The Vice President of India, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu visited the infamous Cellular Jail in Port Blair, Andaman & Nicobar Islands today, where valiant freedom fighters were meted out most cruel and inhuman treatment by the British. He also paid tributes to the heroes of the freedom moment.
The Vice President also visited the solitary confinement cell of Veer Savarkar at the Cellular Jail and paid tributes to the great freedom fighter. The purpose of solitary confinement was to demoralise freedom fighters, keep them in small, solitary cells without any scope to interact with fellow prisoners and local people.
The Vice President was received by the Lt. Governor of Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Admiral D.K. Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM, (Retd.), Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray and other dignitaries, on his arrival at Port Blair this morning. He was also given the Guard-of-Honour jointly by the Army, Navy and Airforce.

Atrocities against women should be condemned & not politicized

Port Blair, July 5
The younger generation of the country should be enlightened about the great contributions of the freedom fighters of our country. "The air of freedom we breathe today is because of the sacrifices they made and torture & innumerable hardships they endured; and we have to remember and salute them for this", said the Vice President of India, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu while addressing a huge gathering during the Civic Reception hosted by the Port Blair Municipal Council in his honour at Dr.B.R Ambedkar Auditorium here this evening. The Lt. Governor, A&N Islands, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, State President, BJP, Shri Vishal Jolly, Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Vikram Dev Dutt, Adhyaksha, ZPSA, Smti Baby Fareeda, Chairperson, PBMC, Shri Indra Pal Singh, senior officers of the Administration, Municipal Councillors & Ward Members, PRIs and general public attended the programme.

The Vice President of India said that the picturesque Andaman & Nicobar Islands not only represent the nature's splendor but are also a microcosm of India's multi-cultural, multi-religious and multi-linguistic social mosaic. The Vice President made a clarion call to the Central and State Governments to motivate youths to visit the National Memorial Cellular Jail and derive inspiration and acknowledge the contributions made by the valiant freedom fighters for liberating our country from the alien rule. He also appreciated the hard work of the people of these Islands, who are trying to realize the dreams of the freedom fighters. "I salute the contributions made by freedom fighters, Veer Savarkar and others, who were incarcerated and tortured during their confinement inside the Cellular Jail", said Shri Naidu.

The Vice President described A&N Islands as a perfect



example of a 'Mini India' where people hailing from different linguistic, cultural & religious backgrounds live in perfect harmony. Shri Naidu urged the countrymen to emulate the example of 'Unity in Diversity' prevailing here in A&N Islands.
The Vice President further said that the agenda of any Government, should be based solely on 'development' and ensuring that required facilities are made available for the citizens. Describing Ram as an embodiment of Indian culture, the Vice President said 'Ram Rajya' in real term is nowhere connected with a religion and it specifically means "a country where there is no poverty, corruption, violence, fear, division based on caste, creed or religion". This, he

said, should be inculcated in the minds of the citizens, so that we can march towards the path of development. He reminded everyone that 'Share & Care' has been the core of Indian philosophy.
The Vice President urged the citizens to inculcate the feelings of 'one nation', 'one country' and 'one people' and to rise above all caste, creed, religion and gender disparity, as these are very dangerous negative tendencies for the functioning of democracy. "From Kashmir to Campbell Bay, the southernmost point of India, we must foster the feeling of togetherness", said Shri Naidu.

Vice President addresses students at DBRAIT Education should lead to enlightenment, enhancement of Knowledge & empowerment: Vice President Exhorts students to aim high, dream big & work hard

The Vice President of India, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu has said that Education is the most important tool for transformation of the society through enlightenment and empowerment. Addressing the students and others present in the Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Institute of Technology (DBRAIT) in Port Blair today, he said that Indian higher education system needs to reinvent itself to respond to the emerging challenges of a rapidly changing knowledge economy. The Lt. Governor, A&N Islands, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd), Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu



Pada Ray, Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Vikram Dev Dutt, Secretary, Education, Shri Arava Gopi Krishna and other senior officers of Administration and academicians were also present on the occasion. The Vice President said that the 'real education' must foster all-round development of students. It should lay equal emphasis on academic excellence and skills for self-employment or gainful employment, he added. Talking on the need to reorient teaching methods, syllabi and the learning processes to meet the challenges of the globalized 21st century knowledge society, he called for revamping the education system from KG to PG to make it more rigorous, effective and quality-oriented. Emphasis should be there on developing a holistic personality and not merely producing certificate holders, he added.

Stressing that students coming out of higher educational institutions must have empathy, compassion and respect for elders and teachers, he said that they should not only be tech-savvy and scholarly but more importantly, they should have unshakeable integrity and honesty with strong ethical and moral values.

The Vice President said that there is a need to inculcate scientific temper and cultivate a scientific outlook right from early childhood. Children should be made to learn through hands-on experiments rather than focusing on rote-learning, he added.

The Vice President has advised students to become job creators rather than becoming job seekers. He further advised the students to be creative, innovative and try to explore uncharted territories and not to be afraid of setbacks. Dedication, passion, commitment, hard work, discipline and perseverance will make realize your dreams and achieve your goals, he added.



The Vice President cited the exemplary lives of late Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, who was from a very humble background, but rose to become a great scientist and the President of India through sheer hard work. He also mentioned about Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, who championed for the cause of the down trodden and became the Father of the Indian Constitution and also Shri Narendra Modi, the Prime Minister of India, who is today known world-wide.

Remembering the contributions of the great freedom fighters of our country, the Vice President said, "the A&N Islands are an Islands of 'sacrifice', Islands which gives 'inspiration' to the rest of the country because, it is this place, where many of our freedom fighters, right from the 1st war of Independence were brought, incarcerated and tortured. But they inspired others and rekindled the spirit of patriotism in other generations to fight for freedom". The Vice President saluted the great freedom fighters led by Vinayak Damodar Savarkar and others, who have made supreme sacrifices here in A&N Islands.

The Vice President disclosed that it is his 3rd visit to the Islands today. He stated that it was his desire to meet the various sections of the society residing here, Scientists & researchers of ICAR-CIARI, Islands' farmers, students and also to visit the Cellular Jail, which drew him here for the third time. After becoming the Vice President of India, Shri Naidu said, his mission was to tour the length and breadth of the country to interact with students from colleges, IITs, IIMs, Medical Institutes, scientists, researchers and the farmers, who are the back bone of our country. His visit to various parts of the country were aimed at enquiring about the fruits of various scientific research and developments and finding whether it reaches to the farmers or not, to know and understand the problems of the farmers, to empower them and to work out ways to strengthen the Agriculture sector of the country.

The Vice President further stated that about 65 % of India's population is below the age of 35 and we have a young population who are breathing with confidence. "I am reassured about the future of this country because this land is very fertile", he said, adding that Indians have made their marks in every sphere of life across the globe. "India's philosophy is based on 'Share & Care', hence we must continue to care for every stratum of the society and share the knowledge we acquired", said Shri Naidu.

Urging the students to respect every human being, Shri Naidu said, women should be respected and treated well. The atrocities meted out to women/girls cannot be wiped out unless the society's mindset is changed. India was a country where women were given utmost respect and hence we call it our 'Mother Land'. The rivers of our country are named after women. The regard for women was high and we must continue to exhibit the same because it is the culture of our country to respect women. "Women should be empowered and given the opportunity to pursue their dreams", said the Vice President. He also listed the names of prominent Indian women who have made a mark in various fields.

The Vice President also spoke about the initiatives of the Prime Minister towards empowering citizens of the country viz. 'Make in India', 'Skill India' and 'Clean India'. Shri Naidu said, it is the duty of every individual to keep our surroundings clean and the 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' should be a people's movement. Maintaining good health is equally important and hence every individual must remember the saying 'health is wealth'.

The Vice President also threw light on various burning issues viz. global warming and climate change and urged the citizens to do their bit to combat these challenges. He also exhorted them to harness solar energies and take care of the environment we live in. Shri Naidu also highlighted about the country's 'Look East Act Policy', which is bound to provide opportunities to the citizens. He said, the future is bright and we must take advantage of it and education should be used for transforming the society. He also reminded the students of the Prime Minister's vision of 'Reform, Perform & Transform'. Shri Naidu concluded his address by bestowing his best wishes to the students.

The Vice President also interacted with the media persons and the students soon after his address.

term gain", the Vice President said, demonetization had a positive impact on the country's economy, adding that today there are 35 crore bank account holders in the country, which is a historic achievement. This, he said has massively helped the Government to curb corruption and the benefits of various schemes are reaching the target population. Stating that online is the way forward, the Vice President said, we are now moving towards digital India and together we must fight to end the menace of corruption.

Highlighting the functioning of Parliament, the Vice President said the Parliament should function in a dignified way. Though there may be political differences, but all issues should be discussed and debated with no disruption, so that the solutions for the issues can be worked out. The Vice President mentioned that the schemes floated by the Government should reach the beneficiaries and the citizens must join hands in achieving the desired results. Emphasizing that 'health is wealth', the Vice President said, the 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' should be a mass movement and it is the responsibility of every individual to keep the society clean.

The Vice President stated that atrocities against women should be condemned and not politicized. "We must ensure that women are rightly empowered as they play pivotal role for the growth and development of the country", he said adding that women should be respected and not ill treated.

The Vice President called the Islands a precious jewel given by Mother Nature and said, they must be preserved in their pristine purity. Let us add more lustre to them by making them hubs of sustainable socio-economic development. Let us make them the inspirational lighthouses of historical legacy, he added.

Speaking on the occasion the Lt. Governor A&N Islands Admiral DK Joshi PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), said the strategically important A&N Islands, guarding the most busy sea lanes of the world is capable of playing an important role in the 'Act East Policy' of India and can become the gateway to East Asian and South East Asian countries. The sea surrounding the A&N Islands provides opportunities as well as challenges to it. We have 25% of the countries coast line as well as 30% Exclusive Economic Zone.

The Lt. Governor said the Administration is efficiently providing basic facilities to the people here viz. Education, Health, Electricity, Water, despite the connectivity problems. "However during the last 2-3 years, the A&N Islands have made unprecedented Scio-economic development, and we thank the Central Government for its constant support in the overall development of the Islands", said the Lt. Governor, expressing confidence that the issues concerning Shipping, Civil Aviation and internet connectivity will be solved soon with the support of the Central Government.

Mentioning about the unique feature of the Islands that makes it a Mini India, the Lt. Governor informed about the cultural exchange programme between A&N Islands and Lakshadweep under 'Ek Bharat-Shreshth Bharat' and the student exchange programme between Jammu & Kashmir and A&N Islands (Kashmir to Campbell Bay).

Highlighting the development activities of the Islands, the Lt. Governor informed about the constitution of Islands Development Agency under the chairmanship of the Home Minister as per the direction of the Prime Minister. Under this, various important projects are being implemented for tourism and infrastructural development. Last year, 4.87 lakh tourists visited these Islands and every year this data is growing by 20%. The undersea OFC project work has been awarded during May 2018, which will be completed by December 2019. The works of construction of National Highway 4 and the two bridges are progressing well. The proposal for bridge between Chatham and Bambooflat is also ready, said the Lt. Governor.

He also informed that under Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, the A&N Islands have been declared 'Open Defecation Free' on Jan 31, 2018. Rain water harvesting and solar roof top has been made compulsory in all the buildings to be constructed in the Municipal area. This will also be implemented in the rural areas soon, he said. The A&N Islands have 86.93% forest area. Despite being a major part of Carbon Sink of the country, land diversion for important developmental and Agricultural projects here is very difficult; he said urging that land may be made available for these activities.

The A&N Administration has also proposed for dual use of various Defence and Civil infrastructures in the Islands. The dual use of proposed extended Airports in Diglipur, Car Nicobar and Campbell Bay will benefit the people and economy of these Islands the Lt. Governor said, expressing confidence that the Islands will continue to receive the special attention of the Central Government.

Speaking on the occasion, the Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray at the outset thanked the Vice President for choosing A&N Islands under Smart City project while he was the Urban Development Minister. He further stated that following implementation of GST in the country in July 2017, the PBMC has lost its octroi. On the other hand more number of Wards have been included in the jurisdiction of PBMC. Therefore, more funds should be provided to PBMC, he said. He also requested that the Councilors be provided with some fund to help the people of their area during any disaster. The Member of Parliament also requested to include sugar under PDS and increase the quantity of rice under PDS. He also requested that a special package is given to the Rural Development Department for carrying out various developmental activities in rural areas, restarting the flight between Port Blair and Nicobar and urged that a package is provide to the Sri Lankan refugees living in Katchal Island.

Welcoming the Vice President of India, Shri M Venkaiah Naidu, the PBMC Chairperson Shri Indra Pal Singh informed him about the prime responsibilities of the Port Blair Municipal Council viz. providing drinking water, sanitation, solid waste management, footpaths, street lights and public toilets. He also informed that PBMC has initiated the Digitalization in the Municipal Council to bring good governance to the citizens of the Port Blair City. Digitalization has brought transparency and corruption free environment for the people, he said, adding that PBMC will soon launch the online building plan approval system for the people, which is also one step ahead towards digitalization. He further mentioned that, following implementation of the GST, the octroi has been subsumed in the GST, resulted in 85% reduction in the revenue of PBMC and requested to provide budgetary grant to PBMC besides additional funds to meet various requirements. The PBMC Chairperson also presented the Appreciation Letter to the Vice President. The function concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by the Sr. Vice Chairperson, PBMC Smti Vinita Malhotra.

maximum benefit apart from providing MSP at 50 percent or more over the cost of production. Other income enhancing measures need to be taken to mitigate agrarian distress, especially of the small and marginal farmers, he added.

The Vice President asked the scientific community present at the gathering to have regular interaction with farmers through their scientific teams and Krishi Vigyan Kendras. A good synergy between the research institutes, farmers and the local administration is crucial for development of farm sector, he added.

Expressing concern over the unstable income of farmers owing to risks

relating to production, markets and prices, the Vice President stressed on the need to improve farmer's income. Creating greater awareness among farmers on crop diversification, Livestock (dairy and poultry) and horticulture (Green House cultivation, Hitech horticulture) sectors can be best bets for enhancing farmers' income and employment opportunities, he added.

The Vice President asked farmers and those involved in agriculture to be aware of government schemes like Soil Health Card (SHC) Scheme, Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY), Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) and The electronic National Agriculture Market (e-NAM).

The Vice President said that the decreasing man power availability and their increasing costs are making the farming less profitable and sometimes non-profitable. Secondary agriculture like processing and value addition of farm produce has immense potential to enhance the farmers' economy, he said.

He also suggested creation of farmers groups such as Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) and Village Producer Organizations (VPOs) to scale up post-harvest operations and directly linking them with markets which would also help farmers to realize higher prices for their produce. It would also generate considerable off farm /non-farm employment opportunities for the rural youth, he added.

Earlier, the Director, CIARI, Dr. A Kundu welcomed the Vice President and other dignitaries.

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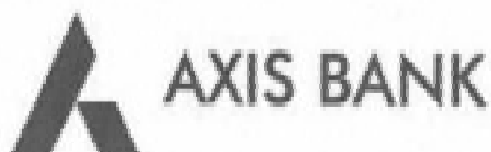

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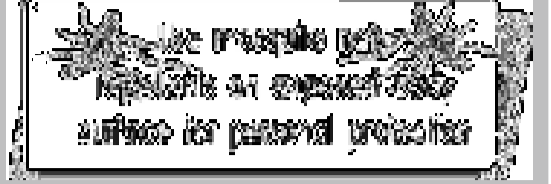
