Constitutional matters heard by CJI can be live streamed: Centre to SC

New Delhi, July 23
The Centre on Monday told the Supreme Court that video recording and live streaming of judicial proceedings can be undertaken on a trial basis in constitutional matters being heard by the Chief Justice of India's court. A bench, headed by CJI Dipak Misra, was told by Attorney General Shri KK Venugopal, whose assistance has been sought by the court in the matter, that live streaming can be undertaken on an experimental basis for one-three months to ascertain how it functions



technologically. He said, the functioning of the pilot project can be later analysed and made more efficient. The bench asked all the parties, including senior advocate Ms Indira Jaising, who had filed a PIL in her personal capacity, to give

suggestions to the Attorney General. It said, Shri Venugopal will collate and compile the suggestions and submit them to the court which will later approve them. The bench has fixed the matter for further hearing on the 30th of this month.

Railways to introduce Shri Ramayana express from November

New Delhi, July 23
IRCTC, the tourism wing of Shri Piyush Goyal led Ministry of Railways will run a special tourist train associated with the story of Lord Ram from the famous Indian epic Ramayana in the name of 'Shri Ramayana Express'. Shri Ramayana Express will be flagged off on 14th November, 2018 from Delhi Sadfardjung railway station. The train will cover all important destinations associated with the life of Lord Shri Ram in a 16 days all inclusive tour package which is spread both in the countries of India as well as Sri Lanka in which 4



destinations will be covered. The all inclusive tour package will cover all meals, accommodation and wash and change facilities in dharmshalas, all transfers, sight-seeing arrangements and dedicated tour manager of IRCTC who will be travelling with the tourists during the entire tour. Named as Shri Ramayana Yatra-Sri Lanka, the pilgrimage circuit will have

two travel components - one each in India and Sri Lanka. After leaving Delhi, the train will make its first stop in Ayodhya followed by Hanuman Garhi Ramkot and Kanak Bhawan temple. The train will then cover the important destinations of Ramayana circuit such as Nandigram, Sitamarhi, Janakpur, Varanasi, Prayag, Shringverpur, Chitrakoot, (Contd. on last page)

Govt to formulate new industrial policy: Minister

New Delhi, July 23
Government today said, it is in the process of formulating a new industrial policy. In a written reply in the Lok Sabha, Minister of State for Commerce and Industry Shri R Chaudhary said, the proposed vision is to create a globally competitive Indian industry driven by innovation, speed and ease, competitiveness, quality and sustainability. He said, the underlying goals include advancing

India in emerging technologies, increasing technological depth in Indian industry, scaling up small businesses, integrating into global and regional value chains and increasing employment avenues in industry. Shri Chaudhary said, consultations in this regard are being held with stakeholders including industry bodies, academia, think tanks, state governments and concerned Ministries.

India fastest growing economy in Asia: ADB

New Delhi, July 23
India continues to be the fastest growing economy in Asia and is on track to meet current fiscal year's projected growth of 7.3 per cent. Asian Development Bank (ADB) in a new report said, Indian economy's growth will further accelerate to 7.6 percent in 2019, as measures taken to strengthen the banking system and tax reform boost investment. The report said, South

Asia, led by India will continue to be the fastest growing sub-region despite rising tensions between the US and its trading partners. ADB Chief Economist Yasuyuki Sawada said, though rising trade tensions remain a concern for the region, protectionist trade measures, implemented this year so far, have not significantly dented buoyant trade flows to and from developing Asia.

BJP State President urges for 'equal pay for equal work'

Port Blair, July 23
The State President BJP, A&N Islands, Shri. Vishal Jolly, in a letter addressed the Lt. Governor has requested for providing equal pay for equal work to Resource Persons and Contract Faculties in Colleges under A & N Administration. He mentioned that the educated unemployed youths of these Isles depend on government sector, particularly the masters and above degree holders due to lack of job opportunity in the private sector. Working as Resource Person in a college is an opportunity for them. At present, more than 200 resource persons are engaged in different colleges in A&N Islands, many of whom have served as Resource Person for more than 10-15 years. The

resource persons serve upto 9 months in a year but their pay is less than Rs. 10,000/- in some month and a maximum of Rs. 18,000 on an average. There is no consolidated pay followed for them as

like contract faculties. Shri Jolly has urged that the Resource Person be treated equally with Contract faculty and they be provided same consolidated salary, a communication said.

Extension of Wharf at Hope Town Construction work in progress to facilitate berthing of higher capacity vessels & LPG tankers



Staff Reporter, Port Blair, July 23
The Hope Town Wharf in South Andaman which handles cargo sensitive in nature including LPG is being extended by 60 meters to take the total length of the Wharf to 200 meters. The construction work for the extension of the Wharf, mainly utilized by Indian Oil Corporation (IOC) for discharging the LPG and other petroleum products is going on full swing. Accordingly, 70 percent

of the work, which also includes piling work, has been completed in full length. The super structure work is in progress and it is expected that the entire wharf extension project will be completed by December this year, informed the Chief Engineer & Administrator ALHW, Shri TN Krishnamoorthi while speaking to 'The Daily Telegrams' here today. The Chief Engineer

further informed that the purpose of expanding the length of the wharf is to facilitate berthing of higher capacity vessels including LPG tankers (which are 160 Mtr in length), as recommended by Indian Oil Corporation (IOC). The IOC is also in the process of augmenting the storage capacity from 900MT to 2700 MT and once the berthing of higher capacity vessels materializes, the LPG storage of 2700 MT will be fully utilized enabling

IOC to cater to the LPG demands in these Isles more economically, without any disruption in A&N Islands. Hope Town Wharf, situated opposite to Chatham Island in Port Blair Harbour, is currently having a length of 140 mtrs. The fund amounting of Rs.17.49 crores for the project has been provided by Ministry of Shipping under Central Sector Plan Scheme and the project is being executed by the Andaman Lakshadweep Harbour Works (ALHW). The project envisages

components viz extension of wharf - 60Mtr X 20.50 mtr and dredging- 100Mtr X 30Mtr area to clear cast-in & cast-off route of the vessels berthing alongside the extended wharf area.

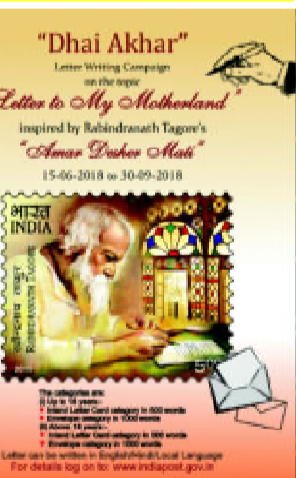

Newport, July 23
American third seed Steve Johnson beat first-time ATP finalist Indian Ramkumar Ramanathan 7-5 3-6 6-2 at the Hall of Fame Open in Newport, Rhode Island, on Sunday for his fourth career title and second of 2018. Johnson wrapped up the final in the only U.S.-based grasscourt ATP event in just under two hours. With the win, Johnson brought an end to world number 161 Ramkumar's bid to become the first player from India to win an



ATP singles title since mentor Leander Paes prevailed in Newport 20 years ago. Ramkumar had made an impressive run to the finals in an upset-filled tournament that

saw only two seeded players reach the quarter-finals. The match was played three hours earlier than originally scheduled due to a possible storm in the area.

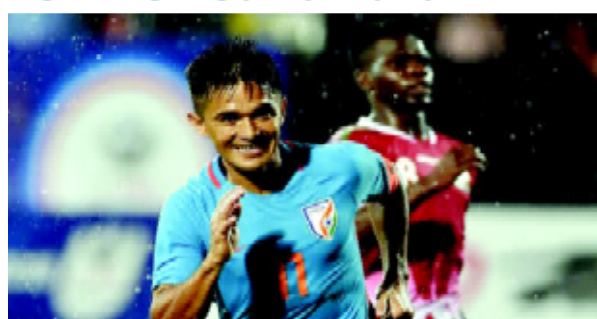

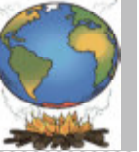
