Media briefed on COVID-19

One positive case detected during test conducted on incoming flight passengers

Port Blair, Nov. 26 The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar while giving information on COVID-19 status stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 288 passengers who arrived here yesterday, one positive case has been detected. Today, 13 flights with 2,251 passengers arrived, out of which, 1770 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 481 passengers and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 118 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 55 passengers and all were found negative. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 48 passengers were tested with RAT and were found negative. During test conducted on 3 passengers at Helipad, no positive case was detected. Today, 619 beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 598 were in the age group of 18-44. The Director, ANIIMS, Dr. AK Mandal informed that at present one COVID patient is undergoing treatment at GB Pant Hospital.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

5,46,490 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far

Port Blair, Nov.26 The safety of the citizens is the foremost priority of the Administration, especially during this pandemic time. To shield its citizens from the corona virus, the vaccination of eligible beneficiaries is being initiated by the Administration in different parts of the Islands. Accordingly, the vaccination began with administering of COVISHIELD vaccine for Health Care Workers followed by frontline workers and vulnerable population with co-morbidities. Subsequently, the vaccination for 45 and above was initiated followed by 18 to 44 years which is currently underway. Meanwhile, the vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 5,46,490 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2, 81, 603 (approx.). A total of 2413 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 2094 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which 103 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 277 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 12 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 42 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 6 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,75,411 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Trimodel Therapy Module (CIARI-Gau Maa Rakshak) to Treat Humpsores in cattle

This methodology is a combination of different medicines and time of administration and which is economic, effective with quick recovery. The methodology includes cleaning of the wound with liquid soap to remove the dirt and application of green papaya mist on the wound surface (30 minutes) for 3 days to digest the dead tissues. Antiseptic and fly repellent ointment is to be applied daily for 45 days to check the bacterial infection and further deposition of larva of *Stephanofilaria*. Parenteral administration of *Avermectin* 200µg/kg body weight on day 0, 15 and 30 to kill microfilaria. Oral administration of tablet *Diethylcarbamazine citrate* 6 mg/kg body weight daily for 45 days to kill macrofilaria. Clinical improvement is observed day 15 of the post treatment onwards; however the whole treatment protocol has to be followed.

Benefit:

- * Wound size (cm²) significantly reduces from 175 to 32 on day 15 and to 1.50 on day 30.
- * Success rate of the treatment: 95%.
- * Milk yield increases in 76.47% of the treated animals by 15-20%.
- * Reduces the stress level.
