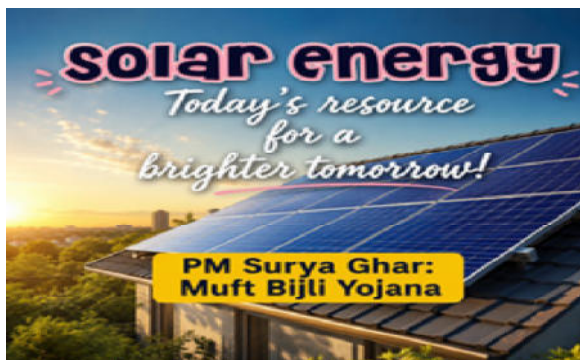

Hon'ble Lt. Governor conducts comprehensive inspection of G.B. Pant Hospital

Directs preparation of time-bound action plan for restoration of essential medical services

Emphasis on early revival of Jan Aushadhi Kendra and proposals to increase MBBS & PG seats in ANIIMS

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 26

The Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Dr. Dinesh Sharma, today conducted a comprehensive inspection of G.B. Pant Hospital, Sri Vijaya Puram, and undertook an in-depth review of the medical facilities, arrangements and overall management of the hospital. He interacted directly with patients and their attendants to enquire about the treatment being provided, available facilities and the difficulties and inconveniences faced by them.

During the inspection of the Pharmacy Counter, directions were given to ensure adequate stock of all essential medicines required for day-to-day treatment, so that patients do not have to depend excessively in the markets outside for medicines. Emphasis was also laid on making the Jan Aushadhi Kendra located within the hospital premises functional at the earliest



and ensuring its regular and effective operation to provide quality medicines to patients at affordable prices.

During the inspection of the Pathology Laboratory, the available facilities, equipment and functioning of the laboratory were reviewed. Directions were given to

identify essential laboratory machines that are currently unavailable at the hospital and prepare proposals for their procurement at the earliest, so that all necessary diagnostic facilities can be made available within the hospital premises in a time-bound manner.



Taking serious note of the non-functional MRI machine, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor directed that it be repaired on a war footing and made operational at the earliest, while ensuring its continuous functioning thereafter. The Chief Secretary (In-charge) was directed that procurement

of equipment should be undertaken through a fully transparent tendering process.

The Hon'ble Lt. Governor also inspected various wards, including Ophthalmology, Orthopaedics, Surgery, Medicine and Paediatrics, and interacted with

Historic reforms in Education Sector in A&N Islands

Recognition period for New Schools extended from 1 Year to 5 years; documents reduced from 19 to 5

Sri Vijaya Puram, Sept. 26

In a significant step towards making the education sector in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands simpler, more transparent and accessible, the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, Andaman and

Nicobar Islands, Dr. Dinesh Sharma, has approved a key proposal aimed at easing the process of recognition of new schools.

Recognition period extended:

The period of recognition for new schools, which had

earlier been reduced from three years to one year, has now been extended to five years. The move will provide greater stability to newly established educational institutions and enable them to focus more effectively on improving

academic quality and educational outcomes.

In another major reform, the number of documents required for recognition of schools has been reduced from 19 to just 5. The decision will significantly

Important initiative to strengthen basic infrastructure in rural areas through PRIs

Hon'ble Lt. Governor reviewed & approved 14 development works related to various PRIs in Isles

Asian Games 2026 kabaddi: Sumit's heroics help India clinch gold medal

Aichi, Nagoya, Sept. 26
The Indian men's kabaddi team bagged gold after beating the Islamic Republic of Iran 40-34 in the Asian Games 2026 final at the Tokai Citizen Gymnasium in Aichi on Friday.
India have now won nine of the 10 Asian Games kabaddi men's titles contested to date with the only exception being Jakarta 2018, where Iran emerged as the champions
Sumit played a pivotal role in the turnaround, initiating some crunching, game-changing tackles.



Indian women's kabaddi team clinch Gold at Asian Games 2026

Aichi, Nagoya, Sept. 26
The Indian women's kabaddi team clinched Gold after beating Iran at the 2026 Asian Games. The Indian women went on an unbeaten run throughout their campaign. The dominant Indian side edged out Iran in a tense final clash at the Tokai Citizen Gymnasium in Aichi-Nagoya, winning the contest by a 37-34 margin.



Sawan Barwal wins silver in men's marathon at Asian Games 2026



Aichi, Nagoya, Sept. 26
Indian marathon runner Sawan Barwal created history at the Asian Games 2026 by winning a silver medal in the men's marathon event, ending India's 44-year wait for a podium finish in the discipline. Barwal clocked 2:11:37 to register a personal best and set a new national record in the men's marathon final. He finished behind Japan's Yamashita, who claimed the gold medal after pulling ahead in the closing stages of the race.

Tajinderpal Toor Singh wins silver medal



Aichi, Nagoya, Sept. 26
India's Tajinderpal Singh Toor won silver in the men's shot put with a best effort of 20.64m, finishing behind Iran's Mohammadreza Tayebise, who set an Asian Games record of 20.81m. He adds a third Asian Games medal to his collection, having won gold at the previous two editions.

patients to enquire about their health and treatment facilities. He also met patients belonging to the tribal community admitted in the Jarawa Ward and enquired about their well-being. The concerned officials were directed to demonstrate special sensitivity and promptness in their treatment and care.

Giving the highest priority to the convenience of patients and their attendants, directions were issued to establish a Patient Attendants' Accommodation Facility within the hospital premises and to ensure adequate seating and waiting arrangements in the Male Ward.

During his interaction with faculty members and doctors, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor directed the preparation of a concrete and time-bound action plan for restoration of essential medical services and for making all services functional at the earliest. He also directed that the ventilators be repaired immediately.

The issue of increasing the number of doctors working in the hospital was directed to be taken up on priority. Necessary action was also directed to be initiated for creation of new posts on contractual basis and for ensuring stability in the tenure of doctors engaged on contract.

The Hon'ble Lt. Governor further emphasized the need to prepare necessary proposals and take further action for increasing the number of MBBS and PG seats at ANIIMS, with a view to enhancing the availability of specialist doctors in the Islands and further strengthening medical education and healthcare services. He also directed that cancer and cardiology services be made fully functional and operated effectively.

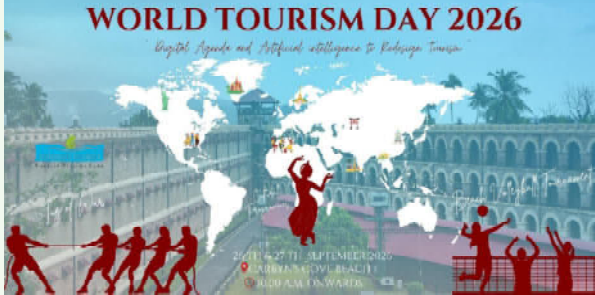

No.....F.No.2-259/RR/IP&T/2018, in exercise of powers conferred under the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India read with Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi Notification No.U-14/3/60-ANL dated 11th April,1960 and in supersession of all previous Notifications issued to this effect, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands hereby **proposed** to make the following Rules to regulate the method of recruitment to Group 'C' post of **News Reporter** borne in the Information & Publicity Division of Directorate of IP&T, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, namely ;

Claims and objections are invited from stakeholders/persons to be affected thereby. The claims and objections (if any) should reach the office of Director of IP & T, A&N Administration, Sri Vijaya Puram within 30 days from the date of its publication in the official website for examination and consideration.

1. **Short Title and Commencement :-**
i. These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration (Group 'C' post of News Reporter in the establishment of Information and Publicity Division) Recruitment Rule, 2026.

ii. They shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazettee.

2. **Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of Pay:-**
The number of posts, its classification and the Scale of Pay attached thereto shall be as specified in paras 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of Recruitment, Age Limit and Qualification:-**
The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in paras 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification :-**
No person –
a. Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
b. Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post;

6. **Savings:-**
Nothing in these Rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Schedule Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

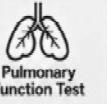
