## NCST organises national seminar on 'Conservation of Particularly Vulnerable Tribes of A&N Islands: The Way Forward'

### Let PVTGs of Andaman & Nicobar Islands grow with their genius and at their own pace: Lt. Governor

New Delhi, Jun 27

The National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST) is organizing a two days National Seminar on 'Conservation of Particularly Vulnerable Tribes of Andaman and Nicobar Islands: The Way Forward' at New Delhi. The seminar was inaugurated by the Lt. Governor of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Admiral D.K. Joshi PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) today. The Chairman of NCST Shri Nand Kumar Sai presided over the inaugural function.

About 44 Ministries/ Departments are participating in the seminar to present their strategies and approach towards PVTGs in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. This Seminar has been organized in collaboration with Anthropological Survey of India (AnSI) and Directors of 18 Tribal Research Institutes in different States are also participating to deliberate on critical issues of tribal groups who are at the verge of extinction. Vice Chancellors of six Universities including Indira Gandhi National Tribal University, Amarkantak will provide academic inputs on PVTGs. Domain experts, NGO and Society

representatives are also providing their perspective so that a holistic view is taken on the way forward. Delivering the inaugural address, the Lt. Governor, A&N Islands emphasized that let PVTGs of Andaman & Nicobar Islands grow with their genius and at their own pace. He said that Andaman & Nicobar Islands are home to the most primitive tribal groups: Great Andamanese, Onge, Jarawa, Sentinelese, Nicobarese and Shompens. Some of these tribal groups are on the verge of extinction. It is important to understand the challenges they face and to preserve them. In his address, Shri Nand Kumar Sai, Chairman,



NCST said that today these fragile communities are facing expropriation of their ecosystem by outsiders. There is an aggressive brush off with non tribals- traders and tourists and this is impacting their physical, environment and routine life. The outside influences are impacting their land use patterns, use of the sea, overall biodiversity leading to material and non-material changes in them and to some deleterious consequences. These clearly need to learn from what happened to the Onges and the Great Andamanese who have been adversely impacted by outside influences brought in by tourism and modern development.

In his welcome address, Secretary, NCST Shri Raghav Chandra dwelt upon many important issues pertaining to the most primitive tribal groups of A&N Islands viz Great Andamanese, Onge, Jarawa, Sentinelese,

Nicobarese and Shompens. He said that the tribal way of life is the simplest, serene and sustainable in the world, modern mankind with its expensive, waste-including, consumerist lifestyle has a lot to learn from our ancient native

tribes- most notably about to coexist peacefully and how to reduce our footprint on mother earth. The total area of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands is 8249 sq kms or twelve times the size of the country of

## CJI asks HCs to suggest measures for speedy disposal of cases

New Delhi, Jun 27 Chief Justice of India (CJI) Dipak Misra has asked the high courts across the country to suggest measures for speedy disposal of cases to curb pendency and filling up of vacancies in the subordinate judiciary. In a communication to the Chief Justices of the High Courts, the CJI has suggested that a disposal review mechanism should be put in place keeping in view the pendency of a large number of cases in the courts. He said that experiences

show that overall monitoring, review and course correction of any action plan yields optimum results. The communication has also referred to the arrears committee which has been tasked to monitor and prepare action plan for disposal of old cases. In a separate communication to the High Courts recently, the CJI had highlighted the issue of number of vacancies in the subordinate judiciary and asked them to fill up the vacancies where it was 15 per cent or more.

## Govt restricts manufacture of Oxytocin for domestic use to public sector only from July 1

New Delhi, Jun 27 Government has restricted the manufacture of Oxytocin formulations for domestic use to public sector only from 1st of next month. It has also banned the import of Oxytocin and its formulations. Health and Family Welfare Ministry in a release said Oxytocin in any form or name will not be allowed to be sold

through retail Chemist. The Ministry said that only the Karnataka Antibiotics and Pharmaceuticals Limited (KAPL), a public sector company, will manufacture the drug for domestic use from next month. The Oxytocin formulations for domestic use will be supplied by the manufacturer directly to the registered hospitals and clinics.

**ISSF Junior World Cup: Saurabh Chaudhary sets junior world record, wins gold**

Germany, June 27  
Sixteen-year-old Indian shooter Saurabh Chaudhary on Tuesday set a new world record on the way to winning a gold medal in the ISSF Junior World Cup in Suhl, Germany. Saurabh shot a total of 243.7 in the 10m air pistol event in the ongoing International Shooting Sport Federation tournament. Saurabh, who earned the eighth gold medal for India in the prestigious meet, ended the eight-man final with a score of 243.7 after 24 shots, 4.1 points clear of Korean shooter Lim Hojin (239.6), who won the silver. Chinese Wang Zhehao walked away with the bronze medal with a total score of 218.7. The junior world record prior to this was 242.5 by Chinese shooter Wang Zhehao at the first ISSF Junior World Cup of the year in Sydney. The other Indian in the final,



Anmol Jain, fell short of the podium, finishing fourth with 199.6. In the qualification, Saurabh had finished third with a score of 583, just ahead of Jain at 580. In the women's 25m pistol final, Manu Bhaker was fifth with 19 hits and Devanshi Rana was eighth with five. The trio of Saurabh, Anmol and Abhishek Arya stood first in the 10m air pistol team event with a

combined score of 1730, while the team of Arjun Singh Cheema, Gaurav Rana and Udhayveer Sidhu was third. In December last year, Saurabh qualified for the Youth Olympics Games with a gold medal and a junior world record at Asia Youth Olympics Games qualification. He had shot 243.1 in the final then. With 8 gold medals, 1 silver and 5 bronze, India continued to top the medal standings.

**Dipa Karmakar named in 10-member artistic gymnastics squad for Asian Games**

New Delhi, June 27  
A fit again Dipa Karmakar was on Tuesday named in the Indian gymnastics squad for the Asian Games, making it a comeback event for the 24-year-old after a career-threatening injury. The men and women squads in the artistic gymnastics were picked after the two-day trials concluded at the Indira Gandhi Stadium in New Delhi. Karmakar topped the trials ahead of Pranati Das, Aruna Reddy, Mandira Chowdhury and Pranati Nayak, who all have also made the Asian Games squad. Rakesh Patra topped the men's trials ahead of Yogeshwar Singh, Gaurav Kumar, Ashish Kumar and Siddharth Verma. Karmakar has not competed since her historic fourth place finish in Rio Olympics and



had undergone an Anterior Cruciate Ligament (ACL) surgery in April 2017. It remains to be seen how Karmakar performs at big stage after a two-year gap. Her coach Bisweshwar had pulled Karmakar out of the Commonwealth Games trial as she was nowhere near full fitness. In her absence, the Indian contingent had disappointed at the Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast. Karmakar and Patra are expected to take part in a competition in Turkey next month ahead of the August 18-September 2 Asian Games.

**Mayank Agarwal on fire again as India A beat England Lions by 102 runs**

Leicester, June 27  
Opener Mayank Agarwal continued his dream run with yet another hundred as India A comfortably beat England Lions by 102 runs in the third match of the Tri-nation 'A' series, in Leicester on Tuesday. After scoring 112 against West Indies A yesterday, Agarwal made an identical score as India A scored a competitive 309 for 6 in 50 overs. In reply, England Lions were all out for 207 in 41.3 overs with pacer Shardul Thakur taking three for 53. India A are now level on points with the Lions—4 points from three games. While batting, Agarwal's 112 was complemented by Shubman Gill's 72 and Hanuma Vihari's 69. Gill in fact was promoted as an

Ankita Raina began her campaign at the Wimbledon qualifiers with an easy straight sets win over local girl Maia Lumsden in London on Tuesday. The 205th ranked Indian routed the wild card entrant 6-2 6-1 and set up the second round clash with Russia's Vitalia Diatchenko, ranked world No 134. The top ranked Indian girl needs to win two more matches to make it to the main draw. In the first qualifying round of men's doubles, the Indian pair of Vishnu Vardhan and N



Sriram Balaji advanced to the second round with a 6-3 6-4 win over Sergio Galdos and Gerald Melzer. Also advancing to the second round was Jeevan Nedunchezhiyan with his American partner Austin

Krajicek. The fourth seeds faced stiff competition from Britons Marcus Willis and Aidan McHugh before prevailing 7-6(3) 6-3 in the opening round. They are one win away from making the main draw.

**Argentina enter World Cup pre-quarters with 2-1 win over Nigeria**

Moscow, Jun 27  
A late goal from Marcos Rojo gave Argentina a 2-1 triumph over Nigeria in their final Group D match here on Tuesday as the two-time champions entered the FIFA World Cup pre-quarterfinals.

Rojo scored the winner for Argentina in the 86th minute after Victor Moses' penalty conversion in the 51st minute had cancelled out Lionel Messi's strike in the 14th minute. Following the win, Argentina

Singapore. The total number of tribes on these islands are 28077, out of which 97% are the more developed Nicobarese. The five particularly venerable tribes are the Sentinelese only 50, in North Sentinel Island; Andamanese: 70 in Strait Islands; Ongese: 120 in little Andaman Islands; Shompens: 238 in Great Nicobar Island and Jarawas: 500 in Middle and South Andaman Islands. Exclusive Thematic Sessions have been organized on the Sentinelese, Great Andamanies, Onge, Jarawa, Shompen. The deliberations took stock of the impact of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) Regulation 1956 as amended in 2005 and 2012 along with 2004 Policy on Jarawa Tribes of Andaman and Nicobar. Similarly, the 2015 Policy on Shompen of Great Nicobar Islands have been discussed in the Seminar. The entire architect of welfare approach by the Government will be analysed in the seminar for a road map for PVTGs in Andaman, which are a role model for PVTGs in other States.

**Sindhu makes winning start at Malaysia**

Kuala Lumpur, June 27  
Olympic silver-medallist PV Sindhu made a winning start, staving off a stiff challenge from Japan's Aya Ohori in the women's singles opening round at the USD 700,000 Malaysia Open World Tour super 750 tournament on Wednesday. Sindhu, who had skipped the Uber Cup Finals to regain full fitness after claiming a silver at the Gold Coast Commonwealth Games, took some time to get into the groove before she edged out world No. 14 Ohori 26-24, 21-15 in the opening round match.

The third-seeded Indian will face the winner of the match between Malaysia's Ying Ying Lee and Chinese Taipei's Chiang Ying Li next. However, it was curtains for Singapore Open champion B Sai Praneeth as he went down 12-21, 7-21 to Wang Tzu Wei of Chinese Taipei in a men's singles contest. Sindhu's slender 8-6 lead vaporised when Ohori had a 12-10 and 15-13 advantage at one stage. But Sindhu managed to turn the tables, reaching 19-17. The Japanese came back to grab game points at 20-19 but the Indian saved one. However, she failed to convert three game points herself as Ohori again held a 24-23 lead. In the end, Sindhu held her nerves to close out the opening game. In the second game, Sindhu eked out a slender 8-6 lead at one stage and despite a fightback by Ohori, she managed to break free at 14-14 to comfortably seal the contest. Kidambi Srikanth and men's doubles pair of Satwiksairaj Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty will be in action later in the day.

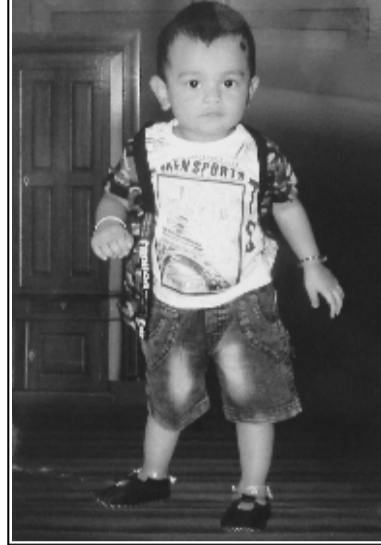

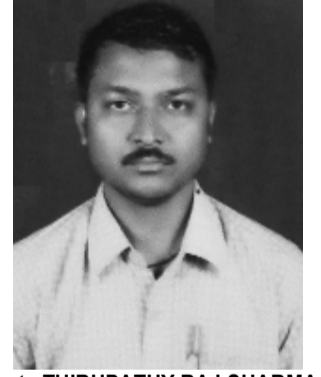

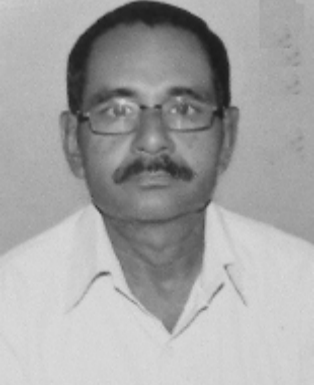
