RBI to soon release new Rs 20 note



Mumbai, Dec 26

The Reserve Bank of India will soon introduce Rs 20 notes with additional features.

The Reserve Bank has already issued new-look currency notes in the denominations of Rs 10, Rs 50, Rs 100, and Rs 500, besides introducing Rs 200 and Rs 2000 notes after

demonetisation. The new notes are being introduced under the Mahatma Gandhi series. The new currency notes are different in size and design compared to issued previously. The currency notes, except for banned Rs 500 and Rs 1000, issued under the old series continue to remain legal tender.

Government approves Rameshwaram-Dhanushkodi project

New Delhi, Dec 26

The government has approved laying a new broad gauge railway line connecting Rameshwaram with Dhanushkodi, which is believed to be the starting point of Ram Sethu and a major pilgrim destination. The 17-km line will cost around Rs 208 crore and it has been included in the umbrella work for new lines in the current financial year. Dhanushkodi railway station was destroyed and abandoned after the 1964 Rameshwaram cyclone and

it remains unattended. The new railway line will be a boon to pilgrims visiting the place. Hindu pilgrimage at Rameshwaram gets completed only after taking a dip in Dhanushkodi. The railways has also approved building a new bridge on Pamban channel, which will replace the 104-year-old structure over the sea. The vertical-lift bridge, to be built alongside the existing bridge at Rs 249 crore, will have the first vertical lift span in India. The old bridge was closed for traffic earlier this month.

Both Houses of Parliament to resume after 3-day break

New Delhi, Dec 26

Both the Houses of Parliament will resume on Thursday after a weekend and a three-day break on account of Christmas. In the Lok Sabha, the Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Marriage) Bill is scheduled to be taken up for consideration and passing tomorrow.

The Bill proposes all declarations of instant triple talaq void and illegal. It seeks to make the practice a punishable offence with imprisonment of up to three

years. The Bill will replace the Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Marriage) Ordinance-2018.

The National Medical Council (Amendment) Bill 2018 has also been listed among others for tomorrow's legislative business.

In the Rajya Sabha, The Trafficking of Persons (Prevention, Protection and Rehabilitation) Bill 2018, and The National Council for Teacher Education (Amendment) Bill, 2018 and others have been listed for consideration and passing.

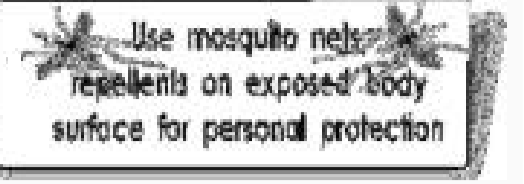

New Industrial Training Institute at Arong in Car Nicobar ready for inauguration

The Administration lays great emphasis on skill development for the youth enabling each person of this Islands to acquire skill to enhance their employability and to have better standard of life. The Administration has made many efforts in this direction such as convergence of skill development activities for focused implementation with definite result, opening of capacity building centres, up-skilling of general populous as well as organising job fair for getting employment. Six Shipping Projects identified for announcement during the forthcoming VVIP visit

The A&N Administration has identified the following six projects for announcement/ commencement of work during the forthcoming visit of the Hon'ble Prime Minister to these Islands. These are as follows:-

- * **Operationalisation of Port Meadows:** Port Meadow was notified as the 24th Port in the A&N Islands on 20.10.2016. The port is located around 25 NM north of Port Blair and is ideally suited for transshipment activities through Sea to Sea Transshipment of Cargo between ships. Recently the Govt. of India has also declared it as a Customs Port. The operationalization of the port will economically benefit the Islands through enhanced trade with South East Asian countries and would also create job opportunities for the Islanders.
- * **Container Transshipment Terminal at Great Nicobar:** Considering the strategic location of the Great Nicobar Island and its proximity to the International Sea Lanes of Communication and Malacca Strait, the Govt. of India has given in principle approval for floating EOI for inviting Private Public Partners (PPP) for the setting up of a Container Transshipment Terminal (CTT) at South Bay

in Great Nicobar. The project will be taken up with the assistance of the Major Port Trusts of Vishakhapatnam and Paradip.

- * **New Passenger Terminal at Havelock:** Havelock Island being one of the prime tourist destinations which is visited by around 3000 ship passengers on daily basis, the need for a modern passenger hall close to the Havelock jetty has been felt for a long time. The Govt. of India has now approved the construction of a modern passenger hall with all facilities close to Havelock jetty at a total cost of approximately Rs. 24 Crores. The construction of the new passenger hall will provide the much needed fillip to tourism activities in the Islands.
- * **Yacht Marina:** A&N Islands is an ideal destination for International sailors. Many yachts from different international locations visit Port Blair annually. To provide adequate berthing facilities and other administrative and technical support to these visiting yachts the A&N Administration has proposed to establish a Yacht Marina at Port Blair between Meetha Khari and Hathitapu jetties. The Yacht Marina will be constructed in a phased manner and presently the designing

A&N Administration plans to setup 50 MW Solar based power plants in Isles

Access to affordable, reliable and sustainable energy is the target of Sustainable and Developmental Goals (SDG). Limiting global warming to 1.5°C. by 2020 is the target of the World by adopting 100% renewable energy. The A&N Administration under the aegis of Ministry of New & Renewable Energy has made a road map of more than 50 MW Solar based power plants to gradually replace the diesel based electricity supply. The Solar Energy Corporation of India is the implementing agency for the rooftop solar plants for renewable energy. M/s. Neyveli Lignite Corporation is implementing 20 MW of Solar PV Power Plant. Seven MW of solar based power plants have

already been installed and will be dedicated to the people of Port Blair and Car Nicobar during the ensuing visit of Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi on Dec.30. 5 MW capacity solar plant is already functioning at Port Blair and 25 MW more of solar plant have also been approved and will be implemented by NTPC. The 7 MW solar power already achieved will generate approximately 10 million units per year which in turn will save around Rs.10 crore per year resulting in reduction of carbon emission due to less consumption of about 27000 KL of HSD oil per year, a communication from the Superintending Engineer, Electricity Department said.

Administration gets 20 electric vehicles from EESL to replace its diesel fleet

India unveiled 'National Electric Mobility Mission Plan' (NEMMP) in 2013 to address the issues of National Energy Security, vehicular pollution and growth of domestic manufacturing capabilities. Reiterating its commitment to the Paris Agreement, the Government of India has plans to make a major shift to electric vehicles by 2030.

There have been initiatives to set up community charging stations and solar powered charging stations especially at the fuel stations in the country. There have been many reasons for the shift to clean mobility such as:

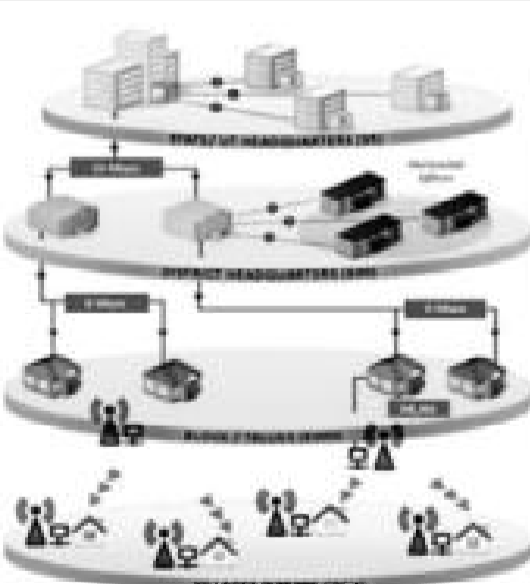
- * Automobile related pollution has been one of the major causes of poor air quality indices in India.
- * The need to reduce dependency on a fossil fuel based economy.
- * India can become a global provider for clean mobility solutions and processed that are affordable and scalable.
- * Electric vehicles can contribute to a reduction in noise pollution levels as it is very high at some places affecting the lives of people and increasing at an alarming rate.
- * Though energy efficiency and emission reduction has improved in automobiles, the pollution levels have not seen any reduction due the growth in the total number of vehicles on road.

In line with its vision to achieve 30 percent e-mobility by 2030 for a sustainable and cleaner future, the Andaman and Nicobar Administration has adopted the National E- Mobility Programme. Towards this, Andaman and Nicobar Administration has taken 20 electric vehicles from Energy Efficient Services limited (EESL), a joint venture of PSUs

SWAN is a Converged network in Secured Closed User Group (CUG) for network Data, Voice and Video services for all government offices leveraging existing OFC/ Copper connectivity of Telecom Service Provider's (TSPs). SWAN has centralized authentication & authorization mechanisms, ensuring security policies for workstations and servers. Setting up of State Wide Area Network in all States /UTs was approved by Govt. of India in March 2005 with total Outlay of Rs 3334 Cr with MeitY Share - Rs 2005 Cr, State (ACA) Share - Rs.1329 Cr. All State/UT SWANs were planned to be established covering over 7500 Point of Presence (PoPs) with an objective to connect all Government offices (initially 50,000) across each State / UT following 3-tier tree/star architecture.

Scientists have identified a fossil plant species that suggests flowers bloomed in the Early Jurassic, more than 174 million years ago. Till now, angiosperms (flowering plants) were thought to have a history of no more than 130 million years. The discovery of the novel flower species, which the researchers named Nanjinganthus dendrostyla, throws widely accepted theories of plant evolution into question, by suggesting that they existed around 50 million years earlier. Nanjinganthus also has a variety of 'unexpected' characteristics according to almost all of these theories. Angiosperms are an



important member of the plant kingdom, and their origin has been the topic of long-standing debate among evolutionary biologists. The research team in China studied 264 specimens of 198 individual flowers preserved on 34 rock slabs from the South Xiangshan Formation - an outcrop of rocks in the Nanjing region of China renowned for bearing fossils from the Early Jurassic epoch. The abundance of fossil samples allowed the researchers to dissect some of them

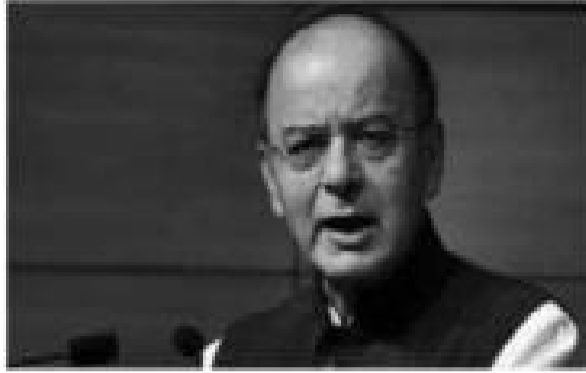

FM says a new beginning made with CSR in last 4 years

New Delhi, Dec.26

Finance Minister, Shri Arun Jaitley has said, a new beginning has been made in the past four years in India regarding Corporate Social Responsibility. Addressing a function at AIIMS, New Delhi, Shri Jaitley said, social sectors in India get funded more on a community basis except for this new beginning. Analyzing the means of funding for India's healthcare and educational bodies as against the global ways, the Minister said, most hospitals and educational institutes in developed countries get large endowments. These endowments come from their alumni. Once they are successful in life, they keep supporting the institutions. Shri Jaitley said, some IITs have started that experiment now in the country, but still it is not very largely prevalent. He said, in India, educational institutions and hospitals are also set up by religious groups and communities.



No proposal to alter age criteria for Civil Service examinations, clarifies Govt.

New Delhi, Dec.26

There is no proposal to alter the age criteria of eligibility for civil service examinations, the government clarified on Tuesday. Minister of State in the Prime Minister's State Office and Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Dr Jitendra Singh said, no such proposal is being considered by the



Centre. He said, all media reports suggesting that the Centre may lower the upper age limit for entry into the civil services and the age

may be brought down to 27 years for general category candidates in a phased manner by 2022-23. Currently, the upper age limit remains 32 years for candidates belonging to general category. For candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes category, the upper age limit to appear for the exam remains 37 years.

Schools cannot make Aadhar a pre-condition for admission: UIDAI

New Delhi, Dec.26

The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has asserted that schools cannot make the 12-digit biometric identifier a pre-condition for student admission. UIDAI CEO, Shri Ajay Bhushan Pandey said in New Delhi yesterday that asking for Aadhaar cards for admissions is not as per the provisions of law and doing so will be against the recent

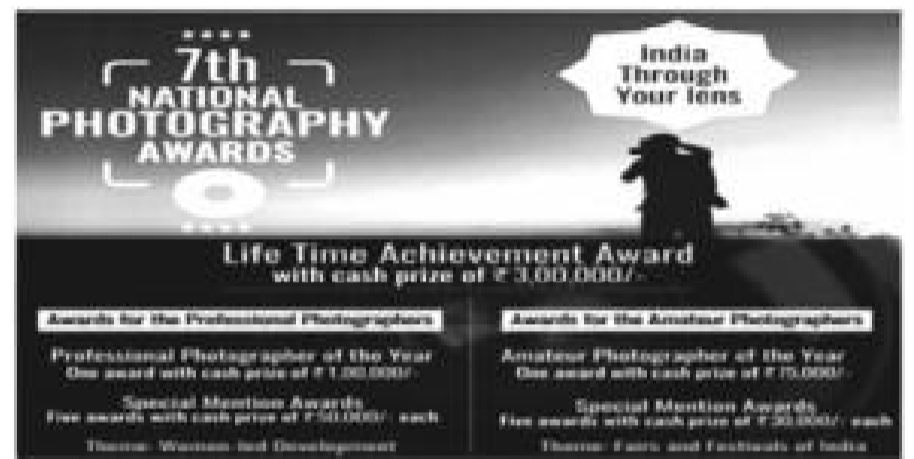


order of the Supreme Court. He said, UIDAI is aware of the reports that some schools are asking for Aadhaar cards for student admission. UIDAI's clarification comes at a time when admissions to nursery and entry-level classes have begun in over 1,500 private schools in Delhi. UIDAI has asked schools to ensure that no child is denied admission for lack of Aadhaar. In September, the Supreme Court had upheld the constitutional validity of Aadhaar but ruled that Aadhaar was not mandatory for bank accounts, mobile connections or school admissions. The court had held that Aadhaar would remain compulsory for filing of Income Tax returns and allotment of Permanent Account Number, as well as welfare schemes.

Five weightlifters banned after 2012 Olympic tests reanalyzed

London, Dec.26

The International Weightlifting Federation announced in Paris on Monday that five weightlifters have been provisionally suspended after reanalysis of their urine samples provided during the 2012 London Olympics. They include two Olympic champions, Ukrainian Oleksiy Torokhtiy and Uzbek, Ruslan Nurudinov. Oleksiy is 105kg gold medallist six years ago, and Ruslan Nurudinov won the same category in the 2016 Rio de Janeiro Games. Only Torokhtiy stands to lose his title, as the samples retested were given four years before Nurudinov's gold-medal winning performance in Brazil. The third weightlifter facing ban is Valentin Hristov of Azerbaijan. He could lose his 2012 bronze medal from the -56kg category after testing positive for an anabolic agent. He is currently serving an eight-year ban following two positive doping tests in 2013 and 2015. The other two athletes to test positive are Armenia's Meline Daluzyan and Belarusian Mikalai Novikau. They did not win medals in London.

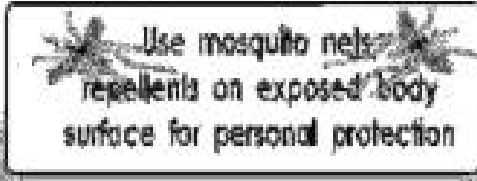

50 bedded AYUSH Hospital to come up at Junglighat

The foundation stone for the project is likely to be laid by the Prime Minister during his maiden visit to the Island, a communication from the Deputy Director-AYUSH, Directorate of Health Services, Andaman & Nicobar Administration, Port Blair said.

Upgradation of Primary Health Centre, Garacharma to District Hospital

At present no District Hospital is available in South Andaman District since the lone referral District Hospital, i.e. G.B. Pant Hospital at Port Blair has been upgraded to Teaching Hospital for Andaman Nicobar Islands Institute of Medical Science (ANIMS). Hence, a proposal for upgradation of PHC Garacharma to District Hospital has been conceived considering its location and catchment area it is serving presently. The Garacharma is

located centrally and could easily cover all the segment of South Andaman District such as Garacharma, R a n g c h a n g , Prothrapur, Calicut, Birdline, Dollygunj, Brichgunj, Sippighat, Bathubasti and also areas like Chouldari, Mout, Manglutan, Tushnabad, Ferrargunj & Bambooflat. The people of these areas now need not come all the way to GB Pant Hospital for specialized services by sparing time and money.

The proposed District Hospital, Garacharma will have the facilities viz Emergency Operation Theatre, Accident & Trauma Ward, Critical Care Ward, Antenatal & Postnatal Wards, Labour Room & Ward, Male, Female & Children Wards, Surgical Wards, Laboratory, Blood Bank, Pharmacy, Ultra Sonography facilities, Specialists Services and AYUSH unit. The Lt. Governor has accorded in principle approval for upgradation of Primary Health

Centre Garacharma to District Hospital at an estimate cost of Rs 17.70 crs(Phase-I) for construction of 150 bedded District Hospital. The Prime Minister of India is likely to lay the foundation stone of the project during his visit to this Island on 29-30th December, 2018 which will fulfil the long pending demand of general public and PRI members of Garacharma and nearby area, a communication from the Secretary, Health said here.

* **Shore Protection Work near MUS Jetty:** Sea erosion at MUS shore line has been a cause of concern for some time now. The constant erosion of the shore line not only destroys the plantation and land based assets but also leads to siltation in the MUS harbour which makes berthing of ships difficult. The Govt. of India has approved the shore protection work near MUS Jetty at Car Nicobar at a total cost of 49.19 Crores. The Shore Protection work will be commenced soon.
