The SIR is an initiative by the Election Commission of India (ECI) to update and purify voter lists and its purpose is to create accurate and error-free voter lists by identifying and removing deceased, permanently shifted, and

duplicate electors. At the outset, the Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands, Shri L. Kumar, IAS welcomed the Election Commissioner, Dr. Vivek Joshi on his visit to A&N Islands. Thereafter, the CEO through a power point presentation gave a detail account undertaken in A&N Islands with the sole aim to prepare a robust and accurate Electoral Roll, the objective of which is that "no eligible citizen is left out while no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll".



This technology offers island farmers multiple advantages: guaranteed female progeny for faster herd expansion, higher milk yields from genetically superior animals well-adapted to tropical island conditions, elimination of unwanted male calves, reduced rearing costs, and significantly improved income within three to four years when the calves start lactating.







Farmers who have received these valuable female calves express deep satisfaction and gratitude to the department for making such advanced technology accessible and affordable. The consistent success and the unique refund policy have generated tremendous enthusiasm and encouraged many more farmers to register their animals for the programme.

Shri. Krushna Mohan Beura, Manager (Animal Breeding), National Dairy Development Board, made a monitoring visit to the islands from Nov. 17 to 19, 2025. During the visit, three randomly selected Artificial Insemination Centres where calvings have been recorded under the project were inspected. Shri. 


