconfirm its role, a replication study involving 655 people belonging to different BMI categories - underweight, normal, overweight and obese - was

undertaken. "We found highly significant association between the marker and obesity in the replication study," he said. THSD7A is a neural N-glycoprotein, which promotes angiogenesis. Angiogenesis, in turn, modulates obesity, adipose metabolism and insulin sensitivity. And now, the authors have been able to find a correlation and this information can be used for drug target, early diagnosis of obesity and treatment.

Explaining how the gene is linked to obesity, Dr. Thangaraj said: "The gene is present in everyone. But when there is a mutation to the gene, there is a likelihood that the person carrying the mutated gene will end up being obese."

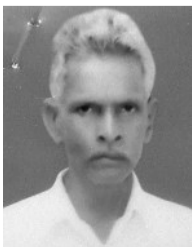
