## Transformation of India cannot happen without transformation of governance: PM

New Delhi, Aug 26 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has said transformation of India cannot happen without transformation of governance. Inaugurating the first Transforming India series lecture organised by NITI Aayog in New Delhi today, Shri Modi said, transformation of governance needs transformation in mindset and transformative ideas. He said development today depends on quality of ideas and institutions. He also said, country has to change it laws, speed up processes and adopt technology for the development. Shri Modi said, if India has to meet the challenge of change, mere incremental progress is not enough. He said, a metamorphosis is



needed to meet the challenge. Shri Modi said, nations cannot march through the twenty first century with the administrative systems of the nineteenth century and there is need of collective opening of the minds, to let in new, global perspectives. Shri Modi said, younger generation in India is thinking and aspiring so differently and government can no longer afford to remain rooted in the past. Shri Modi said, development now depends on the quality of institutions and ideas. He said, 30 years ago, a country might have been able to look inward and find

its solutions but today, countries are inter dependent and inter connected. He said, no country can afford any longer to develop in isolation. Prime Minister said, this series is being inaugurated by Mr. Tharman Shanmugaratnam, one of (Contd. on last page)

## MP urges Administration for taking proactive steps for regular power supply in rural areas



Port Blair, Aug 26 During the visit of the Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray in

the villages of Bidnabad, Calicut and Burmanalla area under South Andaman on Aug 25, a large number of general public and residents of the said area reported that frequent power disruption is happening in these areas. This was also practically observed by him during his visit in the said vicinity. Similarly, during his current tour to North & Middle Andaman from Aug 26 onwards, a large number of general public and residents from various corners have also reported that even in the rural area of Mayabunder Tehsil such as Mayabunder, Webbi, Pahalgao, Tugapur, Rest Camp, Basanthipur, Harinagar etc. frequent

power disruption without any prior notice is happening in the area at least 2 or 3 times in a day. This is causing great difficulties for the residents, particularly during night time besides badly affecting their children's education. Considering the matter as serious, the Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, immediately brought it to the notice of the Chief Secretary, Secretary (Power) and SP, N&M Andaman over phone for their attention and urged them to take proactive steps for regular power supply in the rural area without interruption, a communication from Office of the MP said.

Addressing the gathering, the chief guest remarked that mother's milk is nutritious & healthy for the baby. She stressed that breast feeding is important for the babies' overall development and should be encouraged among mothers as it helps prevent diarrhoea, pneumonia and infant mortality besides various other diseases.

She also urged ASHA workers, Anganwadi workers, ANMs and health educators to sensitize the rural population about the need and importance of breastfeeding their new born babies and also to educate them not feed the new born with honey. Lauding the Govt. for taking various measures for the welfare of women and children in the country, she urged people to make best use of the schemes launched. She said the

wages of Anganwadi workers needs to be increased and efforts will be made in this regard while pregnant/ lactating mothers who are financially weak should be given an incentive of Rs.6000 to meet their various needs. Speaking on the occasion, the Director, Health Service, Dr. Shipra Paul informed that in A&N Islands, 96% institution deliveries takes place and infant mortality rate is very low here. However, she

said, continuous efforts should be made to ensure zero infant mortality and called upon media, general public, and parents to extend their support in making this programme a success.

Explaining about the components of breast feeding programme, she said it includes mass awareness generation, community health interaction, awareness by Doctor/Nurses/ ANM workers and monitoring of the programme.

In his keynote address, Dr. Navin Govind, Deputy Director (FW&HE) said the Govt. of India has launched the yearlong nationwide programme called 'MAA-Mother's Absolute Affection' all over the country for promotion, protection and support of

## Fisheries Deptt. cautions against transporting live fish seed from mainland

Port Blair, Aug 26 The Directorate of Fisheries has cautioned people against importing any species of live fish of freshwater or marine including its juveniles or seedlings to the Islands from the mainland without proper clearance from the competent authority. The directions have been issued as it has come to the notice of the Department that some person, traders are transporting live fish seed to the Islands from mainland through ship/air route. As per the provisions of

A&N Marine Fishing Rule -2004, rule 16 (e) "Person, Trader, Firm or Organization shall not import any species of fish (live) freshwater or marine including its juveniles or seedlings whether indigenous or exotic to the islands, provided such import is allowed for research or scientific or demonstration purpose by the Director of Fisheries on production of necessary quarantine clearance issued in respect of the consignment by the competent authority", a communication said.

Port Blair, Aug 26  
The Twentieth Round of Foot and Mouth Disease Vaccination for Livestock is being carried out by the Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services in South Andaman from Aug 26, 2016. The vaccination programme will continue till Sept. 9, 2016.

Although Andaman & Nicobar Islands have been maintaining the disease free status against most of the infectious and contagious disease of Livestock for example, Rinderpest, Foot & Mouth Disease, Anthrax, Black Quarter etc. till recently. There was an outbreak of Foot and Mouth Disease among Livestock in selected villages of South Andaman immediately after Tsunami. Since then Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services have been implementing the Foot and Mouth Disease control programme as per the guidelines issued by the Govt. of India.

breastfeeding practices through health system to achieve higher breast feeding rates of quality survival of new born in the country.  
He said breast feeding has to be done for new born baby till six months followed by breast feeding & other supplementary upto 2 years is compulsory as it helps prevent diarrhoea and pneumonia in infant (zero to five years). He informed that ASHA worker, health workers and staff nurses will be imparted training in this regard and called upon everyone to help spread awareness on breast feeding.
