Election Commissioner of India on visit to A&N Islands

SIR of electoral rolls is a strategic exercise by ECI aimed at thoroughly updating, verifying, removing and correcting the voter lists across India: ECI, Dr. Vivek Joshi

Election Commissioner of India, Dr. Vivek Joshi, today presided over a meeting in the conference hall of the A&N Secretariat with the Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands & District Election Officers regarding the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls, currently underway in A&N Islands. The SIR is an initiative by the Election Commission of India (ECI) to update and purify voter lists and its purpose is to create accurate and error-free voter lists by identifying and removing deceased, permanently shifted, and duplicate electors.

At the outset, the Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands, Shri L. Kumar, IAS welcomed the Election Commissioner, Dr. Vivek Joshi on his visit to A&N Islands. Thereafter, the CEO through a power point presentation gave a detail account of the SIR exercise being undertaken in A&N Islands with the sole aim to prepare a robust and accurate Electoral Roll, the objective of which is that "no eligible citizen is left out while no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll".

The CEO stated that the number



of electors as on 27.10.2025 is 3,10,404 out of which 1,60,523 are male, 1,49,877 are female and 4 are third gender. He further said that in order to complete the SIR exercise with utmost transparency DEO, ERO, AERO, BLO Supervisor, BLO & BLAs have been appointed.

Training programmes have been conducted for AEROs, BLOs and BLO Supervisors in all the three Districts for the smooth conduct of the SIR exercise covering the length & breadth of A&N Islands. The CEO further informed that altogether, 3,10,346 Enumeration Forms have been distributed to the electors and 2,21,391 filled in forms have been collected as on 26.11.2025 (by 10 am).

The Enumeration Forms digitised collected from the electors stands at 66.12 percent. The CEO also apprised the Election Commissioner about the meetings held with the Political Parties

at the CEO, DEO, ERO and AERO levels. The political parties have also extended their cooperation & support by appointing around 800 Booth Level Agents, who are working in close coordination with the BLOs to support the enumeration work, the CEO added.

On reviewing the SIR exercise in A&N Islands, the Election Commissioner, Dr. Vivek Joshi said that the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls is a strategic exercise by the Election Commission of India (ECI) aimed at thoroughly updating, verifying, removing and correcting the voter lists across India. Its goal is to ensure that the electoral roll is accurate, inclusive and free from errors such as duplicates, deceased voters, or ineligible entries. The Election Commissioner expressed his

happiness that SIR exercise is being undertaken in A&N Islands in a systematic way as per the laid down guidelines of the Election Commission. He noted with appreciation that about 896 electors have filled the Enumeration Forms through online mode. While emphasizing the importance of inclusive elections, he urged officials to focus more on the leverage of technology for electoral services to facilitate youth voter enrolment. The Election Commissioner further stated that the Commission has further simplified the online search option for the mapping of electors with last SIR by name, relation, district adding transliteration option for easy search by visiting ECI portal : <https://voters.eci.gov.in/>.

Ahmedabad to Host 2030 Commonwealth Games



New Delhi, Nov. 26

Ahmedabad has been confirmed as the host of the Centenary Commonwealth Games in 2030, marking India's second time staging the event after New Delhi in 2010. The decision was approved by delegates from 74 Commonwealth nations at the General Assembly in Glasgow. Ahmedabad's vision builds on the momentum of Glasgow 2026 and highlights India's cultural and sporting strengths. Commonwealth Sport said that the 2030 edition will feature 15 to 17 sports, with the full programme to be finalised next year. The Games aim to unite athletes and communities while celebrating a century of Commonwealth sporting tradition.

Revolutionary steps in dairy sector AHVS assures 90% chance of female calf born

Sri Vijaya Puram, Nov. 26

The Department of AH&VS, has highlighted the continuing success of the Accelerated Breed Improvement Programme using Sex-Sorted Semen (ABIP-SSS), launched in July, 2024 under the Rashtriya Gokul Mission. Since its inception, the Department has performed over four hundred sex-sorted semen inseminations across North & Middle Andaman, South Andaman and Nicobar districts, bringing advanced reproductive technology directly to the doorsteps of island farmers.

In the last six months alone, seventeen healthy female calves



have been born under this programme in villages stretching from Diglipur to Campbell Bay. These seventeen births represent the most intensive and successful phase of the initiative so far, with many more pregnancies currently in progress.

The ABIP-SSS programme uses cutting-edge technology

that separates X and Y chromosomes in semen, delivering up to ninety to ninety-three percent probability of female calf production. High-genetic-merit sex-sorted semen of Jersey x Gir cross, Jersey x Sahiwal cross, and 100% Jersey bulls is made available at a highly subsidised rate of only Rs. 250 per dose (original cost Rs. 675), with the department bearing the remaining amount. To further reduce risk for farmers, if conception does not occur in the first attempt, a second dose is provided at the same nominal rate. In case both attempts fail, the entire amount paid by the farmer for both doses is fully refunded. This farmer-friendly policy

This technology offers island farmers multiple advantages: guaranteed female progeny for faster herd expansion, higher milk yields from genetically superior animals well-adapted to tropical island conditions, elimination of unwanted male calves, reduced rearing costs, and significantly improved income within three to four years when the calves start lactating.

Farmers who have received these valuable female calves express deep satisfaction and gratitude to the department for making such advanced technology accessible and affordable. The consistent success and the unique refund policy have generated tremendous enthusiasm and encouraged many more farmers to register their animals for the programme.

Shri. Krushna Mohan Beura, Manager (Animal Breeding), National Dairy Development Board, made a monitoring visit to the islands from Nov. 17 to 19, 2025. During the visit, three randomly selected Artificial Insemination Centres where calvings have been recorded under the project were inspected. Shri. Beura personally verified all animals with calving entries in the Bharat Pashudhan App along with the animals inseminated with sex-sorted semen, and expressed satisfaction over the proper implementation and authentic recording of field-level results.

The AH&VS Department is committed to further expanding the reach of ABIP-SSS through continuous awareness campaigns, advanced training of AI technicians, and uninterrupted supply of quality sex-sorted semen. The target remains to steadily increase the number of female calves born every month and create a strong foundation for long-term milk self-sufficiency across the islands.

The birth of seventeen female calves in just the last six months, duly verified at the national level, is a clear testimony to the effectiveness of the programme and the dedication of field teams. It marks a vital step towards transforming dairy farming, strengthening rural livelihoods, and building a prosperous, milk-sufficient future for the Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

DSS issues guidelines for ensuring smooth, safe, and efficient cargo booking & handling operations

Sri Vijaya Puram, Nov. 26

It has been observed that despite repeated directions, excess cargo is being bought at the time of loading at jetty by the labours/traders. To ensure safe and efficient cargo handling operations at the jetty, the Directorate of Shipping Services hereby brings to the attention of all stakeholders/labours/ Government agencies and the general public to follow below mentioned guidelines to ensure smooth, safe, and efficient cargo booking and handling operations:

> Cargo booking for scheduled vessels shall be accepted up to three (03) days prior to the vessel's scheduled departure. No booking

will be done on the day of loading and cargo booking will be carried out exclusively at the Commercial Wing of DSS. No cargo booking shall be entertained at the jetty.

> Cargo will be accepted and handled strictly on a first-come, first-served basis, subject to booking confirmation and adherence to timing guidelines.

> All Commercial cargo bookings must be made in the name of a registered firm/ establishment. Bookings in the name of individuals will not be accepted except personal belongings.

> For the morning loading shift, cargo must be delivered before 10:00 AM. For the second loading shift, cargo must

be delivered before 05:00 PM.

> It has been observed that excess cargo is being brought to the jetty, resulting in congestion and operational difficulties. Stakeholders are instructed to bring cargo only as per the confirmed booking/ Manifest and strictly within the permitted limits.

> The Checking Inspectors and Tally clerks must ensure that the cargo should be loaded as per Manifest. No Excess Cargo will be allowed to load in the vessel.

All concerned have been requested to comply with the above instructions to facilitate smooth vessel operations and efficient cargo handling, a press release from DSS said.
