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Forests are our treasure, preserve and protect them: Vice President

New Delhi, July 24
The Vice President of India, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu has said that a mega Bio-Diverse Country like India should preserve and protect its forest cover and pass the treasure to next generation duly protecting and developing it. He was interacting with the Indian Forest Service (IFS) Probationers (2017-19), here today. The Vice President asked the Officers to be aware of the imbalances in the global life support systems caused by depleting forest cover, environmental degradation, global warming, pollution of air and water, etc. Stressing on the importance of



forests in maintaining ecological balance, the Vice President has asked Forest Officers to act as facilitator in providing the benefits of the forests to the community and nation, besides providing leadership. The Vice

President said that Forest Management has no longer limited to the management of forests and wildlife alone but is also an activity for maintaining the health of land, water and air. He further said that we now need to depart from the age

old concepts of forest management and adopt a more open, cooperative, ecological functional and environmental angle. Keep social, economic and cultural ramifications in mind while taking decisions on the management of

forests, he added. The Vice President asked the officers to carefully address the problems of forest protection and human sustenance and advised them to apply their knowledge and skill with a human face while dealing issues of the hungry and deprived people living in the around forest areas. Maternal mortality, infant mortality rates sharply decline during last 3 years: Minister

New Delhi, July 24

The maternal mortality and the infant mortality rates in the country have sharply declined during the last three years. The maternal mortality rate has come down from 167 per lakh births between 2011 and 2013 to 130 between 2014 and 2016. Replying to supplementaries during Question Hour in the Rajya Sabha today, Health and Family Welfare Minister Shri JP Nadda said infant mortality rate has also come down from 160 to 130 per one lakh births during the



same period. Attributing the decline to the health schemes including Janani Suraksha Yojana, the Minister said the decline is faster than global rates. He said by the year 2025, the maternal mortality rate is likely to come down to 70 per

one lakh. Referring to another supplementary to Ayushman Bharat scheme, the Health Minister said the Centre has signed Memorandum of Understanding with 26 states to implement the scheme.

Indian Coast Guard evacuates injured crew from ship transiting Andaman Sea

Port Blair, July 24

The Indian Coast Guard Ship C- 146 evacuated an injured crew from MV 'Ornella' on July 21. The 49-year crew, a Ukrainian national suffered severe injuries due to a fall from the staircase of the vessel whilst it was on passage from Chittagong, Bangladesh to Penang, Malaysia. The operation was coordinated by the Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre, Port Blair located at CG RHQ (A&N), which received the message from the master of the vessel and advised her to head

Sundar Singh Gurjar breaks javelin record, makes up for 'missing' 2016 Paralympics

New Delhi, July 24
Javelin thrower Sundar Singh Gurjar, 22, has contemplated suicide twice in his life. The first time was when he lost his arm in a freak accident in 2015 and the second, when he failed to reach the competition area on time at the 2016 Paralympics. But on both occasions, he overcame the urge to take his own life and with support from his coach he started anew. The Rajasthan athlete's resilience paid off as he enjoyed a gold-laden 2017, which included a Para Worlds medal in London. Less than a fortnight ago, Sundar eclipsed the world



record set by Devendra Jhaharia at the Paralympics in Rio, the event he could not participate in because he did not hear the 'call' though he was in the waiting room. At the PCI Indian Open Para Athletics championship in Bengaluru he won a javelin gold (F-46) with a 64.11 metre throw, better than Jhaharia's 63.97m record.

Ramkumar Ramanathan jumps to career-best 115 after Hall of Fame Open heroics

New Delhi, July 24
Ramkumar Ramanathan could not end India's 20-year-long title drought in singles on the ATP World Tour but the Chennai boy got close to the top-100 as he leapfrogged 46 places to a career-best rank of 115 after a runner-up finish at the Hall of Fame Open. Ramkumar lost the title clash of the ATP 250 event 5-7 6-4 2-6 to American Steve Johnson in almost two hours on Sunday. The 23-year-old earned 150 points for a massive jump in his ranking and got richer by USD 52,340. The last Indian to win an ATP singles trophy was Leander Paes, who incidentally had won on the grass courts of the same Hall of Fame tournament in 1998. Yuki Bhambri



continued to be the best-ranked Indian at number 86 despite a loss of one place. Prajnesh Gunneswaran dropped two places to 186 and was followed by Sumit Nagal (269), Saketh Myneni (339, +18) and Arjun Kadhe (345, +16). In the doubles, Rohan Bopanna was the top-ranked Indian at unchanged 27 and was followed by Divij

Sharan (38, -2), Leander Paes (80, -5), Purav Raja (83, -2) and Jeevan Nedunchelviyan (87, +4), N Sriram Balaji (96, +3) and Vishnu Vardhan (98, -6). In the women's singles rankings, Ankita Raina returned to the top-200 following her title win in an ITF event in Thailand. The next best was Karman Raur Thandi at 232, a loss of 16 places.

World Junior Squash Championship: Indian Men beat Saudi Arabia 3-nil in their opening encounter

Chennai, July 24
Indian Men beat Saudi Arabia 3 - Nil in the World Junior Squash Championships in Chennai today. India will take on Switzerland later today. A total of 24 countries, divided into eight groups, are taking part the tournament. India, placed in Group-E alongside Switzerland and Saudi Arabia, is seeded fifth. Egypt, which has dominated the Individual events of the Championships, has been



given the top billing and is in Group-A. Canada has been seeded second and England third. Pakistan has been placed 11th. Two teams from each group will advance to the knock-out phase. The Final will be played on Sunday.

Shreyas Iyer to lead India A against SA, Australia A sides

Kolkata, July 24
Promising top-order batsman Shreyas Iyer was on Monday named captain of the India A teams which will take on South Africa A in the upcoming four-day games and a quadrangular series involving the two teams and Australia A. The All-India Senior Selection Committee met at a plush hotel here to pick the squads. The team also includes Under 19 World Cup winning captain Prithvi Shaw, Mayank Agarwal and India regular Yuzvendra

Chahal. The BCCI also named the India A and India B teams for the quadrangular series against Australia A and South Africa A with U-19 pacer Shivam Mavi finding a place in the India A team. The India B team will be led by Manish Pandey. It will be the fourth team in the series and will also see the likes of highly rated top-order U-19 batsman Shubman Gill. In the bowling department, Navdeep Saini and Prasad Krishna were chosen with Krunal Pandya being the all-rounder option. The India 'A'

- Mosquitoes that spread Dengue, breed in stagnant water in coolers, in water tanks, in flower pots, in coconut shells, in broken / discarded vessels and tyres etc.
- Keep water - filled vessels and tanks tightly covered.
- Empty and dry the coolers once a week.
- The mosquito, spreading dengue fever, bites during day time. Wear clothes which cover the complete body.
- Immediately consult a doctor in case of high fever.
