Warm welcome awaits Vice President of India, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu on his arrival today



Port Blair, July 4

A rousing welcome awaits the Vice President of India, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu on his arrival at Port Blair tomorrow morning (July 5). He will be on a day's visit to the A&N Islands tomorrow. Soon after his arrival, the Vice President will visit the National Memorial Cellular Jail at 9.30 am and lay wreath at the Martyr's Column there. He will also visit a Gallery at the Cellular Jail.

Thereafter, the Vice President will visit Dr. B. R Ambedkar Institute of Technology (DBRAIT) at 10.15 am and address the students. The address of the Vice President will be telecast live by the Doordarshan Kendra, Port Blair from 10.15 to 11.15 am. This live telecast will be screened in all 113 secondary schools and senior secondary schools across the A&N Islands.

The Vice President, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu is scheduled to visit the Central Island Agricultural Research Institute (CIARI) at 11.30 am. At CIARI, he will plant a sapling and also visit the 'Dweep Krishi Darpan'. The Vice President will also interact with the farmers and Scientists in the TR Dutta Conference Hall at CIARI. Later in the evening, at 5.30 pm, the Vice President, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu will attend a Civic Reception, to be hosted by the Port Blair Municipal Council, in Dr. B. R Ambedkar Auditorium (PBMC Auditorium), Mohanpura. On completion of his visit, the Vice President will leave for mainland in the morning of July 6, 2018.

PROFILE

Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu is the Vice-President of India, in office since 11th August 2017. He also served as the Minister of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation, Urban Development, Parliamentary Affairs and Information and Broadcasting in Shri Narendra Modi's Cabinet. A prominent leader of the Bharatiya Janata Party, Shri Naidu also served as its National President from 2002 to 2004. He was the Union Cabinet Minister for Rural Development in Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee's Government. Shri Naidu took the oath as Vice-President of India on 11th August 2017 at Darbar Hall, Rashtrapati Bhawan, New Delhi.

Early life

Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu was born at Chavatapalem, in the Nellore district of Andhra Pradesh, on July 1, 1949. He was educated at V.R. High School, Nellore, V.R. College, Nellore and Law College, Andhra University, Visakhapatnam. He was a swayamsevak in the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh and joined ABVP during his college days. He was elected as the President of the Students' Union of colleges affiliated to the Andhra University. He came into the spotlight for his prominent role in the Jai Andhra Movement of 1972. In 1974, he became the Convener of the Jayaprakash Narayan Chhatra Sangharsh Samiti of Andhra Pradesh. He took to the streets in protest against the Emergency and was imprisoned. From 1977-80, he was President of the Youth Wing of Janata Party, Andhra Pradesh.

Political Career as Leader

Both as a student leader and political figure, Shri Naidu gained prominence as a brilliant orator, who vigorously championed the cause of the farmers and the development of backward areas. His oratory skills and political activism propelled his political career and he was elected as an MLA to the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly twice from Udaygiri constituency in Nellore district in 1978 and 1983. He rose to become one of the most popular leaders of the BJP in Andhra Pradesh. After serving in various organisational posts of the BJP at the State and National level, he was elected as a Member of the Rajya Sabha from Karnataka in 1998. He was re-elected twice, in 2004 and 2010, from Karnataka. He served as the Party spokesperson from 1996 to 2000, bringing to the job his panache for quirky alliterations and similes. After the NDA victory in the 1999 general elections, Shri Naidu became the Union Cabinet Minister for Rural Development in the government headed by Prime Minister Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee. He became the National Party President, BJP in 2002.

Following the historic victory of the BJP in the 2014 general elections, Shri Naidu was sworn in as the Minister for Urban Development and Parliamentary Affairs on 26th May 2014. He was nominated by the BJP on 29th May 2016 for the Rajya Sabha from Rajasthan and was elected. Shri Naidu also served as Minister of Information and Broadcasting. A year later, he resigned from both offices to contest the 2017 Vice-President election. He won the election to become the 13th Vice President of India.

Cabinet hikes MSP of paddy by Rs 200 per quintal

New Delhi, July 4
CCEA today hiked the minimum support price for paddy by a record 200 rupees per quintal. Briefing about the decision in New Delhi, Home Minister Shri Rajnath Singh said the cabinet has approved the MSP of 14 Kharif crops for the 2018-19 season. The government's price advisory body CACP has calculated production cost of paddy at 1,166 rupees per quintal. The Minister said the government has raised the MSP of paddy (common grade) by 200 rupees to 1,750 rupees per quintal for 2018-19 season. The support price of Grade A variety of paddy has been raised by 180 rupees per quintal to 1,770 rupees. The increase in paddy MSP is 50-51 per cent over its production cost. Shri Singh said this will send a positive message to farmers and boost their confidence and end farm distress. Terming it as a historic decision, the Minister said the sharp increase in MSP was done after lot of consideration and not in hurry. The hike in the MSP will cost the

LG inaugurates Modern Fish Market at Junglighat Fishermen urged to make best use of the facilities & ensure proper maintenance of market



Port Blair, July 4

It was a joyous occasion for the fisher folks of South Andaman, as the much-awaited Modern Fish Market at Junglighat was formally inaugurated by the Lt. Governor, A&N Islands, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), here this morning. The Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Vikram Dev Dutt, Chairperson, PBMC, Shri Indra Pal Singh, Adhyaksha, ZPSA, Smti. Baby Fareeda, senior officers of the Administration, Ward Councillors and members from the fishermen community were present on the occasion. Soon after the inauguration, the Lt. Governor, along with other dignitaries took a round of the market and inspected the facilities available for the fishermen.

Addressing the gathering, the Lt. Governor said, the Modern Fish Market at Junglighat has been constructed keeping in mind the need for sanitation and a hygienic environment for the fisher folk community to sell their produce.

Lauding the Fisheries Department, APWD and National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB), Hyderabad, for the timely completion of the project, the Lt. Governor, while listing out the facilities available at the market, said, this Modern Fish Market is having a cold storage room where fishermen can store fish upto 5-7 tons, proper tiled sitting arrangement for individual vendors, lighting and fans, electronic weighing scale and a solid and liquid waste disposal machine for conversion of fish waste into manure. He called upon the fishermen to make best use of the facilities made available to them and also to ensure its upkeep, so that the market can become an example of cleanliness. He also asked the PBMC to monitor the sanitation & maintenance and generate revenue from the fish wastes which will be converted into manure.

The Lt. Governor further stated that the Modern Fish Market at Junglighat has set a benchmark for all the fish markets in Isles and the upcoming Modern Fish Market at Mohanpura will also have the same facilities.

Informing about the review meeting of Islands Development Agency (IDA), which was held under the



Chairmanship of the Prime Minister recently, the Lt. Governor, who is also the Vice Chairman of IDA, said that during the meeting, he apprised the Prime Minister about the progress of infrastructural development, tourism related projects of A&N Islands and issues related to telecom connectivity, shipping sector, crocodile menace etc. The Lt. Governor also stated that the Govt. is committed towards the welfare of the Islanders and since the last 4 years, A&N Islands has witnessed discernible progress in sectors like roads, bridges, tourism etc. He mentioned that a number of Ministers from important Ministries and Departments have visited the Islands and are visiting the Islands, every now and then, to understand the challenges and assess the need for more infrastructural

development, in order to take the Isles towards the path of further progress. The Lt. Governor remarked that in a span of another 2 to 2 ½ years, the fruits of infrastructural development in Isles will be visible on the ground. Regarding the development in tourism sector, the Lt. Virat Kohli scores fastest 2000 runs in T20s, first Indian male batsman to achieve the milestone

Old Trafford, July 4
Indian skipper Virat Kohli has become the first Indian male batsman to score 2000 runs in the twenty-20 format of the game. However, he is the fastest to reach the cricketing milestone. The feat was achieved by the captain in the twenty-20 clash with England in Old Trafford on Tuesday. Kohli has taken 60 matches and 56 innings to hit the fastest 2000 runs in the shortest format of international cricket. With the achievement, Kohli joins the elite league of fastest 2000 runs, previously scored by New Zealand's Martin Guptill and Brendon McCullum. While McCullum scored 2000 runs in 71 matches and 66 innings, Guptill reached the milestone in 75 matches and 68 innings. Mithali Raj, the captain of the



Indian women cricket team, is also part of the club of players who have scored over 2000 runs in the twenty-20 format. Interestingly, Kohli is yet to hit a ton in a twenty-20 international game, with his highest being 90 not out vs Australia in Adelaide on January 26, 2016. He has scored 18 50s in this format of the game. Kohli made his T20 international debut against Zimbabwe in Harare on June 12, 2010. In

Some of the big names which bit the dust in the pre-quarters are Argentina, Spain and Portugal. While five-time champions Brazil, 1998 winner France and 1966 champion England are among the favourites to lift the

Chandigarh's Tarini Goyal (16) finished a joint third in the women's U-18 category of Commonwealth Chess Championship 2018 held in Delhi. Goyal registered four wins, apart from two draws and a loss in the championship. Goyal, who has a fide elo rating of 1973, finished with five points to be tied third with Indian International Master Aakansha Hagawane. The youngster with more than 13 international medals rates the commonwealth championship experience as a learning curve. The youngster, who earned the Woman FIDE Master title in Asian U-10 Youth Championships in 2010, won the bronze medal in Asian Youth Chess Championship in 2013



apart from winning the silver U-14 category in Asian Chess Championships in 2015.

the Center's initiative, under NITI Aayog, four more Islands have been identified for holistic development and the project is gaining steam, adding that efforts will be made by the Administration to ensure that these projects fetch maximum employment opportunities for the Islanders. In his address, the Member of Parliament lauded the Lt. Governor for taking initiative in following up with the concerned Ministries and pressing for progress in important projects pertaining to A&N Islands. He also expressed gratitude to the Prime Minister for his concern towards the Islands and implementing important projects for the welfare of the Islanders. Earlier, welcoming the gathering, the Secretary (Fisheries), Shri Ramesh Verma informed that the project of this Modern Fish Market is funded by the Department of Fisheries, A&N Administration and the National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB), Hyderabad with the objective to provide a modern and hygienic market for the fishermen and the general public. A similar fish market will also come up at Mohanpura and the project is likely to be completed by December, while similar projects will also be initiated in other Islands in the coming days, he added. The PBMC Chairperson, while speaking, highlighted the components of the Modern Fish Market viz. 62 individual sitting capacity for fish vendors, electronic weighing machine, cold storage facility for storing unsold fish, bio decompose unit for conversion of fish wastes to manure. He also expressed gratitude to the Administration for initiating such commendable project for the fishermen community adding that a similar fish market will also come at Mohanpura soon. The programme culminated with the vote of thanks proposed by the Director (Fisheries), Dr. Utpal Kumar Sar.
