Union Minister launches National Generic Document Registration System

A&N Islands becomes first UT to implement e-registration of land



Port Blair, June 28
The Union Minister of Rural Development, Panchayati Raj & Mines, Shri Narendra Singh Tomar has called for adopting an easy, fast, corruption free and transparent working system in all Government offices and institutions so as to serve the common man with greater responsibility. He was launching the online land/document registration system- National Generic Document Registration System (NGDRS) for A&N Islands from New Delhi, through video

conferencing today. The Minister of State for Rural Development, Shri Ram Kripal Yadav and the Secretary, Deptt. of Land Resources, GoI, Shri Dinesh Singh were also present on this occasion. At Port Blair, the launch was witnessed in the Mini Conference hall of Secretariat by the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Vikram Dev Dutt, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman, Shri Udit Prakash Rai and other senior officers of the Administration.



The Minister said that there is need to change the working system and reduce the number of complaints from the citizen. Transparency has to be maintained in this regard to deliver a good governance, he said, congratulating the A&N Administration and NIC officials for successfully preparing the software and becoming the first UT to implement the e-registration of land in India. He advised all SRO of the NGDRS to discharge their duties honestly and to the expectations of the citizens. He also expressed hope that other states will also come up with the portal soon and connect

the country together. Speaking on the occasion, the Minister of State for Rural Development, Shri Ram Kripal Yadav lauded NIC and Officials of A&N Administration, for resolving the genuine problems of the citizen by developing the software and connecting them with the Registration Offices. The Chief Secretary A&N Administration, while speaking on the occasion said that the launching of the portal is a step towards transparency in the working of the Revenue Department. The online registration will simplify the registration process in a time bound manner, he said.

The Chief Secretary handed over the first two online registered deeds to the citizen in the presence of the Union Minister. The Secretary, Deptt. of Land Resources, GoI, Shri Dinesh Singh appreciated the efforts made by A&N Administration and the District Administration in particular for operationalizing the online land registration system within the short span of one month. The Deputy Commissioner South Andaman gave details of the preparation of the system and its benefits for buyers and sellers. He mentioned that with the

Jinson Johnson breaks Sriram Singh's 42-year-old 800m national mark

Guwahati, June 28
Jinson Johnson is on a record-breaking spree. In March, at the Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast, he broke a 23-year old national record in the 1500m and on Wednesday, at the ongoing Inter State Championship in Guwahati, he rewrote a 42-year old national mark in the 800m event. The 27-year-old Army man managed to clock 1:45.65s to bag the gold and in the process erased Sriram Singh's mark of 1:45.77 set in 1976 at the Montreal Olympics. The effort also earned him a spot in the Asian Games where the qualification guideline specified by the Athletics Federation of



India was 1:47.50s. Manjit Singh, who clocked 1:46.24s, clinched the silver medal while Mohammad Afsal (1:46.79) snared the third spot. Johnson credited his success to improved physical fitness, "I have been improving my physical fitness and the conditions were very good. Before the race, I was not thinking about the gold. I told myself that I will go for the national record," said Johnson, whose previous best was 1:45.98, recorded two years back. He knew it was a matter of time before he broke Sriram's record.

ISSF Junior World Cup: Manu Bhaker shoots another gold, sets world record

Germany, June 28
Teen sensation Manu Bhaker fired her way to an individual gold medal with a world record score while Anish Bhanwala bagged a bronze as India continued their dominance at the ISSF Junior World Cup in Suhl, Germany on Wednesday. The 16-year-old Manu shot 242.5 to win the top prize in 10m air pistol event and Anish added to India's tally by finishing third in the men's 25m rapid fire pistol. This was the year's seventh individual gold in an International Shooting Sport Federation competition for Manu and the third with a world record. Their efforts took India's tally in the competition to an impressive haul of 17 medals so far. Manu shot 242.5 in the 24-shot final, to claim yet another



junior world record, shrugging off the challenge of China's Kaiman Lu, whose silver winning effort of 236.9 was a massive 5.6 points behind the Indian's score. Chinese Xue Li won bronze with a final round score of 216.2. Manu had earlier combined with teammates Mahima Turhi Agrawal and Devanshi Rana to win the team bronze with a total score of 1694 after the qualification round. Such was Manu's dominance in the final that she was ahead of the field by 3.4 points after 10 shots, 3.8 after 12 and a huge 6.1 after 18 shots before closing out with plenty to spare. Reigning Commonwealth Games champion Anish claimed his fourth international medal of the year when he shot 24 in the Junior Men's final of the 25m rapid fire event. Anish had earlier shot 575 in qualifying to be fifth out of the top six to make it to the final.

FIFA World Cup: 14 of 16 knock-out berths decided



Moscow, Jun 28
In the FIFA World Cup, 14 of the 16 knock-out berths have been decided.

The 14 teams that have entered the knock out stage are: Brazil, Argentina, Spain, Portugal, France, England,

Belgium, hosts Russia, Uruguay, Croatia, Denmark, Mexico, Switzerland and Sweden.

India thrash Ireland by 76 runs in opening T20 encounter

Dublin, Jun 28
India beat Ireland by a whopping 76 runs in the opening T20 International at Dublin last night. Riding on a 160-run stand between openers Shikhar Dhawan and Rohit Sharma, India posted a target of 209 against Ireland. Rohit Sharma scored 97 off 61 balls whereas Shikhar Dhawan smashed 74 in 45 balls. In reply, Ireland could only



manage 132 for 9 in 20 overs despite a breezy innings of 60 off 35 balls by opener James Shannon.

Kuldeep Yadav took 4 wickets, whereas Yuzvendra Chahal picked up 3 wickets in 4 overs.

Pullela Gopichand's daughter Gayatri included in badminton squad for Asian Games

Hyderabad, June 28
The Badminton Association of India (BAI) on Wednesday named six youngsters including Gayatri Gopichand in a strong 20-strong squad, headlined by the star trio of K Srikanth, PV Sindhu and Saina Nehwal for the prestigious Asian Games in Jakarta. Gayatri, daughter of chief national coach Pullela Gopichand, will be joined by Ashmita Chaliha, Sai Uttejitha Rao, Akarshi Kashyap,



Rutuparna Panda, Aarthi Sara Sunil and Sourabh Verma, winner of 2016 Chinese Taipei Masters. BAI had organised two

senior-ranking tournaments in Bangalore and Hyderabad to select the squad after exempting senior players from the twin events.

Ankita Raina out of Wimbledon qualifiers, Vardhan-Balaji pair and Jeevan qualify

London, June 28
Ankita Raina's hopes of a maiden Grand Slam main draw appearance ended in a heartbreaking defeat but the Indian pair of Vishnu Vardhan and N Sriram Balaji succeeded in their effort and qualified for the main draw alongside Jeevan Nedunchezhiyan, who partnered Austin Krajicek in the Wimbledon qualifiers. Ankita lost 2-6, 7-5, 4-6 to the Russian world number 132 against Vitalia Diatchenko after a brave two-hour-23-minute battle in the second round of the grass court major. India has not seen a female singles player competing in the singles Grand Slams since



Sania Mirza's first round loss at the 2012 Australian Open. It was a second meeting between the two players with the Russian emerging victorious way back in 2014, also in an ITF event in Egypt.

However, there were cheers for the Indian fans with Vardhan and Balaji booking their berth in the men's doubles draw following a 6-3, 6-4 win over top seeds Denys Molchanov and Igor Zelenay in the second round.

Kidambi Srikanth enters quarter-final of Malaysia Open

Kuala Lumpur, Jun 28
In Badminton, Indian shuttler and world number 7 Kidambi Srikanth entered the quarter-final of the Malaysia Open in men's singles today. He defeated 15th seeded Chinese Taipei's Wang Tzu Wei 22-20, 21-12 in the pre-quarterfinals. Later today, P.V.Sindhu will take on Malaysia's Ying Ying Lee in women's singles pre-quarterfinal. Earlier in the day, Olympic medalist Saina Nehwal crashed out of the Malaysia Open after a



loss to world No 2 Akane Yamaguchi. Former world number one Saina made the 2nd round exit after suffering a 15-21, 13-21 loss as the match ended in 36 minutes.
