## 'Khelo India Samvaad' to be held on August 27 on the occasion of National Sports Day

**Hon'ble Prime Minister to interact with youth virtually; over 8 lakh youth to participate from 1,600 locations across the country**

Mumbai, Aug. 25 (PIB)

National Sports Day is celebrated on August 29 every year to commemorate the birth anniversary of legendary hockey player Major Dhyan Chand. theoretical classes were conducted on the estrous cycle, hormonal control, synchronisation of estrus, reproductive physiology and various procedures involved in Embryo Transfer Technique. In addition to the theoretical sessions, practical classes were held on reproductive organ palpation, identification of reproductive status and practical techniques involved in embryo transfer. The hands-on practical sessions were highly informative and beneficial in developing practical understanding and skills related to assisted reproductive techniques.

The participants were also given demonstrations and practical exposure to various stages of the embryo production process, including ovum pick-up, oocyte/ova collection, embryogenesis, embryo freezing/cryopreservation, thawing techniques and transportation of embryos. The procedures followed at NDDB were demonstrated in a systematic and practical manner. The training programme also included refresher sessions and interactive discussions, which helped in strengthening the existing knowledge of the participants regarding advanced reproductive technologies in livestock.

The programme concluded with a valedictory function, during which certificates of successful completion of the training were awarded to the participating officers. Overall, the training programme was highly informative and beneficial, providing valuable theoretical knowledge as well as practical exposure to Embryo Transfer Technology and other assisted reproductive techniques. Field demonstration prog. on Azolla Cultivation organised under UT-ATMA

The Department of AH&VS, under UT-ATMA, organised field demonstration programmes on Azolla cultivation on 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2026 at the farmers' fields of Shri Bishwajit Sana and Shri Swapan Mondal, both residents of Ramkrishnapur village.

A total of 21 participants attended the two demonstration programmes. During the sessions, the farmers were explained the method of cultivating Azolla, its nutritional benefits as a livestock feed, and the simple techniques for establishing and maintaining Azolla pits. As part of the programme, inputs comprising concentrated cattle feed worth Rs.4,800/- per



demonstration were supplied to the beneficiaries. In addition, Azolla saplings were provided for establishing Azolla pits prepared by the beneficiaries of Azolla as a nutritious, low-cost and locally available livestock feed.

The demonstrations generated considerable awareness and interest among the farmers regarding the benefits of Azolla as a nutritious, low-cost and locally available livestock feed. Promotion of such sustainable feed resources can significantly reduce the cost of animal rearing and improve the productivity of livestock, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

**The terms and conditions of the e-Auction are given below: -**

- Each prospective bidder shall be required to deposit an earnest money, which shall be 5% of the Minimum Reserve Price for the quarry area with the Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman before participating in the e-auction (drawn in favour of Assistant Commissioner, Settlement).

  - The prospective bidder has to submit necessary copies of documents duly self-attested viz. quarry lease deed and (or) Consent to Operate (CTO)/ consent to establish (CTE) issued by any State/UT Govt. or other Govt. agencies of two (2) years in quarrying and (or) crushing activities from the year beginning 2012 to till date. The prospective bidders have to submit an affidavit duly sworn before the Executive Magistrate/Notary Public stating that the prospective bidders have the capabilities with respect to personnel, equipment's/ machineries and manufacturing facilities in handling of quarrying and crushing units in compliance to the rules and regulation in force.   - The successful bidder shall have to execute quarry lease deed before execution of quarry operation.
  - The lessee shall pay residual bid amount before executing the lease deed.
  - The lease holder shall be liable to pay advance income tax as per provisions of section 206(c) of income tax act in addition to bid amount, payable as per terms and condition of contract agreement before submission of royalty.
  - The lease holder shall be liable to pay the dead rent for the quarry area, royalty as notified from time to time.
  - The lease holder shall be liable to pay the GST as admissible from time to time on royalty paid, to GST Commissionarate and quarterly report to this effect shall be submitted to the competent authority along with supplementary documents specifically showing GST paid for the royalty of stone boulders.
  - The lease holder shall have stacking place for proper storage of quarry products in such a way that measurement would be taken if required.
  - The lease holder shall undertake the quarrying in the quarry area in terms of the quarry plan notified and in accordance with the responsibilities as laid down under Rule 13 of the A & N Islands Minor Minerals Rules, 2012.
  - No lease holder shall be entitled to raise any dispute with the reference to the survey and demarcation of the quarry permitted out to him after execution of the quarry lease deed.
  - The lease holder shall be permitted to extract maximum of **12000 cbm** of stone boulder during **01 (One) year** from the quarry area leased out to him and he/she is expected to satisfy himself of the availability of minor mineral to this extent prior to participating in the e-auction.   - That the lease holder shall abide by the provisions of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and development) Act, 1957, A & N Islands Minor Minerals Rules, 2012 and the Rules and Regulations regarding Employment and Conditions of Service as for the time being in force and also the provisions of other labour laws
- as are applicable to the workmen engaged in the quarries and any other relevant laws for the time being in force.
- In case of any tree/ plantation** is removed during quarrying activity, the lease holder will plant a minimum of twice the number of such plants, which will be in addition to the plantation to be done otherwise as per quarry plan. Before removal of any tree permission of competent authority shall be obtained.
  - Over burden** and other waste if any, should be dumped at identified sites using proper techniques and precautions. Dumps the stabilised suitably by formation of retaining wall/ check dams at outer periphery of dumping sites followed by plantation. Inactive dumps should be covered under the plantation wherever required as proposed under quarry plan. Garland drain should be constructed around the waste dump site inside area to prevent run off from the waste dump to arrest siltation.
  - Regular sprinkling of water be carried out to ensure that the suspended particulate matter level does not exceed the ambient air quality standards, within the entire quarry leased area and the pathways leading to quarry area.
  - Sampling of ambient air quality in the core zone for suspended particulate matter, respirable particulate matter sulphur dioxide, oxides of nitrogen should be carried out once in every six months in the consultation with the Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC), Sri Vijaya Puram.
  - The overall noise level in and around the quarry area will be kept well within prescribed limits of noise emissions as per Environment Protection Act, 1986 and rules framed there under.

37. That the lease holder shall carry out quarrying in accordance with all other provisions applicable for undertaking quarrying including the provisions of Forest(Conservation) Act,1980 and Environment (Protection) Act,1986 and the rules made there under.

38. The lease holder shall abide all the conditions laid down in the Environment Clearance granted by the competent Authority vide EC identification No. EC26C0108AN5607064N and the lease holder shall comply/abide with any additional terms/conditions if any stipulated at any time and all environmental concerns and the safety of the workers are to be addressed.

39. Apart from above, the provisions of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules and regulation under Public liability insurance act, 1991 shall also be enforced.

40. That the lease holder shall undertake necessary measures for landscaping of the quarry area.

41. That the lease holder shall without delay send a report of any accident, causing loss of life or serious bodily injuries or endangering life or property which may at any time occur at or in the said land during the course of operations undertaken under the lease, to the Tehsildar concerned, the Sub- Divisional Magistrate and the Deputy Commissioner.

42. That the lease holder shall submit returns and maintain requisite register and memorandums as prescribed under the A & N Islands Minor Minerals Rules, 2012.

43. That on expiry or premature termination of the lease, the quarried materials, lying on the land from which they are extracted, shall become the absolute property of the A & N Administration.

44. Force Majeure means such of the following factors which substantially affect the performance of the agreement, such as: natural phenomena, including but not limited to floods, draughts, earthquakes, Cyclones and Epidemics; acts of any Government, domestic or foreign, including but not limited to war, declared or undeclared, quarantines, embargoes. Either party shall within fifteen (15) days from the occurrence of such a cause notify the other in writing of such causes.

45. The Lessee or the Deputy Commissioner (South Andaman) shall not be liable for delays in performing their obligations resulting from any Force Majeure cause as referred to and/or defined above.

46. However, if such an event lasts for a period of 90 days or more than either party shall have an option to terminate this Agreement forthwith without any liability after intimating the other party of the same and such event shall be governed by Rule 46 of ANIMMR, 2012.

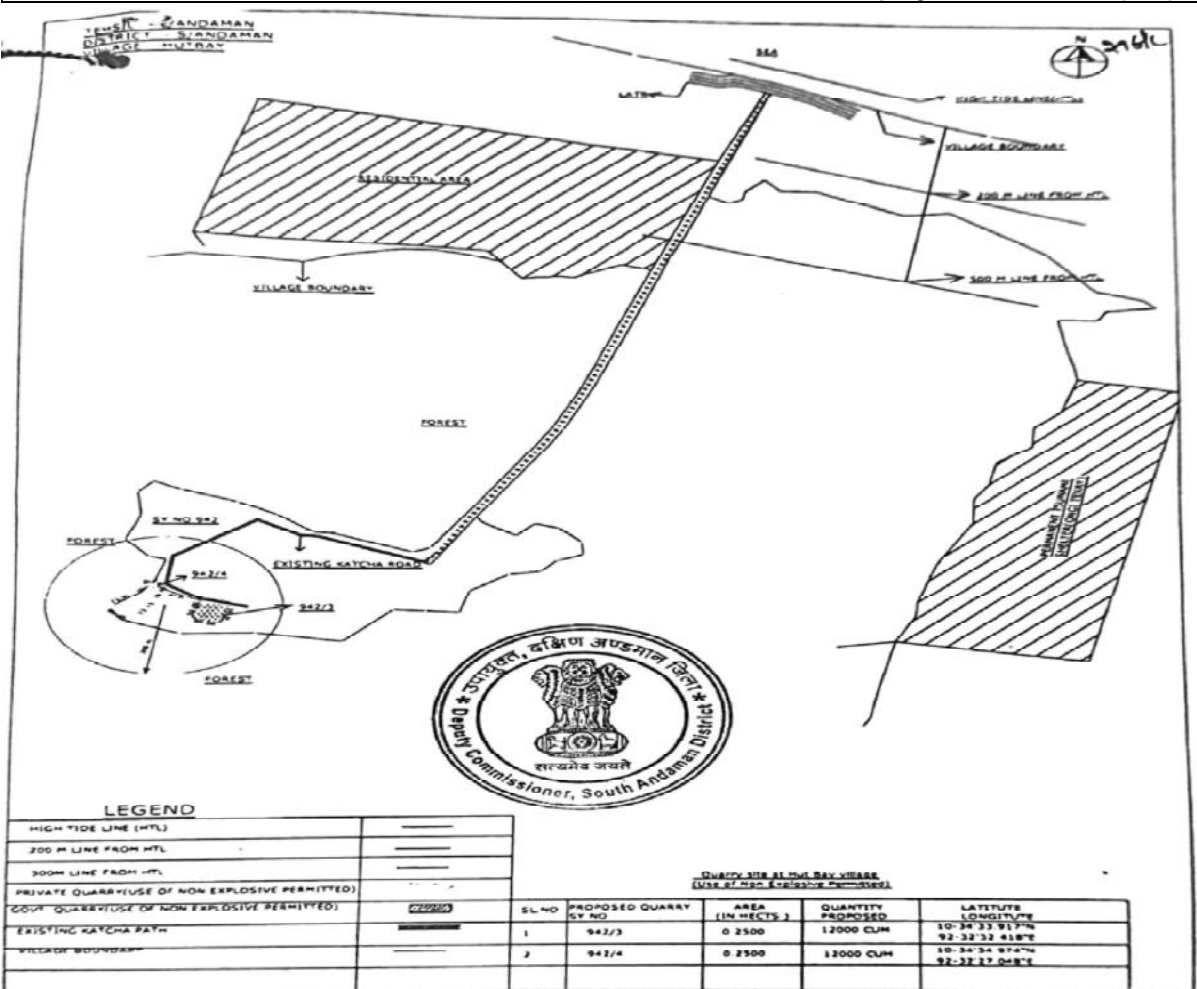
