## India is emerging as a global manufacturing and start-up hub: PM

Kampala, Uganda, July 25 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has said that India is emerging as a global manufacturing and start-up hub. Addressing the Indian diaspora in the Ugandan capital Kampala last night, Shri Modi said, many of the 'Made-in-India' products, including cars and smartphones, are today exported to nations from whom the country used to import. Shri Modi said 11,000 startups have been registered in India in the last four years, making the country a land of start-ups. Prime Minister also hailed India's ties with Uganda and other African nations, saying the resource-rich



continent is now in the centre of his government's foreign policy. Shri Modi said India will open 18 new embassies, taking the total number of the country's missions in Africa to 47.

Noting that the trade between India and Africa has witnessed a 32 per cent increase, Prime Minister said Asia and Africa are better positioned in the new world order. Shri Modi

reiterated India's commitment to providing 10 billion US dollars to Africa. He lauded the contribution of the Indian community in the growth of Uganda, but also

recalled the hardship faced by them in the 1970s when some of them were forced to leave the country.

The Prime Minister thanked Ugandan President Mr Yoweri Museveni for re-embracing the Indian community. Shri Modi also recalled his trip to Uganda as Gujarat Chief Minister in 2007 and said the memory of that visit was still afresh. The

## Blood Moon: Longest Lunar Eclipse of the Century on July 27

New Delhi, July 25

There will be a total lunar eclipse around the midnight of July 27 which is expected to be this century's longest. This time, the moon would pass right through the centre of the earth's shadow which makes it the first central lunar eclipse after the one in June 2011, B G Sidharth, Director of BM Birla Science Centre here said. During the eclipse, the moon will appear red, giving it the nickname

The greatest part of the lunar eclipse happens at 51 minutes 44 seconds past midnight (IST). India play Ireland in pursuit of first win in Women's Hockey World Cup

New Delhi, July 25  
A golden opportunity to claim an upset win lost, the Indian women's hockey team would be aiming to make amends when it takes on a lower-ranked Ireland in its second game of the World Cup, in London on Thursday. India had a bright chance to score an upset win against world no.2 England in their Pool B opener on June 21 but settled for a 1-1 draw. The Indians only had themselves to blame as despite leading the English girls for 54 minutes, they conceded a late goal to share the points. World no. 10 India will fancy their chances against world no. 16 Ireland, but it would be a serious mistake by the Sjoerd Marijne-coached side if they take the Irish lightly. By virtue of their stunning 3-1 stunning over world no. 7 USA, the



lowest ranked side in the group, Ireland are currently leading Pool B just ahead of England and India. And a win tomorrow would secure Ireland's place in the knock-out stage of the tournament. The Indians, on the other hand, would be desperate to score their first win in the tournament tomorrow. But the Indians will have to lift their game by few notches for that to happen. Against England, they failed to earn a single penalty corner, leaving dragflicker Gurjit Kaur frustrated. However, goalkeeper Savita was brilliant under the bar to deny England on numerous occasions. The Indians did create more chances from open play against England and that counted as a positive for chief coach Marijne going into tomorrow's game. A win on Thursday will take India to the top of the pool and brighten its knock-out chances ahead of its last fixture against USA on July 29. In the other match of the day, Spain will take on South Africa in Pool C.

Asian Games performance could be considered for Sports Awards to be held on September 25

New Delhi, July 25  
The Sports Ministry is open to the idea of considering outstanding performers of next month's Asian Games for this year's National Sports Awards, which will be held on September 25 instead of the conventional August 29 to ensure that athletes do not miss out due to their participation in the continental showpiece. Every year, the National Sports Awards ceremony is held on August 29 at the Rashtrapati Bhawan to commemorate the birth anniversary of hockey legend Major Dhyan Chand as the National Sports Day. But in a departure from tradition, the awards ceremony will be held on September 25 to avoid a clash of dates with the Asian Games to be held in the Indonesian twin cities of Jakarta and Palembang from August 18 to September 2.

Sports Secretary Shri Rahul Bhatnagar said the decision was taken to ensure maximum participation from sports persons and the Sports Ministry has already received a green signal from the Rashtrapati Bhawan on the change of dates. "The Sports Ministry has decided to shift the date as it coincides with the Asian Games. We want maximum participation from athletes, coaches and officials at the awards ceremony so we wrote to Rashtrapati Bhawan, requesting for the change of date," Bhatnagar said. The official also confirmed that performances at the Asian Games will be considered for the sports awards. "The athletes who will receive the sports awards this year have already been selected on the basis of their entries received before April 30. But the government has provision to name outstanding sports persons of Asian Games to the recommendation committee," Shri Bhatnagar said. "The recommendation committee will have a meeting after the Asian Games and it will be up to them to decide. If they decide to include some more deserving names, they can be included along with the selected ones." Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna is the highest sporting honour for an Indian athlete and has not been given to more than four athletes in a single year. The Arjuna Awards are next in the pecking order and have been given to a maximum of 17 athletes in a single year so far. The Dronacharya Award is handed out to outstanding coaches, while the Dhyan Chand honour is a lifetime achievement honour.

**PHILATELY SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME 'Deen Dayal SPARSH Yojana'**  
**[For the year 2018-19 for students of Class VI to IX]**

Department of Posts has launched a philately scholarship scheme **Deen Dayal SPARSH Yojana** (Scholarship for Promotion of Aptitude & Research in Stamps as a Hobby) on 03.11.2017 for generating interest regarding Philately amongst students.

**About scheme:**

Students of class VI to IX having good academic record and pursuing philately as a hobby will be awarded scholarship on the basis of Philately Quiz & Philately Project to be conducted by Divisional/ Regional/ Circle offices. The amount of Scholarship per awardee is to be Rs. 6000/- per annum @Rs. 500/- per month.

**Salient Features:**

**1. Eligibility Conditions:**

- A Candidate must be a student (Class VI to IX) of a recognized School within India.
- Concerned School should have a Philately Club and the candidate should be a member of the Club.
- In case the School Philately Club hasn't been established a student having his own Philately Deposit Account may also be considered.
- A candidate must have good academic record. At the time of selection for award of scholarship the candidate must have scored at least 60% marks or equivalent grade/ grade point in the recent final examination in 2018 (i.e. V, VI, VII & VIII final exams for students studying in VI, VII, VIII & IX respectively), copies of progress report/ marks card/ certificate from the school authorities should be enclosed along with the application. There will be 5% relaxation for SC/ST.
- Requirement of having a Philately Account/ Membership of the school Philately Club would be with respect to the Date of Application and the student applying would have to mention the same in his/her application form. This is mandatory.

**2. Selection Process:** The Selection Process will be consisting of two levels (Level 1 – Philately Written Quiz & Level 2-Philately Project).

**Level 1: A Philately Written Quiz** at regional level will be conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> of August 2018 by postal authorities in their respective regions which would act as a Screening Test for the second level. The last date for submission of the application is 31<sup>st</sup> July 2018. Time duration for the written quiz test will be One Hour. Department of Posts reserves the right to change the dates at a later stage. The exact date of written quiz etc will be uploaded on [www.westbengalpost.gov.in](http://www.westbengalpost.gov.in) website. Participants are requested to regularly visit the website and keep themselves updated about the scheme from time to time.

**Level 2: Philately Project:** Students selected at the Regional Level Written Quiz will have to submit a Philately Project for final selection within Fifteen days after their selection is announced. There will be no weightage of the marks secured in Philately Quiz in the final evaluation and the final selection would be decided solely on the basis of the marks secured in Philately Project. The results of the selected candidate of the quiz will be uploaded on West Bengal Postal Circle website [www.westbengalpost.gov.in](http://www.westbengalpost.gov.in) for detailing them on the list of Philately Project Topics & broad guidelines to be followed for writing their project. The candidate selected in Philately Written Quiz can submit their project on any of the topic from the list provided within 15 days to the concerned Divisional Office. Participants are requested to regularly visit the website and keep themselves updated about the scheme from time to time.

**3. Syllabus:**

**Philately Written Quiz** will be a Multiple Choice (MCQ) quiz consisting of 50 (Fifty) questions from following subject: Current Affairs, History, Science, Sports, Culture, Geography and Philately (Local & National).

**Philately Project** should not be of more than 4 to 5 pages. In the project, students may use not more than 16 stamps and not more than 500 words.

**4. Amount of Scholarship:** The amount of Scholarship is to be Rs.6000/- per annum @Rs. 500/- per month for a selected candidate. Top 40 students from Level 2 (10 students maximum from each of the VI, VII, VIII & IX Class) will be awarded scholarships.

**5. Disbursement of Scholarship:** The scholarship will be transferred in the joint account (with parents) of awareness in India Post Payment Bank or Post Office Savings Bank in a branch which has core banking facility.

**6. General Conditions:**

- An awardee is eligible for the scholarship provided he/ she maintains good conduct and continues his/ her studies as a regular student.
- Scholarship may be revoked at any point of time by the competent authority on finding any irregularities in the eligibility criteria.
- A student must continue to have a Philately Deposit Account during the Scholarship period.
- Student selected last year has to apply fresh. The Philately Deposit Account opened by them earlier should be live without a break.

**7. Application Procedure:** Interested candidates may submit the application to the concerned Divisional Head through Speed Post/Regd Post or by hand in prescribed form by 31<sup>st</sup> July 2018 addressed to the concerned Divisional Head (see the list below as Annexure). The applications of all the interested candidates of a school can be sent in one envelope by the school incharge/ head by Post or by Hand. Before sending the applications the candidates should ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility criteria prescribed.

Applications received through courier will not be entertained.

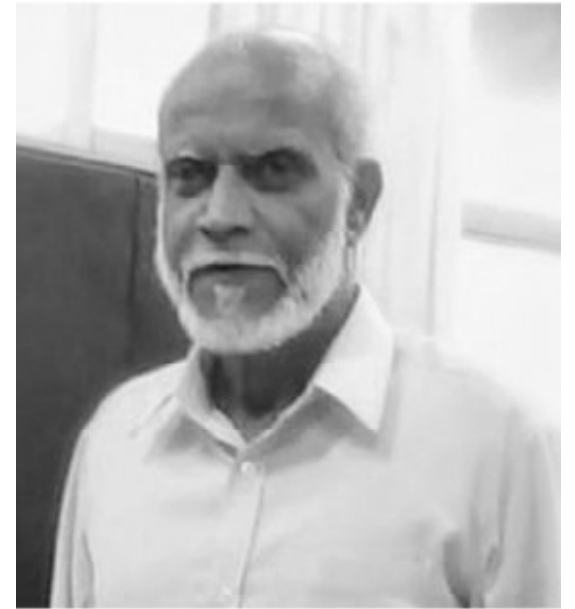
