PM Modi to embark on three nation tour to Africa from July 23

New Delhi, July 20
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi will embark on a five day visit to Rwanda, Uganda and South Africa from 23rd of this month. Briefing media on the visit in New Delhi, Secretary (Economic Relations) in the External Affairs Ministry, Shri T S Tirumurti said, in the first leg of his visit, Prime Minister Modi will reach Rwanda on the 23rd for a two day visit.
He said, India will extend two lines of credit to that country, of USD 100ml each for agricultural sector and industrial sector. Prime Minister Shri Modi will have an interaction with Indian community there. He will meet the leadership



of Rwanda and will be accompanied by high level business delegation during his visit. Secretary also said that India is contemplating to further enhance its strategic partnership with Rwanda.
The Prime Minister will depart from Rwanda to

Uganda on the 24th where he will call on the President. Shri Modi will have delegation level talks and will address Indian community.
PM Shri Modi will also address the parliament of Uganda. Two lines of credit worth USD 164ml will be extended to Uganda during the visit. In the last leg of his visit, Prime Minister Shri Modi will reach South Africa on the 25th to attend the 10th BRICS summit at Johannesburg. He will also meet South African President.

Govt approves special remission scheme for prisoners as part of Commemoration of Mahatma Gandhi's 150th Birth Anniversary

New Delhi, July 20
The Union Cabinet has approved a remission scheme for certain categories of prisoners, including women, transgenders and physically disabled, under which they will be set free on satisfying the given criteria. The remission is part of commemoration of 150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.
The decision was taken at a Cabinet meeting chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi



in New Delhi recently. The scheme will cover those women and transgenders who have crossed the age of 55 years, and men over 60

cent of their sentence will also be covered under the scheme -- irrespective of their age. Terminally ill prisoners will also be considered under the scheme.
The scheme is, however, conditional and those convicted of murder, acts of terrorism, kidnapping for ransom, rape, dowry death and human trafficking will not be covered. The prisoners will be released in three phases, starting 2nd October this year.

Citizens urged to remit property tax dues

Availing rebate of 10% till July 31

Port Blair, July 20
The Revised method of Property Tax is being implemented by Port Blair Municipal Council w.e.f 01.04.2017. The total property tax is calculated as per Unit Area Rental Value method on covered area of the building. The definition of 'Covered area' means total area covered by the building at ground level and at each floor level but does not include garden, rockery, well and well

structures, plant nursery, waterpool, swimming pool (if uncovered) platform round a tree, tank, foundations, bench chabutra with open top and unenclosed sides by walls and the like; drainage, culvert, conduit, catch pit, gullypi, chamber, gutter and the like; compound wall, gate unstoreyed porch and portico, slide, swing, uncovered staircases, ramps, areas covered by sunshade and the like; watchman's booth, pump house, garbage shaft, electric cabin or substations and such other utility structures meant for the services of the building under consideration.
Special rebate of 10% is allowed for early payment of Property tax for the year 2018-19. Therefore, all the citizens have been requested to remit the dues by availing the rebate of 10% till 31.07.2018, a communication from Secretary, PBMC said.

WhatsApp to restrict simultaneous message forwarding to five chats in India

New Delhi, July 20
WhatsApp today said its users in India will not be allowed to forward more than five chats at once. As part of its efforts to reduce circulation of fake messages on the platform that have even incited mob lynching incidents, the company said that it will remove the quick forward button that appears next to media messages.
In a blogpost, WhatsApp



noted that its users in India "forward more messages, photos, and videos, than any other country in the world". The Facebook-owned company has over one billion users globally, of which over 200 million

are in India.
WhatsApp has received flak from the Indian Government over fake news and false information being circulated on its messaging platform. Yesterday, the Government shot off a second notice to WhatsApp asking it to come out with effective solutions to curb the menace of fake news beyond just labelling forwards.

Saina Nehwal, Sindhu, Srikanth, Prannoy retain places in BWF rankings

New Delhi, July 20 India's star shuttlers PV Sindhu and Saina Nehwal retained their positions in women's singles in the latest Badminton World Federation (BWF) rankings released on Thursday. While Saina skipped last week's Thailand Open, Sindhu made it to the final before losing to reigning World Champion Nozomi Okuhara, who climbed up two spots to 6th. Despite her runner-up finish, Sindhu is still placed at No.3 while her compatriot Saina remained on 10th. Meanwhile, 16-year-old Vaishnavi Jakka Reddy climbed up four spots to break into the World top-50 for the first time, achieving a career-best ranking of 50. Ruthvika Shivani Gadde, who returned to action this week in Singapore, also climbed up two



places to 90th. Sai Uttejitha Rao, who hogged the limelight at the All India senior ranking tournament in Bengaluru recently, was one of the biggest movers as she climbed up 13 places to 115. In men's singles, Kidambi Srikanth and H.S.Prannoy stayed put to their No.5 and No.11 spots, while Sameer Verma and B.Sai Praneeth dropped one place each to 19th and 25th respectively. Divya Kakran wins silver in Junior Asian Wrestling Championships

New Delhi, July 20 Divya Kakran (68kg) won silver and Reena (55kg) and Karuna (76kg) claimed bronze in women's freestyle at the Junior Asian Wrestling Championships in New Delhi on Thursday. The other Indians in action, Shivani Panwar (50kg) and Sangeeta Phogat (59kg), missed out on a podium finish.



Japanese wrestlers dominated, winning three of the five gold medals. Commonwealth Games bronze medallist, Divya, a contender for gold, lost to Meerim Zhumanazarova of Kyrgyzstan in the final. The Delhi wrestler was 5-0 down in the opening three minutes. With a minute to go, Meerim

raced to 11-0 to seal the deal. In the day's last bout, Karuna beat Oyuubagana Batchuluu of Mongolia 10-0, while Reena beat Khodicha Najimova of Uzbekistan 8-2 for bronze. In 59 kg, Sangeeta Phogat suffered a knee injury in an early round and wasn't able to give her best in the bronze play-off, losing 5-10 to China's Juanjuan Shi. Shivani Pawar lost her bronze play-off 3-2 to Marina Zakshevskaya of Kazakhstan. India had hoped to win a medal in all five weight divisions. However, chief national coach, K Biju, said: "The team had good preparation, but small errors at crucial moments proved decisive."

Archery World Cup: Indian women face France for gold medal clash today

Istanbul, July 20 In the Archery World Cup Stage-4 in Berlin, Indian women compound team of Trisha Deb, Jyothi Surekha Vennam and Muskan Kirar storm into the final stunning top seed Turkey.



The trio showed nerves of steel after a tied opening set to beat the fancied Turkey 231-228 to set up a gold medal clash against France, tomorrow. Fifth seed, India pipped Great Britain by one point in the opening round, while in the

second round they prevailed over higher-ranked USA 232-228 for their second final appearance in three months. Earlier compound archer Abhishek Verma sealed a berth in the World Cup Finals but made a third round exit, losing to 35th seed Akbarali Karabayev of Kazakhstan.

25-member Indian football squad announced for U-20 COTIF event

New Delhi, July 20 The 25-member Indian U-20 football team will leave for Valencia, Spain tomorrow to participate in the COTIF International tournament scheduled to begin on July 29. The U-20 national team consists of boys who represented India in the FIFA U-17 World Cup India 2017 and the U-19 National Team boys. Midfielder Harmanpreet Singh and Jashandeep Singh, who were part of the 23 short listed players from the Khelo India Project that had appeared for trials at Indian Arrows in Goa, have also been selected into the final squad as part of the reserves.

The team will be playing friendly matches against local clubs on July 23 and July 25 before proceeding to the COTIF Tournament - the Mini Mundial Sub U-20 Men's football tournament. New Delhi, July 20 Veteran Indian star Leander Paes, who missed the entire clay and the grass court season, made a winning return to competitive tennis with American partner Jamie Cerretani at the ATP Hall of Fame Open in Newport. Paes, playing his first match since creating the Davis Cup world record in February for most number of wins in doubles, and Cerretani, defeated Luke Bambridge and Jonny O'Mara 6-4 6-3 in their opening round of the USD 623,710 hard court event. Paes and his partner are now up against giant-killers Jeevan



Nedunchezhiyan and Austin Crajicek, who topped top seeds Nicholas Monroe and John-Patrick Smith 5-7 6-1 10-8. Jeevan has a good record playing against Paes, winning twice against the Indian legend this season - at Tata Open Maharashtra in Pune and at Dallas Challenger. Also

advancing to the quarterfinals was in-form Divij Sharan, who along with partner Jackson Withrow, seeded second, beat Martin Redlicki and Evan Zhu 6-3 6-3. Third seeds Purav Raja and Ken Skupski also moved to the last-eight with a 7-5 6-4 win over Ruben Bemelmans and Denis Kudla.

Indian Men's team beat New Zealand by 4-2 in series opener

Bengaluru, July 20 The Indian men's hockey team pulled off a sensational 4-2 win over New Zealand in the first Test of the three-match series in Bengaluru yesterday.
