## Drug addiction spurs poverty & poses challenge to national security: President

New Delhi, June 26 President Shri Ram Nath Kovind has said drug addiction spurs poverty and poses a challenge to the national security as well as development and public welfare goals. Presenting the National Awards for outstanding services in the field of Prevention of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse in New Delhi, Shri Kovind said, alcohol consumption is the door towards destruction. He said, illicit drug use is a serious concern as it poses significant health challenges. He said, problem of drugs addiction and alcoholism negatively impact the



individual, family and society in multiple domains such as health, culture, development and politics. The President said, misuse of illegal drugs is creating health challenges especially for the young generation and school going children. He stated that the problem of drug abuse can be solved by awareness, prevention,

incentives, and support efforts. Shri Kovind said, Parents, teachers, doctors, voluntary organizations should be associated in the medical and rehabilitation efforts. The President said that increase in drug trafficking and drug abuse in the border areas is associated with issues of terrorism and political unrest. He said, there is a need to be more vigilant in border States like Punjab and Manipur. Speaking on the occasion, Social Justice and Empowerment Minister Shri Thawar Chand Gehlot said, in the last four years, four lakh 50 thousand people across the country have been de-addicted from drugs.

Mumbai, June 26 India has become the main engine of world growth being the most investment friendly country with a GDP growth rate of 7.4 per cent in the current fiscal year and growing global confidence in India's economy, said Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today. He was speaking at the inaugural of third annual meeting of the Asia Infrastructure Investment Bank-- AIIB in Mumbai today. Highlighting the strengths of the Indian economy in size and scale and the efforts taken by the government to reform and streamline the vital process on the path of development, the Prime Minister said that India's



story of economic resurgence mirrors that of many Asian countries which need large investments in infrastructure for inclusive growth and betterment of lives in this region. As developing countries facing similar challenges,

the 87 member nations have made remarkable beginning by investing over four billion US dollars within last two years, he said. AIIB has already made an impact on the lives of billions of people and can play a central role in helping various sectors like

agriculture, energy, water supply, sanitation, environment and logistics, he said. Though AIIB focuses on Asia, it also supports infrastructural finance requirements in other countries, he said. In his welcome address, Finance Minister Shri Piyush Goyal said the inspired leadership of India's Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has steered the policies of the multi-lateral banks towards poverty alleviation and emulating the ideals of Mahatma Gandhi by gently shaking the world through its infrastructure funding initiatives in Asia and elsewhere. Established two years ago, the Bank annual meeting is attended by about 3000 delegates from 87 countries.

## Govt proposes to set up 3,000 'Van Dhan Kendras' across country

New Delhi, Jun 26 The government has proposed to set up 3,000 'Van Dhan Kendras' involving 30,000 self-help groups of tribal community across the country to provide skill up-gradation and capacity building training for value addition of forest produce. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has launched the Van Dhan Scheme on 14th of April this year during the celebrations of Ambedkar Jayanti at Bijapur in Chattisgarh. A statement issued by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs said, these groups will be working under the leadership of Collector and they can market their products not only within

## Over 41 lakh new jobs created in 8 months: CSO

New Delhi, Jun 26 More than 41 lakh new jobs were created in the country during September 2017 till April this year. Central Statistics Office, CSO, released the employment-related statistics in the formal sector for eight months beginning from September 2017. In April this year alone, the highest ever new payrolls of over 6.8 Lakhs were recorded by the retirement fund body Employees' Provident Fund Organisation, EPFO. CSO brought out the first release of employment-related statistics in the formal sector in April, this year which covered the period from September 2017 to February 2018. It said, during April, the maximum new payrolls of over 1 lakh 87 thousand

were recorded in the age bracket of 18 to 21 years followed by nearly 1 lakh 81 thousand payrolls in 22 to 25 years. For each age-wise band, the estimates are net of the members enrolled and ceased during the month. It also said the estimates may include temporary employees whose contributions may not be

## A & N Police apprehends 8 Myanmar Nationals; people urged to inform about any illegal activity

Port Blair, June 26 Upon receipt of credible information from a local fisherman of V.K. Pur regarding sighting of Myanmarese poachers entering into Jackson Creek on two engine dinghies, a police party was deputed to carry out extensive search under the supervision of Shri. M.K. Meena, SDPO Havelock.

After conducting day & night search operations, the Police team headed by SI Subramani, I/C OP R.K.Pur apprehended three

Myanmar Poachers on Jun 11, 2018 while three more were apprehended on Jun 18, 2018 by another team lead by ASI S.N. Rathore. Thereafter 2 more were also apprehended.

The apprehended Myanmarese were brought to Port Blair and a case has been registered at PS CCS under relevant sections of law. The two seized engine dinghies of the poachers have been brought to Hut Bay with the help of Coast Guard Ship. Further investigation of

the case and search of remaining poachers is in progress by A & N Police and IRBn joint teams. **Champions Trophy: Confident India aim to upstage Australia**

Breda, June 26  
Their campaign off to a dream start with back-to-back wins, India would look to continue the giant-slaying spree when they take on world champions Australia in their third match of the FIH Champions Trophy hockey tournament, here Wednesday. In pursuit of their maiden Champions Trophy title in the 37th and final edition of the event, the Indians could not have asked for a better start, mauling arch-rivals Pakistan 4-0 before stunning world No.2 and reigning Olympic champions Argentina 2-1 in their opening two games. India are now leading the six-team standings with six points from two wins, just ahead of Australia (4 points). The top two teams in the round robin league will face each other in the summit clash on Sunday. The Commonwealth Games debacle behind them, the Indians came out with new



vigour and purpose here under new chief coach Harendra Singh, who swapped roles with Sjoerd Marijne as the women's team coach. Under Harendra, who took over for the fourth time in his career, the Indian team looked a completely transformed side, desperate to make amends for the Gold Coast disaster. Preferring to field youth alongside experience, Harendra has managed to instil confidence among the players and it is evidently visible in India's

**India look to kick off English summer on winning note against Ireland**

Dublin, June 26  
It's the dress rehearsal before the actual test but India would do well not to let the guard down when they take on a lowly but effervescent Ireland in a two-match T20I series, starting Wednesday. The games will mark the onset of a long summer for the Indian team, with sterner tests against England to follow this short series in Malahide on the outskirts of Dublin. England have just hammered Australia in an ODI series and most of their top players are in sublime form. Perhaps it was a marker of this crucial impending assignment that India decided to stay on and practice in London on Monday. While the contingent had arrived from Delhi on Saturday, this was a first

training session on-tour, held at the Merchants Taylor School cricket ground. Reportedly, the players were split into three groups while practicing all facets of the game. Umesh Yadav and Bhuvneshwar Kumar headed the pace group along with allrounder Hardik Pandya, while a few others practised fielding drills. Among batsmen, openers Rohit Sharma and Shikhar Dhawan enjoyed a first stint together. Skipper Virat Kohli and the in-form KL Rahul batted together in adjacent nets against spin and pace respectively. While Rahul has been a constant part of the T20I squad, Ajinkya Rahane's omission from the ODI squad means that he is once again a contender for the number four spot when the

Kuala Lumpur, June 26  
Ace Indian shuttler Saina Nehwal has entered the pre-quarterfinals of the Malaysian Open Badminton tournament in Kuala Lumpur. In her opening game this afternoon, Saina defeated Hong Kong's Yip Pui Yin in straight games, 21-12, 21-16 to progress. World number three PV Sindhu and seventh seed Kidambi Srikanth are yet to play their first-round



matches. South-East Asia leg of Malaysian Open is the first tournament of the Federation's world tour.

**R Praggnanandhaa becomes second youngest Grandmaster ever**

New Delhi, June 26  
At just 12 years, 10 months and 13 days, R Praggnanandhaa has become India's youngest and world's second youngest Grandmaster after making it to the final round at the Gredine Open in Italy. He missed out on becoming the youngest ever by three months with Sergey Karjakin of Ukraine holding the record of being the youngest Grandmaster in the world at 12 years, 7 months – a feat achieved in 2002. Incidentally, the fourth spot in youngest Grandmasters is also held by an Indian – Parimarjan Negi at 13 years, 4 months and 22 days. By beating Moroni Luca Jr in



the eighth round, Praggnanandhaa needed to play an opponent above of rating of 2482 in the final round to make his third norm. Luck shone on him when he was paired with GM Pruijssers Roeland, rated 2514, which made it possible. Legendary Viswanathan Anand lauded Praggnanandhaa's feat and

**ICC T20I rankings: Winning spree could propel India, Virat Kohli upwards**

New Delhi, June 26  
A busy period of Twenty20 international cricket offers third-placed India a shot at moving up the ICC team rankings, provided they launch an unbeaten run against Ireland and England and a few other results elsewhere in the world go their way. There are as many as 13 T20Is scheduled to be played across the next two weeks, with England playing Australia in a one-off game in Birmingham on June 27, the same as day Ireland host India for the first of two fixtures. From July 1-8, a tri-series in Zimbabwe featuring

the hosts, Australia and Pakistan will be held, while from July 3-8 there will be three T20Is between England and India. Virat Kohli's team can reach 127 points if they win all five T20Is. If England beat Australia and sweep India 3-0, they would reach 126 points. However, both India and England could become No 1 if Zimbabwe manage to beat Australia and Pakistan during the league stage of their home tri-series. Pakistan, the No 1 side in T20Is with 131 points, will be wary of Australia who sit five points below them, when the Zimbabwe series begins. Australia can dislodge Pakistan from the top spot irrespective of what happens in the one-off against England, should they win all four league matches against Pakistan and Zimbabwe. If Australia beat England and then win all four league matches in Zimbabwe, they will have gained 137 points. If Pakistan win all four league matches and the final against Australia they will have 136 points. In the player ratings for T20I batsmen, former No 1 Kohli will eye progress upwards from No 8 with a run of good scores against Ireland and England.

**Kabaddi Masters Dubai 2018 India, Iran book semifinal berths**

Dubai, June 26  
World champions India and runners-up Iran booked semifinal berths from their respective groups to continue their supremacy in the six-nation Kabaddi Masters at the Al Wasl Sports Complex in Dubai on Monday. India once again put up a dominating show to prevail over Pakistan 41-17 for their second successive victory against their arch-rivals in their second and final leg group A exchange. India had thrashed their bitter foes 36-20 in the opening game of the six-nation meet on June 22. Substitute Emad Sedaghatnia put up a spectacular show in the final minute to help Iran seal a semifinal berth from group B after scraping past Korea 31-27 in a fiercely-contested opening



battle of the day. For India, the most expensive player Monu Goyat, who came in as a substitute in the second half topped the raid charts with seven points. Captain Ajay Thakur and Rishank Devadiga scored six points each as they inflicted two all-outs en route to another convincing victory. Earlier in the first match, it was anyone's game till the last three minutes as Iran led 24-22 and Korea got a raid point to reduce the deficit to one point. Sedaghatnia scored with a two-point raid before Mohammad Maghsoudlou got another point in the dying seconds to seal their last-four berth. Maghsoudlou scored 12 points while Mohammad Nabibakhsh put up an all-round show both in attack and defence to spearhead Iran's challenge. The meet is being organised by the International Kabaddi Federation in partnership with Star India Pvt Ltd and Dubai Sports Council.


