Centre along with state govts building infrastructure for modern healthcare to benefit poor and middle class: PM

New Delhi, Jun 29 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today said the Centre along with the state governments is trying to build infrastructure for modern healthcare to benefit the poor and the middle class of the country. Inaugurating several new facilities at AIIMS and Safdarjung Hospital in New Delhi, Shri Modi said the government has given a new direction to public health care in the last four years. Shri Modi said the government is upgrading hospitals in 58 districts to medical colleges to provide better facilities. 13 new AIIMS have been announced across the country, out of which work



on eight has already begun. He said, dialysis centers are being made in almost every district of the country where free dialysis facility is being provided to the poor. Shri Modi added that the government will set up 24 new medical colleges across the country as announced in the Budget. The Prime Minister also said India is working to free the country from TB by 2025. Talking about Yoga, Shri Modi said it has established its name for preventive health care. Earlier, the Prime Minister laid the foundation stone for the National Centre for

Aging at AIIMS in New Delhi. This centre will provide the elderly with Multi-Specialty healthcare and it will have 200 general ward beds. The work of the Centre will be completed by February 2020 at a cost of 330 crore rupees. Shri Modi also inaugurated the 555 bed Super Speciality Block in Safdarjung Hospital. He also dedicated the 500 bedded New Emergency Block in Safdarjung and 300 bedded Power Grid Vishram Sadan at AIIMS. Shri Modi inaugurated the Connection Motorable Tunnel between AIIMS, Ansari Nagar and JNPA Trauma Centre. The tunnel will enable quick transfer of critical patients from the hospital to the trauma centre in just five minutes. Forward Rani Rampal was Friday named as the captain of India's 18-member squad for the women's hockey World Cup to be played in London in July. Hockey India on Friday announced the 18-member Indian women's team for the prestigious tournament which is slated to begin on July 21. India have been placed in Pool B along side hosts and world no. 2 England, world no. 7 USA and world no. 16 Ireland. While experienced Rani will lead the team, goalkeeper Savita has been named as her deputy. The tournament will also witness the return of goalkeeper Rajani Etimaru after having rested for the Spain Tour. India's defence will consist of Sunita Lakra, Deep Grace Ekka, Deepika, drag-flicker Gurjit Kaur and youngster Reena Khokhar who makes a comeback into the team. In the



midfield, Namita Toppo, Lilima Minz, Monika, Neha Goyal, Navjot Kaur and Nikki Pradhan will hold fort. On the team's balance, the Dutchman said, "We have a good blend of experience and youth in the team. The recent Spain Tour has given the team great confidence to do well at the World Cup. Our focus is on the first match against England. "In order to reach our first goal of qualifying for the quarterfinals, we can only think about the first match against the

hosts and the team is excited and confident of starting well against them," he added.

India finish on top of medals tally at ISSF Junior Shooting World Cup



Germany, June 29
Indian shooters picked up eight more medals, including five gold, on the concluding day of the ISSF Junior World Cup in Suhl, Germany on Thursday. Their successful campaign saw them finish on top of the medal standings among 61 participating countries, collecting 26 medals in all including 15 gold, two silver and nine bronze medals. India's gold medals came in the 10m air pistol mixed team, 25m standard pistol men junior individual and team and 25m

standard pistol women junior individual and team events respectively. Besides, they also won the silver medal in the 10m air rifle mixed team event, a bronze in the 25m standard pistol junior men as well as a welcome bronze medal in the junior women's skeet team event. The highlight of the day for India was their 1-2 finish in the 10m air pistol mixed team event, where the pair of Devanshi Rana and Saurabh Chaudhary piped compatriots Manu Bhaker and Anmol Jain

in the five-team final to clinch gold. Devanshi and Saurabh shot a total of 478.9 to get the better of Manu and Anmol, who finished with 474.4. The Indian contingent in the process overturned the result in their favour over powerhouses China, who had topped the charts in the year's first Junior World Cup in Sydney, where India had finished second. The Indian squad also established five new junior world records during the course of the Suhl JWC and equalled another.

Shivpal, Sudha, Dutee Chand and Nirmala Shrooran book Asian Games berths

New Delhi, June 29
Unheralded Shivpal Singh of Uttar Pradesh sprang a surprise with a big throw in the men's javelin while veteran 3000m steeplechaser Sudha Singh ran her best race in two years as both booked Asian Games berths with gold medal winning efforts on the third day of the 58th National Inter State Senior Athletics Championships, in Guwahati on Thursday. Shivpal cleared 82.28m in his final throw – his personal best – to clinch the gold and better the Asian Games qualification mark of 81m to the surprise of those present at the Indira Gandhi Athletics



Stadium. It was a jump of 2.5m from his previous earlier best of 79.77m which he did in 2016. The 23-year-old from Varanasi is expected to be named in the Indian team for the Asian Games

on June 30 along with star athlete Neeraj Chopra who has been exempted from taking part in this meet which serves as the final selection trial to pick the Indian track and field team.
