New Delhi, Nov 26

The programme will be broadcast on the entire network of All India Radio and Doordarshan from 11 am. It will be immediately followed by Regional Versions. The programme



would also be streamed on the YouTube channels of Prime Minister's Office, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting and DD News. Regional language versions of this broadcast will be aired by AIR stations in respective regions at 8 in the evening.

Cuba's Fidel Castro dies aged 90

Cuba, Nov 26
Revolutionary icon, former Cuban President and leader of the Communist revolution, Fidel Castro ruled Cuba as a one-party state for almost half a century before handing over the powers to his brother Raul in 2008. His supporters praised him as a man who had given Cuba back to the people. Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has extended condolences to



the Cuban government and people of the country on the demise of Fidel Castro. In a series of tweets, Shri Modi said Fidel Castro was one of the most iconic personalities of the 20th century.

Govt to substitute physical currency with digital money

New Delhi, Nov 26
The Government today said it wants to substitute physical currency with digital money. In reply to supplementaries in the Lok Sabha, Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley said, the government's effort is to see that the quantum of physical currency comes down, but trade and economy must expand.

Shri Jaitley said there are 80 crore debit cards of various kinds in circulation and 40 crore of them are being used at the ATMs actively. He said electronic wallets and digital transfer of funds are the future technology and government is encouraging it. He also sought cooperation of state governments in this regard.

The day is also observed to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all countrymen and to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women.

RBI asks banks to be cash-ready for pensioners, armed forces

New Delhi, Nov 26
RBI has asked banks to ensure cash supply for pensioners and armed forces in the wake of limited currencies in the market following cancellation of Rs 500 and Rs 1,000 notes as demand for cash from government officials and pensioners is expected after electronic payment of their salary or pension. The apex bank said banks



are therefore, advised to take appropriate steps in order to meet this likely demand for cash. The RBI also asked banks to make cash available at military outposts.

Successful bidders of Food Kiosks advised

Port Blair, Nov. 26
All the highest successful bidders of Food Kiosks which was auctioned on Nov. 9 at Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Auditorium, regarding the allotment of Food Kiosks on monthly rental basis through auction call, have been asked to deposit the security amount of Rs.

1,00,000/- in the form of fixed deposit receipt in favour of Secretary, PBMC by Nov. 28, 2016, failing which the allotment of Kiosk will stand cancelled and EMD amount will be forfeited, a communication from the Chief Accounts Officer, Municipal Council said.

Govt releases drafts of revised model GST, IGST and GST compensation laws

New Delhi, Nov 26
Government has released the Revised Draft Model GST Law, Draft IGST Law, and Draft GST compensation law in public domain. In a series of tweets, Revenue Secretary Shri Hasmukh Adhia said these laws will be considered by GST Council in its meeting scheduled for 2nd and 3rd December and finalized.

The GST Council meeting, which was initially scheduled for yesterday, was postponed till 2nd and 3rd of next month with several states suggesting changes in the model GST Law and compensation formula. Centre had on November 16 circulated the draft legislation among the states. Government proposes to introduce these legislations as money bills to ensure they are not stuck in the Rajya Sabha where the ruling

NDA does not have a majority. The Integrated GST law would deal with inter-state movement of goods and services. Also, the states will draft their own State GST based on the draft model law with minor variations incorporating state-based exemption. The compensation law will list out how states will be compensated in the initial five years for revenue loss on account of GST rollout.

Eviction drive in North & Middle Andaman District

Rangat, Nov 26
In pursuance of the policy of 'Zero Tolerance' towards encroachment on Government land, the encroachment eviction team of Revenue Department has taken various step towards protection of Government land in Rangat Tehsil. Accordingly, an eviction drive was conducted by the encroachment eviction team in the villages of Padmanabhapuram and Rampur and parnasala, wherein 10 unauthorized

occupation from the government revenue land were evicted and restored to the Government land to the extent of about 8 hectare. The eviction team was led by Shri Balku Toppo, Revenue Inspectors (HQ), Shri Sudip Saha (Patwari), Shri Daneil (Patwari) and other team members under the supervision of District Administration. General public have been cautioned to refrain from such unauthorized activities and
